the Twins from 1986-87...during the 1987 regular season, Frazier went $5-5,4.98$ ERA ( 81.1 IP, 45 ER) with two saves, 51 walks and 58 strikeouts in 54 games - third most appearances on the club, behind' Jeff Reardon (63), and Keith Atherton (59)'..he made one appearance during the Twins' 1987 Postseason run, pitching in Game 4 of the World Series at St. Louis, throwing 2.0 shutout innings.

LAST START: Snapped a career-high three-game losing streak after earning the 4-2 Twins win against Milwaukee at Target Field on June 14...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (2 HR), issued one walk and fanned seven batters.... permitted his only runs on back-to-back homers by Brian Anderson and Luis Urías in the second inning; marked the second time in his career that he allowed back-to-back home runs (also, July 10, 2021 vs. Detroit - Niko Goodrum and Zack Short)...retired 13 of the last 16 batters he faced...struck out a season-high seven batters for the third time this season, (also, June 8 at Tampa Bay and May 28 vs. Toronto)... relieved by Brock Stewart in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...Griffin Jax entered in the ninth inning and recorded his first save of the season.
