THE TWINS: After completing their short three-game roadtrip in Houston with a record of 2-1, the Twins began their quick four-game homestand against the Guardians with consecutive victories the last two nights...

TWINS BLANK THE GUARDS: The Twins shut out the Guardians last night at Target Field by a score of 1-0, Minnesota's first 1-0 win this season and first since June 23, 2022 vs. Cleveland...

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the sixth of 13 times in 2023...the Twins are 3-2 vs. the Guardians this season, going 1-2 at Progressive Field from May 5-7 and 2-0 at Target Field...

SONNY HAS BEEN GRAY: Through 11 starts, Sonny Gray has gone 4-0, 1.94 ERA (60.1 IP, 13 ER) with 24 walks and 69 strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .215 (48-for-223) batting average...

THE LEFTORIUM: Tonight marks the 11th time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter...Twins are 5-5 when a left-hander is the opposing starter...

2023 PCF HOME RUN CHALLENGE: Beginning tonight through Father's Day on Sunday, June 18, the Twins organization has pledged \$7,500 to the Prostate Cancer Foundation (PCF) for every home run hit by a Twins player during those 12 games...

HAPPY JEFFIN' BIRTHDAY!!: Happy birthday to catcher Ryan Jeffers, who turns 26 today...Jeffers has played in two career games on his birthday, going 2-for-8 with two singles...

TWINS ML MONTHLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Kala'i Rosario and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for May...

- Enters today leading all qualified American League pitchers in ERA (1.94) and FIP (2.15), while ranking fourth in WAR (2.5).
- Making his 259th career appearance and 250th career start...also his 12th start/appearance this season.
- Facing Cleveland for the second time this season and 17th in his career; is 6-4, 3.63 ERA (86.2 IP, 35 ER) with 34 walks and 89 strikeouts...looking for his first win against the Guardians at home since August 2, 2020.
- Making his seventh start at home this season; is 7-2, 2.18 ERA (103.0 IP, 25 ER) with 34 walks and 126 strikeouts in 19 home starts since joining the Twins.
- Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision against the Houston Astros on May 29 at Minute Maid Park, opposite J.P. France...pitched 6.0-plus innings and allowed three runs (2 ER) on four hits, with two walks and three strikeouts...allowed his first run on a groundball double play to outfielder Kyle Tucker in the fourth inning...lifted from the seventh inning after a double from Tucker and issuing a walk to infielder José Abreu...replaced by Brock Stewart, who yielded a go-ahead grand slam to second baseman Jose Altuve (two runs charged to Gray)...Jorge López (1.0 IP) and Jhoan Duran (2.0 IP) combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins tied the game in the ninth inning via an RBI single from Royce Lewis off Ryan Pressly and won the game in the 10th inning after a two-run home run by Ryan Jeffers off Bryan Abreu.

Ended the month of May with zero decisions...is the only pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to go decisionless in any month in which he made at least five starts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision against the San Francisco Giants on May 23 at Target Field, opposite Alex Cobb...pitched 5.0-plus innings, allowing two runs on six hits, with two walks and six strikeouts...tossed 105 pitches, his second time tossing over 100 pitches this season (also, season-high 107 on April 24 vs. New York-AL)...retired 16 of the first 20 batters he faced...lifted from the game in the sixth inning after loading the bases with two walk and one double...Jovani Moran entered in relief and issued a bases-loaded walk to catcher Patrick Bailey...Brock Stewart replaced Moran and also issued a bases-loaded walk to outfielder Bryce Johnson (both runs were charged to Gray)...marked the first time the Twins issued multiple bases-loaded walks in the same inning since September 8, 2020 at St. Louis when Randy Dobnak and Caleb Thielbar issued two walks in the bottom of the third inning...Jorge López entered in the seventh inning and yielded the final runs scored via a two-run home run to outfielder Michael Conforto.

11:11: Gray holds the fourth-lowest ERA through a pitcher's first 11 starts of the season in Twins history (1961-), trailing Scott Erickson (1.58, 1991), Ervin Santana (1.75, 2017) and Bert Blyleven (1.81, 1971)...has also allowed the lowest number of earned runs in their first 11 starts...is the only pitcher in the majors who has yet to allow a home run this season...is only the fifth pitcher in the Wild Card era (1995-) to allow zero home runs through their first 11 starts of the year (min 60.0 IP), alongside Zack Greinke (2009), Brad Penny (2007), Derek Lowe (2002) and Jeff Weaver (2002).

AGAINST CLEVELAND: Gray is facing the Guardians for the 17th time in his career, going 6-4, 3.63 ERA (86.2 IP, 35 ER) with 34 walks and 89 strikeouts in his 16 previous appearances (all starts)...last faced Cleveland on May 6 at Progressive Field, taking a no-decision in a 4-3 Twins defeat after allowing three runs on four hits with three walks and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...yielded all three runs in the fourth inning (consecutive RBI singles to Josh Naylor and Josh Bell, followed by a bases-loaded walk to Myles Straw)...relieved Jorge Alcala in the sixth inning who allowed a solo home run to Steven Kwan in the seventh inning...Jovani Moran then pitched a scoreless eighth inning.

- Looking for his first win against the Guardians since June 27, 2022 when he led the Twins to an 11-1 win at Progressive Field after pitching 7.0 shutout innings and allowing three hits with one walk and three strikeouts.
- Has not earned a win at home against the Guardians since August 3, 2020 with Cincinnati (6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 R, 1 HR, 2 BB, 8 K)...is 3-0, 2.27 ERA (43.2 IP, 11 ER) with 18 walks and 52 strikeouts in home starts against Cleveland.
- Holds the fourth-most strikeouts against the Guardians since 2014 trailing only Carlos Rodón (124), Justin Verlander (115) and Chris Sale (90).

BULLSEYE: Gray is making his seventh home start of the season today, going 3-0, 1.27 ERA (35.1 IP, 5 ER) with nine walks and 48 strikeouts in his six prior home outings...went 4-2, 2.66 ERA (67.2 IP, 20 ER) with 25 walks and 78 strikeouts in 13 home starts in 2022 and is 53-38, 3.72 ERA (763.2 IP, 316 ER) with 256 walks and 749 strikeouts in 135 career home appearances, including 131 starts.

- Is 7-2, 2.18 ERA (103.0 IP, 25 ER) with 34 walks and 126 strikeouts in 19 home starts since becoming a Twin...has the most strikeouts and lowest ERA through their first 19 home games in Twins history (min 100.0 IP).
- Holds the third-lowest ERA at home in baseball this season (min 35.0 IP), trailing Arizona's Zac Gallen (0.66) and Tampa Bay's Shane Bieber (1.22).

THE ARSENAL: Gray is currently using a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...continues to use his curveball the most at 22.4 percent...all three strikeouts recorded in his last start on May 29 came from a sweeper...primarily uses his curveball (145 pitches) and changeup (67 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (141 pitches), sinker (173 pitches) and sweeper (145 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

- Owns the 11th-lowest opponent batting average (min. 30 PA) against a cutter and is tied for 10th with Chris Bassitt against a sinker.
- His 26 strikeouts on his sweeper are the third-most in the majors, behind Shohei Ohtani (49) and Justin Lawrence (30).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2023 SEASON: 7-2, 2.77 ERA // CAREER: 22-11, 3.39 ERA)

Right-hander Joe Ryan is slated to start in the finale of the four-game series against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field tomorrow...took his second loss of the season in his last start on May 30 at Houston, a 5-1 Twins defeat at Minute Maid Park...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed five runs on four hits, with three walks and six strikeouts; marked his shortest outing of the season and snapped an eight-game streak of allowing three-or-fewer earned runs...facing Cleveland for the second time this season and seventh time in his career...last faced the Guardians on May 7 at Progressive Field; took the 2-0 Twins loss after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on eight hits, with no walks and four strikeouts.

- Has made seven Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
- Originally selected by Oakland in first round (18th overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Vanderbilt University...led Vandy to its first NCAA College World Series berth in 2011.
- Is 0-2, 2.95 ERA (21.1 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in four career Postseason starts.

THIS IS THE (RIGHT) WAY: Gray has seen more success against right-handed hitters as opposed to left-handed hitters this season...Gray has held righties to a .185 (24-for-130) batting average with 51 strikeouts as opposed to lefties who are batting .258 (24-for-93) with 18 strikeouts...since becoming a Twin, lefties are slashing .220/.268/.321 against him while righties are batting .223/.306/.344.

Ranks seventh among American League pitchers in opponent batting average against righties, tenth in all of baseball...his 48 strikeouts against righties rank eighth in the AL and are 11th most in all of baseball.
