TWINS PUT BOWTIE ON DETROIT: The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Comerica Park by a score of 6-3 in 10 innings, making them 8-3 in extras this season...the win made them 11-11-3 in series play (4-7-1 on the road)...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and a season-high eight strikeouts — the second most of his career (10 on 927/22 vs. CWS)...five relievers (Balazovic, Headrick, Stewart, Jax & Duran) combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Royce Lewis (all singles)...they also went 5-for-13 with runners in scoring position.

COR-HEY YA!: Carlos Correa has recorded an OPS of .836 (.292 OBP / .544 SLG) in his last 17 games, including three doubles, one triple, five home runs and 13 RBI in that span... additionally, Correa has reached safely in 11-straight Interleague games (.340 OBP).

ATLiens: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 20th, 21st and 22nd times in their history this week and first time since August 5-7, 2019 at Target Field as the Twins won the first game but lost games two and three...the Twins are 8-11 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 6-8 in Minnesota and 2-3 in Georgia.

◆ This marks the Twins' first time at Truist Park and just the third time playing in the regular season at Atlanta, the previous two being at Turner Field in 2013 (0-3) and 2016 (2-0).

ROSIES: Eddie Rosario was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft...Rosie played six seasons with the Twins from 2015-20, hitting 277 (738-for-261) with 134 doubles, 22 triples, 119 home runs, 388 RBI, 400 runs scored and a .788 OPS in 697 games...he was one of the leaders of the 2019 Bomba Squad, hitting a career-high 32 home runs that season, with 109 RBI...he still ranks 16th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961) with 119 home runs; he also ranks ninth on the club's all-time outfield assists list with 53...he ranks second on the club's all-time list in games played in leftfield with 581, trailing Dan Gladden (621).

INTERLEAGUE PLAYER'S BALL: The Twins have gone 10-10 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco and 2-0 vs. Milwaukee...10 wins already passes their 2022 total of eight...after this series, the Twins' next NL opponent will be the Cardinals for three games at Busch Stadium from August 1-3.

SPEAKERBUXXX: Byron Buxton enters today having gone 0-for-9 in his last three games after going 5-for-11 with one double, three home runs and four RBI in his previous three games leading up to this current stretch...the Twins are 20-12 when Buck gets at least one hit...Buck grew up in Baxley, GA and attended Appling County High School, which is approximately 215 miles south-east of Truist Park.

EL-LEW-VATORS (ME & YOU): Royce Lewis has reached base safely in a career-best 10-straight games, hitting .371 (13-for-35) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, three walks, a .421 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .992 OPS in that span...in nine road games for the Twins this season, he is hitting .432 (16-for-37) with a 1.069 OPS.

◆ Among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 75 at-bats, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.333), second in runs created-per-27 (8.23), fifth in OPS (.863) and OPS+ (139.2), sixth in slugging (.506) and wOBA (.373), and ninth in on-base percentage (.357).

B.0.B.: The Twins have homered 103 times this season, fourth most in the AL and seventh most in baseball (Braves rank first with 139)... the Twins have 19 different players with a home run this season, the most in baseball...next are the Yankees and Brewers, both with 18... the most players to homer in one season for the Twins was 21, in 2004 and 2022.

AINT NOBODY DOPE AS ME, I'M JUST SOL FRESH, SOL CLEAN: Donovan Solano hit his third home run of the season yesterday, all three coming in his last 13 games...in 22 games this month, Solano has posted a .425 on-base percentage, reaching 34 times in 80 plate appearances (18 hits, 14 walks, 2 HBP)...his June OBP ranks third in the AL (minimum 50 at-bats), trailing Shohei Ohtani (.452) and Corey Seager (.441)...he has also drove in 10 runs in June and posted a .909 OPS.

COOLER THAN A POLAR BEAR'S TOENAILS: Edouard Julien went 2-for-4 with a walk yesterday afternoon, giving him nine multi-hit games in 32 total chances...it also marked his fifth time this season reaching base three times in one game...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 10, Julien is hitting .289 (13-for-45) with six doubles, six walks, a .373 on-base percentage and a .795 OPS in 13 games.

GASOLINE DREAMS: Jhoan Duran topped out at 103.0 mph yesterday afternoon, giving him 33 pitches this season at 103.0-or-faster...on the season, he has thrown 231 of his 483 pitches at 100-plus mph, trailing Jordan Hicks (321) for most in baseball...he has averaged 101.9 mph on his fastball this season (highest in MLB), 88.0 mph on his curveball (2nd highest in MLB) and 98.8 mph on his splitter (1st in MLB)...he earned his 11th save yesterday and is one of three pitchers in baseball with at least 10 saves and an ERA under 1.50, joining Felix Bautista and Josh Hader.

TWO DOPE BOYZ: High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Tanner Schobel has been named Midwest League Player of the Week and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week.

◆ Schobel played in five games for the Kernels, hitting, 421 (8-for-19) with four home runs, eight RBI, three walks and a 1.658 OPS.

◆ Culpepper made one start on Sunday at Tampa, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and five strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his third-consecutive no-decision in his last start on June 21 vs. Boston at Target Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in a 10-inning 5-4 Twins' victory...tossed 92 pitches, his most since May 23 vs. San Francisco when he threw 105 pitches...yielded an RBI double to infielder Rafael Devers in the top of the first inning; marked the first run he has allowed in the first inning since April 18 at Boston...allowed his second home run of the season to designated hitter Justin Turner in the third inning...permitted an RBI single in the fifth inning to Turner for his final run...relieved by Brock Stewart who combined with Griffin Jax to pitch scoreless sixth and seventh innings...lhoan Duran entered in the eighth inning and allowed a game-tying RBI double to Triston Casas...the Twins entered extra innings and walked off in the 10th inning via an RBI single by Kyle Farmer, his second-walk off plate appearance of the season.

Gray has not earned a win in his last nine starts, last earning a victory on April 30 vs. Kansas City; the nine-start streak without a win is the fourth longest of his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on June 15 vs. Detroit at Target Field...pitched a season-low-tying 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits, with a season-high-tying four a season-low-tying 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits, with a season-high-tying four walks and three strikeouts in an 8-4 Twins' defeat...marked his shortest start since also throwing 4.0 innings on May 17 at Los Angeles-NL...issued four walks for the first time since his first start of the year on April 1 at Kansas City, which was also the last time he walked more batters than he struck out (4 BB, 1 K)...yielded an RBI single to outfielder Matt Vierling in the second inning...escaped a bases-loaded, no-out jam with just one run allowed in the fourth inning, as shortstop Javier Báez scored on a double play groundout by designated hitter Miguel Cabrera...relieved in the fifth inning by Jovani Moran who allowed three runs on three hits (a two-run triple by Javier Báez and an RBI groundout by Eric Haase)...Jorge López entered in the eighth inning, went back on the mound for the ninth and allowed three runs on two-consecutive RBI doubles to Spencer Torkelson and Zack Short.

AGAINST ATLANTA: Gray is facing the Brayes for the sixth time in his career, going 0-2, 3,23 ERA (30,2 IP, 11 ER) with nine walks and 33 strikeouts in his five previous appearances...last faced Atlanta on August 10, 2021 at Truist Park; did not factor into the decision in the 3-2 Cincinnati defeat after pitching 5.0 innings and allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR), issuing three walks and striking out eight batters...his lone blemish was a game-tying two-run home run to leftfield by Adam Duvall in the fourth inning...retired 11 of the first 15 batters he faced before the home run...relieved by Heath Hembree in the sixth inning, who allowed two base runners...replaced by Amir Garrett who issued a game-winning bases-loaded walk.

◆ Currently holds the 12th-lowest road ERA in the American League this season (min. 30.0 IP).

◆ Making his third career start at Truist Park…is 0-0, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven walks

THE ARSENAL: Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his fastball the most at 22.4 percent...threw 36 fastballs in his last start on June 21, the most he has tossed so far this season...allowed his second home run of the season on a sinker...primarily uses his curveball (181 pitches) and changeup (89 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (177 pitches), sinker (219 pitches) and sweeper (191 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:
