THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their 10-game homestand, sweeping the Brewers in two games on Tuesday and Wednesday, followed by going 2-1 vs. the Tigers over the last three days...today, they will continue the homestand with the four-game series finale against the Tigers...after this series, the Twins will welcome the Red Sox to Target Field for four games from Monday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 21-16 at home and 15-19 on the road. The Twins are on game six of a 16 games in 16 days stretch, their next off-day being in Baltimore on June 29...the Twins have 20 games in 22 days leading up to the All-Star Break (July 10-13).

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 2-0, recording their fifth shutout of the season...Jose De Leon led the bullpen day with 2.0 perfect innings to start and was followed by Emilio Pagan (1.2 IP), Brent Headrick (2.1 IP), Brock Stewart (1.0 IP), Griffin Jax (1.0 IP) and Jhoan Duran (1.0 IP) all in relief...the offense recorded just three hits and walked three times...Alex Kirilloff drove in the Twins' first run with a single in the fifth inning, followed by Ryan Jeffers, who recorded the other RBI of the day with a fielder's choice immediately following Kirilloff...the win snapped a four-game losing streak against the Tigers as the Twins beat Detroit for the first time since September 30, 2022. Headrick earned the win in relief after tossing 2.1 scoreless innings and allowing one hit, with two strikeouts...made his fourth major league appearance of the season and first since April 26...became the third pitcher in Twins history (1961-present) with at least one win and at least one save within his first four career games, joining Bill Pleis (2 W, 1 SV in 1961) and Tom Johnson (2 W, 1 SV in 1974).

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the fourth of 13 meetings in 2023. Four of the Twins' next eight games will be against Detroit as they will travel to Michigan for a three-game series next weekend to kick-off a nine-game roadtrip. Carlos Correa is hitting .295 (18-for-61) with five doubles, two home runs, nine RBI and an .834 OPS in his last 15 games vs. the Tigers. Michael A. Taylor is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with an .870 OPS in his last 15 games vs. Detroit. Christian Vazquez is hitting .329 (27-for-82) with seven doubles, three home runs, 15 RBI and an .894 OPS in 24 career games vs. the Tigers. The Twins have hit 104 home runs vs. the Tigers since 2019, the most in baseball.

STAFF REFLECTIONS: Twins starters have averaged 5.6 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022...they have pitched 6.0-plus innings 40 times this season, which matches their total from last season...by June 18, 2022, they had reached 6.0-plus just 17 times...additionally, below are the starting staff's rankings in a few categories among other all MLB teams:

DONNIE, YOU'RE OUT-OF IN YOUR ELEMENT!: Donovan Solano has reached safely in each of his last eight games, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks, a .515 on-base percentage, a .692 slugging percentage and a 1.207 OPS in that span. Solano is hitting .322 (28-for-87) with 10 RBI, 12 walks and an .824 OPS in 31 games at Target Field this season...his home batting average ranks 10th best in the American League (minimum of 75 at-bats).

RUN THE JULS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on Saturday, Edouard Julien is hitting .421 (8-for-19) with four doubles, four walks, a .522 on-base percentage and a 1.153 OPS in six games...in his last 13 major league games (dating back to May 24), he is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with six doubles, two home runs, four RBI, nine walks, a .436 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.036 OPS. Julien has posted an OPS of .904 vs. right-handed pitching, compared to .444 vs. lefties.

JOEY LONGBALLS: Joey Gallo has an average exit velocity of 93.4 mph, ranking seventh best in the AL and 11th best in baseball...additionally, he ranks fourth in baseball in hard hit percentage at 57.6%...Gallo leads the Twins in both home runs (11) and slugging percentage (.480)...lastly, Gallo has an average home run distance of 406 feet, the longest on the club. Gallo has posted an OPS of .833 vs. right-handed pitching, compared to .685 vs. lefties.

I'LL TAKE OBP FOR 400, ALEX: Alex Kirilloff has posted a .408 on-base percentage in his last 19 games, since May 27, reaching base 31 times in 76 plate appearances (17 hits, 12 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch)...in 37 games for the Twins, he has posted a .393 on-base percentage, which is sixth among AL players with a minimum of 130 plate appearances. Kirilloff has posted a .900 OPS vs. right-handed pitching, compared to .513 vs. lefties.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul catcher/first baseman Chris Williams and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Marco Raya have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week. Williams, 26, hit .467 (7-for-15) with six home runs, 14 RBI, five walks, a .600 on-base percentage, a 1.667 slugging percentage and a 2.267 OPS for the Saints...the Garden Grove, CA native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Clemson University. Raya, 20, made one start for the Kernels on Friday vs. South Bend, allowing one run on two hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Raya also had a 46% whiff rate...the Laredo, TX native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of United south High School in Laredo, TX.

BIRTHDAY SHOUTS: Third base/outfield coach Tommy Watkins is celebrating his 43rd birthday today...he shares a birthday with Pioneer Press beat writer Betsy Helfand, late MLB Hall-of-Famer Lou Brock, country singer Blake Shelton, singer Paul McCartney and former NFL tight end Antonio Gates...the Twins won last season on Tommy and Betsy's birthdays, beating the Diamondbacks in Arizona by a score of 11-1.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, the Twins beat the Red Sox by a score of 4-3 in 17 innings, marking the longest game in Target Field's history...eight pitchers relieved starter Michael Pineda that night, combining to allow just two hits and one walk in 11.0 innings...Max Kepler hit the game-tying home run in the 13th and the walk-off single in the 17th, becoming the first player to have a game-tying RBI and a walk-off RBI in the 13th inning-or-later in the same game since Milwaukee's Willie Randolph on May 1, 1991.

THIS AND THAT: Outfielder Gilberto Celestino has been reinstated from the 10-day Injured List and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...Cele has missed the entire season with left thumb surgery. Right-handed pitcher Jorge Alcala has been transferred from the 15-day IL to the 60-day IL...Alcala has been on the IL since May 16 a right forearm extensor strain. Royce Lewis has reached base safely in six of his last seven games, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with an .867 OPS in that span.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision on June 11 against Toronto at Rogers Centre in the Twins' 7-6 series-finale loss to the Blue Jays; pitched a season and career-low-tying 4.2 innings, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts...received four runs of support before taking the mound; allowed one run in the bottom of the first inning on a sacrifice fly by third baseman Matt Chapman...held Toronto scoreless in the second, third and fourth innings, allowing only two singles...allowed three runs in the fifth inning on two hits and one walk, including a two-run home run from Chapman...was relieved by Jovani Moran with two outs in the fifth and the Twins leading 6-4; Emilio Pagán surrendered a three-run home run to first baseman Cavan Biggio in the eighth as Minnesota lost and failed to record a three-game sweep.

☞ Tied his start on May 3 at Chicago-AL (also 4.2 IP, 4 ER) for the shortest outing of his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss in his first career start vs. Tampa Bay on June 6 at Tropicana Field as the Twins fell 7-0...opposed Zach Eflin, who earned the win...went 6.0 innings, allowing a career-high seven earned runs on six hits while issuing a career-high four walks and striking out five...fired 3.0 scoreless innings to start his outing...allowed three runs in the fourth inning on three hits, one walk and an RBI sacrifice bunt by second baseman Vidal Bruján...yielded a two-run home run to rightfielder Luke Raley in the fifth and a solo homer to centerfielder Jose Siri in the seventh...was relieved by Emilio Pagán in the seventh inning, who allowed one inherited runner to score...Twins offense recorded only four hits in their fifth shutout loss of 2023.

☞ Allowed multiple home runs for the fourth time this season, also doing so on April 14 at New York-AL (3), May 14 vs. Chicago-NL (2) and May 26 vs. Toronto (2).

DEBUT VS. DETROIT: Facing the Tigers for the first time in his career; Detroit will become the 10th team he has faced in the majors...in nine career starts when facing an opponent for the first time, Varland is 2-4, 4.30 ERA (52.1 IP, 25 ER) with 14 walks and 42 strikeouts...has never faced any current Tigers batters in his career...making his second start of the year and fifth of his career against an American League Central division opponent; in four career starts vs. the AL Central (CWS - 3, CLE - 1), he is 1-1, 4.58 ERA (19.2 IP, 10 ER) with six walks and 17 strikeouts; Twins have gone 1-3 in those four starts.

BACK HOME AGAIN: After three-straight road starts, Varland is set to pitch at Target Field for the first time since taking the loss against Toronto on May 26 (6.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R/ER, 2 HR, 3 K)...in three starts at home this year, he is 1-1, 3.44 ERA (18.1 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and 16 strikeouts; Twins have gone 1-2 in those three starts...enters today's outing as the only pitcher in baseball to make at least nine starts overall this season with three-or-fewer home starts...Minnesota is 3-3 in his six road starts in 2023, with Varland going 2-1, 5.40 ERA (33.1 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 34 strikeouts.

☞ In five career starts at Target Field, Varland is 1-2 with a 3.72 ERA (29.0 IP, 12 ER), six walks, 22 strikeouts and a .236 (26-for-110) opponent batting average...he is 3-2 with a 4.81 ERA (48.2 IP, 26 ER), 14 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .268 (51-for-190) opponent batting average in nine career road starts.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Through his first nine starts this season, left-handed hitters are batting .231 (15-for-65) with 18 strikeouts against Varland...righties are hitting .265 (36-for-136) with 32 strikeouts...struck out three left-handed hitters and three right-handed hitters in his last outing on June 11 at Toronto...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .243/.289/.430 with four home runs and 27 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are slashing .264/.316/.492 with 12 home runs and 44 strikeouts.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland has used a four-pitch mix in his first nine starts this season, including a four-seam fastball, cutter, slider and changeup, according to Baseball Savant...used his four-seam fastball and cutter for 76 of his 89 pitches (85.4%) in his last start at Toronto on June 11...below is a look at his 2023 repertoire:

☞ Has averaged 10.6 inches of horizontal movement on his slider this season, the third-most slider horizontal movement on the Twins staff in 2023, according to Baseball Savant (José De León - 14.2, Bailey Ober - 10.9)...his slider breaks 69 percent more than the average MLB slider.

ON YOUR TOES, DEFENSE: 18.7 percent of Varland's pitches this season have been put in play, the highest percentage in the Twins rotation and the 15th highest in the American League (min. 9 GS)...opponents have swung at the first pitch 37.6 percent of the time against him, the fifth-highest rate in the AL (min. 9 GS); teammates Joe Ryan (39.9), Pablo López (38.3) and Bailey Ober (37.8) occupy the top three spots on the AL first-pitch swing percentage leaderboard...Varland also ranks 21st in the AL with an average of 15.9 pitches-per-inning among pitchers with at least nine starts.

GROUND GAME: In his last start on June 11 at Toronto, Varland induced only six groundballs per Baseball Savant, tied with his start on May 9 vs. San Diego for the second-fewest groundballs he has induced this season, one more than his season-low of five groundballs on May 3 at Chicago-AL...his 44.7 groundball percentage this season ranks 17th in the American League (min. 9 GS) and second in the Twins' rotation, trailing Sonny Gray (47.6%)...Varland owns a 42.6 groundball percentage in his career.

STARTING OFF RIGHT: Varland has recorded 71 strikeouts in his first 14 career starts, the fourth-most strikeouts in Twins history through a pitcher's first 14 career starts (since 1961), trailing only Joe Ryan (75 from 2021-22), Tyler Duffey (76 from 2015-16) and Bert Blyleven (78 in 1970)...his 77.2 innings pitched ranks tied for 17th in club history through 14 career starts, and his 4.40 ERA is the 19th-lowest ERA by a Twin through his first 14 career starts.

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 - was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Led all Twins minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1), tied for first in games started (23) and was second in ERA (3.06), second in winning percentage (.615), fourth in opponent batting average (.242) and WHIP (1.26), and tied for fifth in wins (8) in 2022.
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022, one of two pitchers to ever win the award twice, joining José Berrios (2014-15).
- One of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins and one of 16 to pitch...was one of three Minnesota natives on the Twins roster at one point in 2022 (also, Caleb Thielbar and Matt Wallner).
- Named starting pitcher on 2021 Twins MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.
- In 2019, made his professional debut with Rookie-Elizabethton...made three appearances, including one start...struck out 10 batters in 8.2 innings pitched.
- Selected by Twins in 15th round of 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul.
- Debuted wearing uniform number 49, but switched to 37 during 2022-23 offseason when the Twins acquired Pablo López from Miami.
