BATS FINISH COLD IN HOTLANTA: The Twins were shut out by the Braves at Truist Park on Wednesday afternoon, losing by a score of 3-0...

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the first of six times in 2023... the Orioles will travel to Target Field for three games next weekend...

BIRD DOGS: Individual notable numbers vs. the Orioles: Max Kepler is hitting .344 (31-for-90) with seven doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, 12 walks, a .417 OBP and a 1.162 OPS in 25 career games against Baltimore...

LEADING MAN: Carlos Correa is leading off tonight for the fourth time in his career... his previous three starts from the leadoff spot came in a three-game stretch for Houston from April 22-24, 2021 vs. Los Angeles-AL...

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Twins have hit .104 (5-for-48) with runners in scoring position through six games on their current roadtrip... other than the 5-for-13 effort on Sunday at Detroit, they have gone 0-for-8 (6/23), 0-for-4 (6/24), 0-for-5 (6/26), 0-for-10 (6/27) and 0-for-8 (6/28)...

ROYCE OF SUMMER: Royce Lewis went 0-for-4 on Wednesday afternoon, snapping his on-base streak at 11 games... regardless of the 0-for-4, he is hitting .333 (14-for-42) with one double, two home runs, five RBI, three walks, a .391 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .891 OPS in his last 12 games.

ED TALK: Edouard Julien has gone 5-for-16 (.313) in five games played on this trip... since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on June 10, Julien is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with six doubles, eight walks, a .393 on-base percentage and an .817 OPS in 16 games.

ICYMI: Triple-A St. Paul infielder Jose Miranda celebrated his 25th birthday yesterday... in his last 19 games for the Saints, Miranda has hit .308 (24-for-78) with six doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, eight walks, a .372 on-base percentage and an .859 OPS...

- Making his 17th start and appearance and ninth road start of 2023...also his 111th career appearance (all starts) in his sixth major league season (Miami - 2018-22). Facing Baltimore for the second time in his career and first since August 4, 2020 with Miami; earned the win in the Marlins' 4-0 shutout at Oriole Park at Camden Yards (5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 7 K). Acquired by the Twins from Miami on January 20, 2023, along with infielder Jose Salas and outfielder Byron Chourio, in exchange for infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez.

LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his ninth quality start of the season but took the loss on June 24 against the Detroit Tigers in a 3-2 Twins' defeat at Comerica Park...went 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits (all singles), with one walk and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...allowed all three runs in the bottom of the second inning on four singles and one walk, with catcher Eric Haase and rightfielder Zach McKinstry each recording RBI hits...after McKinstry's two-run single, he retired 15 of the final 17 batters he faced, allowing just two singles and striking out eight during the span...was relieved by Emilio Pagan to start the bottom of the seventh with the Twins trailing 3-2; Pagan and Jordan Balazovic combined to throw 2.0 scoreless innings, but Minnesota's offense left eight men on base and struck out 13 times in the one-run loss, which evened the three-game series 1-1.

- Recorded a season-high 10 strikeouts for the second time this year, also doing so on April 11 vs. Chicago-AL...was one short of his career high of 11, done twice previously (May 13, 2022 vs. Milwaukee, July 26, 2022 at Cincinnati). Posted a scoreless first inning; has held his opponent scoreless in the first inning in five straight starts and eight of his last 10 starts after doing so only twice in his first six starts of 2023. Through 16 starts this season, López is among the American League leaders in several statistical categories, including strikeouts (120 - 3rd), FIP (3.26 - 7th), innings pitched (96.0 - T-10th) and opponent OPS (.670 - 14th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss in his first career start against the Boston Red Sox on June 19 at Target Field in a 9-3 Twins' defeat...pitched 5.2 innings, allowing five runs (4 earned) on six hits, with three walks, one hit batter and nine strikeouts...walked centerfielder Adam Duvall with the bases loaded in the top of the third inning; marked the fourth time in his career in which he issued a bases-loaded walk, last doing so with Miami on September 4, 2020 at Tampa Bay (Kevin Kiermaier)...allowed a two-run double to leftfielder Jarren Duran in the top of the fourth...was relieved by Jovani Moran in the top of the sixth after yielding two hits and recording two strikeouts; Moran allowed both inherited runners to score on rightfielder Alex Verdugo's bases-loaded triple...Twins were held scoreless in the final four innings, falling in the series opener.

600 CLUB: López struck out rightfielder Zach McKinstry in the first inning of his last start on June 24 at Detroit to become the 19th Venezuelan-born pitcher in American League/National League history to record 600 career strikeouts and the fifth active Venezuelan to reach 600...here is the list of active Venezuelan-born pitchers with at least 600 career strikeouts:

BIRD WATCHING: Facing Baltimore for the second time in his career and first since August 4, 2020 with Miami; earned the win in the Marlins' 4-0 victory at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, pitching 5.0 shutout innings and allowing only two hits, with no walks and seven strikeouts, which tied his then-career high...outfielders Anthony Santander and Austin Hays are the only Orioles who faced López in 2020 and are still on Baltimore's active roster, combining to go 2-for-6 with two singles against him...since his win over Baltimore in 2020, he is 1-5 with a 4.21 ERA (51.1 IP, 24 ER), 13 walks and 60 strikeouts in nine starts against American League East division opponents (TB - 5, TOR - 2, NYY - 1, BOS - 1), with his teams going 1-8 in those nine games.

PABLO ON THE ROAD: Making his ninth road start of 2023 tonight; is 1-3, 2.94 ERA (49.0 IP, 16 ER) with 11 walks and 60 strikeouts in eight previous road starts...has received an average of only 1.84 runs of support on the road this year, the second-lowest road run support average in baseball (DET's Joey Wentz - 1.67)...Twins have lost his last four road starts and are 2-6 when he starts on the road this season...looking for his first road win since defeating Kansas City on March 30 at Kauffman Stadium on Opening Day (5.1 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 8 K)...is 2-2, 5.94 ERA (47.0 IP, 31 ER) with 16 walks and 60 strikeouts in eight home starts this year; Twins have gone 6-2 in those starts.

In 52 career road starts, he is 15-19, 4.25 ERA (275.0 IP, 130 ER) with 74 walks and 281 strikeouts...is 16-17, 3.81 ERA (331.0 IP, 140 ER) with 95 walks and 328 strikeouts in 58 career home starts.

RIGHT ON: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .202 (41-for-203) batting average this season...his 76 strikeouts against righties are the fifth most in the American League this year, trailing only HOU's Framber Valdez (92), TB's Shane Bieber (86), TOR's Kevin Gausman (82) and LAA's Reid Detmers (80)...his .202 opponent batting average vs. righties this season ranks eighth in the AL (min. 10 GS)...left-handed hitters are batting at a .270 (43-for-159) clip against him in 2023...over his career, he has better numbers against right-handed hitters (.654 OPS) than left-handed hitters (.745 OPS).

CUTTING TO THE CHASE: Through 16 starts, López has a career-high 36.2 chase percentage, placing him in the 96th percentile in all of baseball, according to Baseball Savant...his chase rate ranks second on the Twins staff (Joe Ryan - 37.5) and 15th in the majors...also has a career-best 52.5 percent swing rate and 29.9 percent whiff rate in 2023; his whiff rate ranks in the 78th percentile in all of baseball.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Used a five-pitch mix in his first 16 starts this season, according to Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...opposing batters went 0-for-8 with four strikeouts against his curveball in his last start on June 24 at Detroit; marked his highest strikeout total with his curveball in any start in his career...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

Lopez's changeup has accumulated a run value of -.6 this year, tied for the eighth-best run value on a changeup in baseball, according to Baseball Savant.

In his first 16 starts this year, Lopez has an average fastball velocity of 94.8 mph, a 2.1 mph increase from last season and the largest year-to-year jump of his career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP BAILEY OBER (2023: 4-4, 2.97 ERA // CAREER: 9-10, 3.55 ERA)

Bailey Ober is set to start the second game of the three-game series against the Baltimore Orioles at Oriole Park at Camden Yards tomorrow afternoon...recorded his third-consecutive quality start but took a no-decision in his last outing on June 25 at Detroit in the Twins' 6-3 win; pitched 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and eight strikeouts...facing the Orioles for the first time in his career; Baltimore will be the 18th team he has faced in the majors...is 3-4, 4.12 ERA (83.0 IP, 38 ER) with 21 walks and 82 strikeouts in 17 previous starts when facing a new opponent...is 0-3, 4.41 ERA (16.1 IP, 8 ER) in three starts vs. American League East division opponents this season, losing on May 28 vs. Toronto, June 8 at Tampa Bay and June 20 vs. Boston.

CAREER NOTES

- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota. In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as number two starter for Miami. 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched. In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP. Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings and allowing three hits and two runs while striking out seven in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series. Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters. In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59). Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts. Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs. Started 2018 season with Double-A Jacksonville, earning Southern League Midseason All-Star honors before being promoted to Triple-A New Orleans. Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Brayan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017. Spent 2017 season at High-A level in Seattle and Miami organizations. Went 6-1, 1.88 ERA (71.2 IP, 15 ER) in 17 appearances (13 starts) for Low-A Clinton (Seattle) in 2016. Missed 2014 season following Tommy John surgery on November 11, 2013. Made professional debut with Venezuelan Summer League Mariners on May 23, 2013. Originally signed by Seattle as international free agent on July 4, 2012.

REELIN' IN THE STRIKEOUTS: After fanning 10 batters in his last start on June 24 at Detroit, López has recorded 120 strikeouts in his first 16 starts with Minnesota, becoming the 27th pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-present) to strike out at least 120 batters through his first 16 starts with a team...his 120 strikeouts are the most through a pitcher's first 16 games with the Twins in club history (since 1961):

LUCRATIVE IN-VEST-MENT: López spearheaded the Twins' 2023 home run celebration by purchasing a fishing vest from a sporting goods store on April 29 along with a Paw Patrol kids fishing pole...since the "Land of 10,000 Rakes" vest and fishing pole first appeared in the Twins dugout on April 30, the Twins have hit 67 home runs in 54 games, including at least one homer in 39 of those 54...Minnesota ranks fifth in the American League this season with 1.27 home runs per game, trailing only Texas (1.37), New York (1.43), Tampa Bay (1.49) and Los Angeles (1.49).
