THE TWINS: Have gone 3-4 through seven games on their 10-game homestand, going 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 1-3 vs. Detroit and 0-1 vs. Boston...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of four against the Red Sox through Thursday afternoon...the Twins have gone 21-18 at home and 15-19 on the road.
The Twins are on game eight of a 16 games in 16 days stretch, their next off-day being in Baltimore on June 29...the Twins have 18 games in 20 days leading up to the All-Star Break (July 10-13).
The Twins are looking to avoid falling to a low-water mark of two games under .500 tonight, which would be their lowest since finishing the 2022 season 78-84.

TWINS DROP OPENER TO SOX: The Twins lost to the Red Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 9-3, suffering their fourth loss in their last five games and 10th loss in their last 15. Pablo Lopez (3-4) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs (4 earned) on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with three walks and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Willi Castro...the only extra-base hit for Minnesota was a three-run homer by Christian Vazquez in the fifth inning, his first of the season; Vazquez's three RBI marked a season-high.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Oliver Ortega from Triple-A St. Paul. Ortega, 26, has appeared in 16 games for the Saints this season, going 3-0, 2.42 ERA (22.1 IP, 6 ER), two saves, seven walks, 28 strikeouts, a 1.03 WHIP and a .203 (16-for-79) BAA, including striking out 11 of his last 27 batters faced since June 8...the 6-foot, 204-pound right-hander was originally acquired by the Twins via waiver claim on January 6 from the Los Angeles Angels...the Nagua, Dominican Republic native has appeared in 35 major league games across parts of two seasons with the Angels from 2021-22, going 2-3, 3.95 ERA (43.1 IP, 19 ER), 20 walks and 37 strikeouts.
To make room for Ortega on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Louie Varland to St. Paul...Varland has made 10 starts over two stints with the Twins this season, going 3-3, 5.30 ERA (56.0 IP, 33 ER), 16 walks and 54 strikeouts.
To make room for Ortega on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated outfielder Kyle Garlick for release or assignment...Garlick has played in 14 games over three stints with the Twins this season, hitting .179 (5-for-28) with one double, two home runs, four RBI, two runs scored and two walks.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fifth of seven games in 2023...the Twins are 1-3 against Boston this season, going 1-2 at Fenway Park from April 18-20, followed by a loss last night at Target Field.
Carlos Correa is hitting .306 (56-for-183) with eight doubles, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 36 runs scored, 33 walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .514 slugging percentage and a .924 OPS in 49 career regular season games against the Red Sox.
Max Kepler has reached base in nine of his last 18 plate appearances vs. the Red Sox, recording six hits, drawing one walk and being hit by two pitches...he also has three doubles and one home run in that span.

WE CC YOU 'LOS: Carlos Correa has recorded an OPS of .945 (.340 OBP / .605 SLG) in his last 11 games, including three doubles, one triple, three home runs and 10 RBI...since May 10, he has raised his batting average 33 points, from .185 to .218 in 31 games...below are his first 32 games and last 31 games (since May 10) by comparison:

DONNIE BASEBALL: Donovan Solano has reached safely in each of his last 10 games, hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks, a .475 on-base percentage, a .594 slugging percentage and a 1.069 OPS in that span.
Solano is hitting .312 (29-for-93) with 10 RBI, 12 walks and an .800 OPS in 33 games at Target Field this season...his home batting average ranks 13th best in the American League (minimum of 75 at-bats).
This month, Donovan Solano leads the team in walks (9) and is tied for 12th in the AL.

EXTRA STRENGTH: 218 of the Twins' 562 hits have gone for extra bases, equaling 38.8% of their hits, third-highest percentage in the AL:

RUNNING MEN: Twins have stolen 35 bases in 41 attempts this season, for a 85.4 success rate, best in the AL and second best in baseball, trailing New York-NL (89.7%)...since May 15, they have successfully stolen a club-record 25 consecutive bases, their last caught stealing being Ryan Jeffers on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL (Barnhart/Wesneski).

WILLI WORLD: Willi Castro has hit safely in four-straight games, hitting .429 (6-for-14) with a 1.038 OPS in that span...in his last 22 games (since May 24), he is hitting .299 (20-for-67) with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, eight stolen bases (0 caught) and an .829 OPS.

RIP, GEORGE FRAZIER: Former Twins right-handed pitcher and 1987 World Series Champion George Frazier passed away on Monday at the age of 68 in Tulsa, Oklahoma...Frazier was acquired by the Twins via trade with Chicago-NL on August 13, 1986, along with Julius McDougal and Ray Fontenot, in exchange for Dewayne Coleman and Ron Davis...Frazier spent his final two major leagues seasons with the Twins from 1986-87...during the 1987 regular season, Frazier went 5-5, 4.98 ERA (81.1 IP, 45 ER) with two saves, 51 walks and 58 strikeouts in 54 games...third most appearances on the club, behind Jeff Reardon (63) and Keith Atherton (59)...he made one appearance during the Twins' 1987 Postseason run, pitching in Game 4 of the World Series at St. Louis, throwing 2.0 shutout innings.

MINOR MATTERS: Triple-A St. Paul catcher/first baseman Chris Williams yesterday was named International League Player of the Week and Double-A Wichita left-handed pitcher Aaron Rozek was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week.
Williams played in five games for the Saints, hitting .368 (7-for-19) with five walks, six home runs, a .500 on-base percentage, a 1.316 slugging percentage and a 1.816 OPS...he led the IL in home runs and RBI (14)...Williams joined Matt Wallner (May 30-June 4) as the second Saints player to earn IL Player of the Week honors this season.
Rozek made one start for the Wind Surge on Wednesday, June 14 at Midland and pitched 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and five strikeouts, earning the victory...the Burnsville, Minnesota native was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in June of 2021.

BIRTHDAY SHOUTS: Twins assistant pitching coach Luis Ramirez is celebrating his 50th birthday today...Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Ronny Henriquez is celebrating his 23rd birthday today...Henriquez, who is on the club's 40-man roster, has appeared in 11 games for the Saints this season, going 3-1, 8.15 ERA (17.2 IP, 16 ER), with 16 walks and 15 strikeouts.

LAST START: Snapped a career-high three-game losing streak after earning the 4-2 Twins win against Milwaukee at Target Field on June 14...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (2 HR), issued one walk and fanned seven batters...permitted his only runs on back-to-back homers by Brian Anderson and Luis Urias in the second inning; marked the second time in his career that he allowed back-to-back home runs (also, July 10, 2021 vs. Detroit - Niko Goodrum and Zack Short)...retired 13 of the last 16 batters he faced...struck out a season-high seven batters for the third time this season, (also, June 8 at Tampa Bay and May 28 vs. Toronto)...relieved by Brock Stewart in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...Griffin Jax entered in the ninth inning and recorded his first save of the season.

☞ The Twins are 19-11 when Ober issues one-or-fewer walks in a start, he is 6-5, 2.83 ERA (155.2 IP, 49 ER) with 19 walks and 156 strikeouts in those 30 games.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his third loss of the season in a 4-2 Twins defeat against the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field on June 8, opposite Yonny Chirinos...pitched 5.1 innings and allowed four runs (3 earned) on three hits, issued two walks and tied a season high with seven strikeouts...tossed 3.0 perfect innings before issuing a walk in the fourth inning to outfielder Randy Arozarena who scored on an RBI triple by first baseman Luke Raley...also yielded a two-run home run to designated hitter Harold Ramirez...relieved in the sixth inning by Griffin Jax after allowing a single and a walk...shortstop Wander Franco crossed home on a throwing error by Jax after stealing third base...José De León closed the game by pitching 2.0 scoreless innings as the Twins were swept in three games.

OBER VS. BOSTON: Facing the Red Sox for the first time this season and the third time in his career; is 0-1, 0.00 ERA (11.0 IP, 0 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts in two previous starts...last faced Boston on April 17, 2022 at Fenway Park; did not factor into the decision after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing two runs (0 ER) on four hits, walking one batter and striking out three...allowed both runs in the sixth inning...Rafael Devers reached first on an error by Miguel Sanó, followed by a double by Xander Bogaerts, finally allowed consecutive sacrifice flies to J.D. Martinez and Alex Verdugo...relieved by Tyler Duffey in the seventh inning...Caleb Thielbar entered in the eighth inning and allowed two runs via an RBI single by Bogaerts and an RBI double by Martinez...replaced by Cody Stashak who allowed three runs (two RBI singles from Trevor Story and Jackie Bradley Jr. and a sacrifice fly by Kevin Plawecki).

☞ Making his first career start against the Red Sox at Target Field.

BACK HOME: Ober is making his eighth home start this season, 23rd of his career...in his seven previous home starts this season, Ober is 2-2, 2.97 ERA (39.1 IP, 13 ER) with 10 walks and 35 strikeouts...is 6-3, 3.56 ERA (111.1 IP, 44 ER) with 27 walks and 112 strikeouts in 22 career home starts...Twins have gone 14-8 in his home starts.

☞ Owns the fourth-most strikeouts through a pitcher's first 22 home games in Twins history (since 1961), trailing Joe Ryan (136), José Berríos (124) and Francisco Liriano (118).

LEFT AND RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are batting .209 (23-for-110) with 26 strikeouts and 10 walks against Ober after 10 starts this season...right-handed hitters are hitting .204 (20-for-98) with 28 strikeouts and four walks...in his career, left-handed hitters are batting .256/.320/.418 with 84 strikeouts against Ober...righties are hitting .219/.242/.416 with 117 strikeouts off him.

☞ Owns the ninth-lowest opponent batting average against righties in the American League...ranks 11th in all of baseball (min 55.0 IP).

☞ Tied for the 19th-lowest opponent batting average against righties in the American League since 2021...tied for 23rd in all of baseball (min 205.0 IP).

ARSENAL: Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his 10 starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...five out of the seven strikeouts he recorded in his last start came from changeups...mostly uses his slider (164 pitches) against righties while relying on his changeup (162 pitches) and curveball (60 pitches) against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire:

THE CHASE: According to Baseball Savant, Ober owns a 34.8 chase percentage this season, ranking in the 94th percentile in baseball...ranks third on the Twin's pitching staff, trailing Joe Ryan (37.2) and Pablo López (35.3).

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
