THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their 10-game homestand... sweeping the Brewers in two games on Tuesday and Wednesday, followed by going 1-3 vs. the Tigers over the last four days... tonight, they will continue the homestand with the first of four against the Red Sox through Thursday afternoon... the Twins have gone 21-17 at home and 15-19 on the road. The Twins are on game seven of a 16 games in 16 days stretch, their next off-day being in Baltimore on June 29... the Twins have 19 games in 21 days leading up to the All-Star Break (July 10-13).

TWINS DROP SERIES TO TIGERS: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-4 as their rally in the bottom of the eighth fell short... they scored three runs in the eighth inning but left the bases loaded... Louie Varland (3-3) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on nine hits in 4.1 innings pitched... Jordan Balazovic made his major league debut with 3.2 scoreless innings of relief, allowing two hits with one walk and two strikeouts... he fanned Spencer Torkelson in the sixth inning for his first career strikeout... the offense recorded seven hits and struck out 14 times... Carlos Correa went 2-for-3 with one walk. Balazovic and Edouard Julien are the second pair of Canadian-born players to debut in the same season for the Twins, joining Rene Tosoni (first game of the doubleheader on April 28) and Scott Diamond (second game of the doubleheader on July 18), who both debuted for Minnesota in 2011.

LOVE THAT DIRTY WATER: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fourth of seven games in 2023... these two played a three-game series at Fenway Park from April 18-20 as the Twins won the middle game by a score of 10-4... Minnesota was outscored in the series 20-19... the Twins last hosted the Red Sox at Target Field for three games from August 29-31, 2022 as the Twins won two of three... Minnesota is 3-1 in their last four against Boston in Minneapolis. Carlos Correa is hitting .307 (55-for-179) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 36 runs scored, 33 walks, a .413 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS in 48 career regular season games against the Red Sox. Max Kepler has reached base in nine of his last 18 plate appearances vs. the Red Sox, recording six hits, drawing one walk and being hit by two pitches... he also has three doubles and one home run in that span.

CHRISTIAN MINGLE: Christian Vázquez was selected by the Red Sox in the ninth round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft and played parts of eight seasons in Boston, hitting .262 (610-for-2329) with 124 doubles, 54 home runs, 266 RBI and 275 runs scored. He still ranks fifth on the Sox all-time list in games caught (651), trailing Jason Varitek (1488), Carlton Fisk (990), Sammy White (967) and Rich Gedman (858). Hit a walk-off homer for Red Sox in 13th inning of 2021 ALDS Game 3 vs. Tampa Bay... caught final pitch of the 2018 World Series, a swinging third strike to Manny Machado. Earned the Unsung Hero Award from the Boston Chapter of the BBWAA following the 2017 season.

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa has recorded an OPS of .990 (.349 OBP / .641 SLG) in his last 10 games, including three doubles, one triple, three home runs and 10 RBI... since May 10, he has raised his batting average 32 points, from .185 to .217 in 30 games... below are his first 32 games and last 30 games (since May 10) by comparison:

EXTRA STRENGTH: 217 of the Twins' 555 hits have gone for extra bases, equaling 39.1% of their hits, second-highest percentage in the AL:

FREE BAGS: The Twins have walked 245 times this season, fifth most in the AL, just ahead of Boston (242)... additionally, they have seen 3.95 pitches-per-plate appearance, second most in the AL, trailing Seattle (3.96), and ahead of Los Angeles (3.95) and Boston (3.93). This month, Donovan Solano leads the team in walks (9) and is tied for 12th in the AL.

LINING UP THE LEFTIES: Today marks the 15th time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter... Twins are 7-7 when a left-hander is the opposing starter. The Twins have the seventh-fewest at-bats in baseball vs. left-handed pitching at just 546... also tied for third-fewest hits (120). Twins are slashing .220/.293/.368 with 17 homers vs. lefties, compared to .233/.315/.406 with 73 homers vs. righties. Donovan Solano is hitting .311 (19-for-61) with eight doubles and an .855 OPS against lefties this season... he ranks eighth in the AL in batting average vs. lefties among players with a minimum of 60 at-bats in such instances.

SOLANO SMOKING: Donovan Solano is leading off for the 12th time this season, third most on the club, trailing Max Kepler (17) and Byron Buxton (13)... Solano has reached safely in each of his last nine games, hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks, a .514 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.181 OPS in that span. Solano is hitting .318 (28-for-88) with 10 RBI, 12 walks and an .821 OPS in 32 games at Target Field this season... his home batting average ranks 11th best in the American League (minimum of 75 at-bats).

TOUCHING BASE WITH ALEX KIRILLOFF: Alex Kirilloff has posted a .410 on-base percentage in his last 20 games, since May 27, reaching base 32 times in 78 plate appearances (18 hits, 12 walks, 2 hit-by-pitch)... in 38 games for the Twins, he has posted a .394 on-base percentage, which is fifth among AL players with a minimum of 130 plate appearances.

RUNNING MEN: Twins have stolen 35 bases in 41 attempts this season, for a 85.4 success rate, best in the AL and second best in baseball, trailing New York-NL (89.5%)... since May 15, they have successfully stolen a club-record 25 consecutive bases, their last caught stealing being Ryan Jeffers on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL (Barnhart/Wesneski)... the longest streak in baseball this season is Tampa Bay's streak of 35, which was snapped on June 11.

KEEPING IT 100: López became the third American League pitcher to reach 100 strikeouts this season in his last start on June 13 vs. Milwaukee...Tuesday marked Lopez's 14th game with the Twins; he is the sixth-fastest pitcher in American League history (since 1901) to reach 100 strikeouts in the AL and the fastest since Gerrit Cole did it in a record 10 games in 2018...also became the fourth pitcher in Twins franchise history (since 1901) to record 100 strikeouts in his first 14 games of a season...here is the complete list:

LAST TIME OUT: Took his third-consecutive no-decision in the Twins' 7-5, walk-off victory over the Milwaukee Brewers at Target Field on June 13; recorded a quality start, pitching 6.0 innings with three runs and four hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts...retired the first six batters he faced with four strikeouts...allowed all three runs in the third inning on two hits and one walk; leftfielder Christian Yelich doubled home two runs and first baseman Rowdy Tellez had an RBI single...held the Brewers hitless for the remainder of his outing, retiring 10 of the final 12 batters he faced; was relieved by José De León to start the seventh inning with Minnesota trailing 3-2...Twins scored four runs in the bottom of the ninth, capped by a two-run, walk-off homer by shortstop Carlos Correa, coming from behind to take the series opener.

- ⌘ Tied his start on May 21 at Los Angeles-AL for his second-highest strikeout total of the year, one shy of his season high of 10 strikeouts on April 11 vs. Chicago-AL.
- ⌘ Through 14 starts this season, López is among the American League leaders in several statistical categories, including strikeouts (101 - 4th), pitches-per-inning (15.5 - 11th), FIP (3.53 - 11th) and innings pitched (84.1 - T-12th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Went 7.0 innings and allowed only one run but took a no-decision in the Twins' 2-1 defeat against the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field on June 7...allowed five hits (1 HR), issued one walk and struck out six batters...pitched opposite Shawn Armstrong who fired 2.0 scoreless innings as an opener...allowed a solo home run to third baseman Isaac Paredes to lead off the second inning, then retired 17 of the final 21 batters he faced from the second through the seventh inning...was relieved by Brock Stewart to begin the eighth inning with Minnesota trailing 1-0; Twins tied the game on an RBI single from third baseman Royce Lewis in the top of the ninth inning, but Jhoan Duran allowed a walkoff solo home run to designated hitter Randy Arozarena in the bottom of the ninth.

- ⌘ Marked just the fourth time in his career that his team lost when he worked at least 7.0 innings and allowed one-or-fewer runs (9-4 team record in 13 career starts under those parameters).
- ⌘ Picked off shortstop Wander Franco in the third inning; was his third pickoff of the season (2 at Miami on April 5), tied with KC's Taylor Clarke for the most in the American League this year.

LÓPEZ VS. BOSTON: Facing the Red Sox for the first time in his career tonight...Boston will become the 27th team he has faced in the majors; has also yet to face Detroit, Seattle and Minnesota in his career...in 26 career starts when facing a new opponent, he is 9-7 with a 3.32 ERA (152.0 IP, 56 ER), 31 walks and 151 strikeouts...tonight will be his 12th career start vs. an American League East opponent, having faced Tampa Bay six times, New York-AL twice, Toronto twice and Baltimore once previously; is 3-4, 3.16 ERA (62.2 IP, 22 ER) with 12 walks and 68 strikeouts in 11 career starts vs. the AL East.

- ⌘ Boston outfielder Adam Duvall has had the most success vs. López among the six Red Sox batters who have faced him previously, going 3-for-4 with one double, one RBI and two walks in six plate appearances.

EXTENDED STAY: Making his eighth home start of 2023 in the seventh game of the Twins' season-long-tying 10-game homestand...has gone 2-1 with a 5.88 ERA (41.1 IP, 27 ER), 13 walks and 51 strikeouts in his first seven home outings...despite López having the second-highest home ERA among qualified pitchers in the American League (DET's Joey Wentz - 6.29), the Twins have gone 6-1 in his seven home starts as the offense has provided him with an average of 5.66 runs of support at Target Field...in seven road starts this year, he is 1-2 with a 2.72 ERA (43.0 IP, 13 ER), 10 walks and 50 strikeouts; Minnesota owns a 2-5 record in his seven starts away from Target Field in 2023, with López receiving only 1.67 runs of support on average.

- ⌘ In 57 career home starts, he is 16-16, 3.76 ERA (325.1 IP, 136 ER) with 92 walks and 519 strikeouts...is 15-18, 4.25 ERA (269.0 IP, 127 ER) with 73 walks and 271 strikeouts in 31 career road starts.

RIGHT ON: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .197 (35-for-178) batting average this season; with right-handed hitters going 0-for-12 with six strikeouts against him in his last start on June 13 vs. Milwaukee...his 65 strikeouts against righties are the fourth most in the American League this year, trailing only TB's Shane Bieber (83), HOU's Framber Valdez (80) and TOR's Kevin Gausman (73)...his .197 opponent batting average vs. righties this season ranks seventh in the AL (min. 10 GS)...left-handed hitters are batting at a .265 (36-for-136) clip against him in 2023...over his career, he has better numbers against right-handed hitters (.654 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.745 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in his first 14 starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...threw 17 curveballs in his last start on June 13 vs. Milwaukee, the second-most curveballs he has thrown in a start this season (19 vs. Kansas City on April 28)...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

- ⌘ In his first 14 starts this year, López has an average fastball velocity of 94.8 mph, a 2.1 mph increase from last season and the largest year-to-year jump of his career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2023: 4-3, 2.65 ERA // CAREER: 9-9, 3.50 ERA)

Bailey Ober is set to start the second game of the four-game series against the Boston Red Sox at Target Field tomorrow night...earned the win in his last start on June 14 vs. Milwaukee, going 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on six hits (2 HR) with one walk and seven strikeouts as the Twins won 4-2 and swept the two-game series...has pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his 10 starts this season with a WHIP of 0.99; is one of six pitchers in baseball with a WHIP under 1.00 this year (min. 10 GS)...facing the Red Sox for the third time in his career, having faced Boston once in 2021 and once last season; went 0-1, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts in those two games, with the Twins going 1-1...facing Boston at Target Field for the first time in his career.

- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as number two starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
- In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
- Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings and allowing three hits and two runs while striking out seven in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
- Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
- In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59).
- Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
- Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
- Started 2018 season with Double-A Jacksonville, earning Southern League Midseason All-Star honors before being promoted to Triple-A New Orleans.
- Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Brayan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
