THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Detroit over the weekend, followed by a loss in Atlanta last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three in Atlanta through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Baltimore to enjoy an off-day on Thursday then play three games against the Orioles over the weekend...the Twins have gone 23-19 at home and 17-21 on the road.

♣ The Twins are on game 15 of a 16 games in 16 days stretch, their next off-day being in Baltimore on Thursday...the Twins have 11 games in 13 days leading up to the All-Star Break (July 10-13).

SORRY MS. JACKSON: The Twins lost to the Braves last night at Truist Park by a score of 4-1... Sonny Gray (4-2) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on seven hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the score was locked at 1-1 until a three-run seventh inning from Atlanta, highlighted by homers from Marcell Ozuna (solo) and Ronald Acuña Jr. (2-run)...the offense recorded six hits, walked twice and struck out 12 times...Joey Gallo provided the only offense for the Twins, hitting a solo home run in the second inning.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to June 26) with right elbow soreness...Stewart has appeared in 25 games for the Twins this season, going 2-0, 0.70 ERA (25.2 IP, 2 ER), one save, seven holds, 11 walks, 35 strikeouts, a .172 (15-for-87) opponent batting average and a 12.3 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio... to replace Stewart on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Oliver Ortega from Triple-A St. Paul...Ortega appeared in one game for the Twins on June 20 vs. Boston, allowing two runs on one hit in 1.0 inning pitched, with one walk and one strikeout...he has appeared in 17 games for the Saints this season, going 3-0 with a 2.22 ERA (24.1 IP, 6 ER), eight walks and 29 strikeouts.

INTERLEAGUE INFO: The Twins have gone 10-11 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee and 0-1 at Atlanta...10 wins already passes their 2022 total of eight...after this series, the Twins' next NL opponent will be the Cardinals for three games at Busch Stadium from August 1-3.

JOEY LONGBALLS: Joey Gallo hit his 13th home run last night, tying Byron Buxton for team lead...it also marked the 33rd of his career in Interleague Play...Gallo has an average exit velocity of 93.8 mph, ranking sixth best in the AL and ninth best in baseball...additionally, he ranks third in baseball in hard hit percentage at 59.1%...nine of Gallo's 13 home runs have come off fastballs and four off breaking pitches.

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis has reached base safely in a career-best 10-straight games, hitting .371 (13-for-35) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, three walks, a .421 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .992 OPS in that span...in nine road games for the Twins this season, he is hitting .432 (16-for-37) with a 1.069 OPS.

◆ Among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 75 at-bats, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.333), second in runs created-per-27 (8.24), fourth in OPS+ (139.1), fifth in OPS (.863), sixth in slugging (.506), seventh in wOBA (.373), and 10th in on-base percentage (.357).

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 104 times this season, tied for fourth most in the AL and tied for seventh most in baseball (Braves rank first with 141)...the Twins have 19 different players with a home run this season, the most in baseball...next are the Yankees and Brewers, both with 18...the most players to homer in one season for the Twins was 21, in 2004 and 2022.

RUN THE JULS: Last night, Edouard Julien recorded his second-straight multi-hit game and third in his last five starts...he now has 10 multi-hit games in 33 total chances...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 10, Julien is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with six doubles, six walks, a .382 on-base percentage and an .810 OPS in 14 games.

♣ Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 100 at-bats, he ranks fifth in slugging percentage (.441) and on-base percentage (.341).

DURANTULA: Jhoan Duran topped out at 103.0 mph on Sunday afternoon vs. Detroit, giving him 33 pitches this season at 103.0-or-faster. on the season, he has thrown 232 of his 483 pitches at 100-plus mph, trailing Jordan Hicks (321) for most in baseball...he has average 101.9 mph on his fastball this season (highest in MLB), 88.0 mph on his curveball (2nd highest in MLB) and 98.8 mph on his splitte (1st in MLB)...he earned his 11th save on Sunday and is one of three pitchers in baseball with at least 10 saves and an ERA under 1.50 joining Félix Bautista and Josh Hader.

FESTAVAL: Rosters for the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, which will be played at 7:00 p.m. (ET)/4:00 p.m. (PT) on Saturday, July 8 at T-Mobile Park in Seattle, were announced last night by Major League Baseball...Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher David Festa will represent the Twins for the AL team...the 23-year-old has made 12 starts for the Wind Surge this season, going 2-2, 5.12 ERA (51.0 IP, 29 ER), with 22 walks and 64 strikeouts...the Verona, NJ native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University...he is currently ranked as the club's 10th best prospect by MLB.com.

A COMPLETE EXPERIENCE: Ryan pitched his first career complete-game shutout in his last start on June 22 vs. Boston at Target Field, as Minnesota won 6-0 in the series finale to split the four-game set...allowed just three hits and struck out nine batters without issuing a walk in 9.0 innings... retired 20 of the first 21 batters he faced, allowing only a fourth-inning single to designated hitter Justin Turner in that span...allowed one single in the seventh and eighth innings but stranded both runners...sent down the Red Sox in order in the ninth inning, retiring leftfielder Masataka Yoshida on a flyout to leftfield to finish the shutout.

Became the first Twins pitcher with a complete game since José Berríos on June 7, 2018 vs. Chicago-AL, ending a 724-game span between complete games for Minnesota...also became the first Twin with a complete-game shutout since Berrios blanked the Orioles 7-0 on April 1, 2018 in Baltimore.

Threw a career-high 112 pitches, surpassing his previous high of 110 on August 9, 2022 at Los Angeles-NL...also pitched into the ninth inning for the first time in his career, besting his 7.2-inning start on September 18, 2022 at Cleveland for his longest career outing by innings.

Snapped his career-long three-decision losing streak...also did not issue a walk in back-to-back starts for the first time in his career.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on June 16 vs. Detroit at Target Field in the Twins' 7-1 defeat; pitched 7.0 innings, allowing a season-high six runs on seven hits (2 HR), with no walks and seven strike-outs...allowed five runs in the top of the third inning on four singles, a sacrifice fly by designated hitter Kerry Carpenter and a three-run homer by shortstop Javier Báez...allowed a solo home run to centerfielder Matt Vierling in the top of the fourth...needed only 35 pitches to toss 3.0 scoreless runnings from the fifth through the seventh innings...was relieved by Josh Winder to start the top of the eighth with Minnesota trailing 6-1...Twins scored only one run as Detroit took the second game of the four-game series.

4 Allowed multiple homers for the second time this season (also, 2 on May 30 at Houston) and sixth time in his career; Twins have gone 0-6 when Ryan allows multiple homers in his career.

BRAND NEW BRAVES: Facing Atlanta for the first time in his career...the Braves will become the 19th team he has faced in the majors; he is 5-7, 5.01 ERA (91.2 IP, 51 ER) with 36 walks and 80 strikeouts in 18 previous starts when facing a new opponent...has never faced any current Atlanta hitters in his career...tonight also marks his first start against a National League East division opponent; the NL East is the only division he has yet to face since debuting in 2021.

RYAN ON THE ROAD: Making his team-leading ninth road start of the season tonight...has recorded seven quality starts in eight outings away from Target Field this year, going 3-2, 3.26 ERA (47.0 IP, 17 ER) with 10 walks and 49 strikeouts...tied with CHC's Marcus Stroman and SEA's George Kirby for the most quality starts on the road in baseball this season...Twins have gone 4-4 in his eight road starts, winning his last road start on June 10 at Toronto (9-4) after losing each of his previous four road starts...Ryan is seeking his first personal road win since April 19 at Boston (6.0 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K)...he is 5-2 with a 2.70 ERA (46.2 IP, 14 ER), five walks and 51 strikeouts in seven home starts in 2023.

\$\Phi\$ Ryan is 11-6, 3.59 ERA (123.0 IP, 49 ER) with 29 walks and 125 strikeouts in 22 career road starts...is 12-7, 3.24 ERA (144.1 IP, 52 ER) with 38 walks and 156 strikeouts in 25 home starts.

\$\Phi\$ Making his first career start at Truist Park tonight, Atlanta's home ballpark will become the 16th ballpark he has pitched at since his debut in 2021...in 15 previous starts when pitching at a new ballpark, he is 5-6, 5.10 ERA (77.2 IP, 44 ER) with 19 walks and 81 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are batting just .190 (31-for-163) with a .494 OPS and 37 strikeouts against Ryan this year...his .494 opponent OPS against lefties is the third-lowest in the American League this season (min. 8 GS)...right-handed hitters are hitting .214 (39-for-182) with a .596 OPS and 63 strikeouts, going just 1-for-13 (.077) with five strikeouts against Ryan in his last start on June 22 vs. Boston...his .203 (70-for-345) overall opponent batting average in 2023 ranks third in the American League and fourth in all of baseball, among qualified pitchers.

© Over his career, Ryan has slightly better splits against left-handed hitters than righties, with lefties batting just .193 (92-for-477) with a .584 OPS since his debut in 2021...right-handed hitters are hitting .214 (109-for-509) with a .642 OPS off Ryan.

- 2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020. In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).

 Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).

 Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics... went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.

 Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz... learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.

 In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by Baseball America as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
