THE TWINS: The Twins completed their short four-game homestand with a four-game series split with the Guardians, winning the first two followed by consecutive losses on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon...tonight, the Twins will begin their sixth roadtrip of the season with the first of three at Tropicana Field against the Rays through Thursday...they will continue the trip this weekend with three games at the Rogers Centre against the Blue Jays...the Twins have gone 18-14 at home and 13-15 on the road.

BATS CAN'T BACK ANOTHER JOE GEM: The Twins lost to the Guardians on Sunday afternoon by a score of 2-1...Joe Ryan (7-3) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on two hits in 6.2 innings pitched, facing the minimum through six innings...the offense recorded five hits and out-hit the Guardians 5-3...however, Minnesota struck out 16 times, tying their season-high...Willi Castro provided the only run for the Twins, hitting a solo home run off Enyel De Los Santos in the eighth inning.

BUCK FOR LARNACH: The Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List (retroactive to June 3) with a left rib contusion...Buxton sustained the injury after being hit by a pitch by Cleveland's Tanner Bibee on June 1 at Target Field...he has hit .220 (40-for-182) with nine doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 23 RBI, 26 walks and 31 runs scored in 50 games for the Twins this season...to replace Buxton on the 26-man roster, the Twins have returned outfielder Trevor Larnach from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Larnach, who has missed the Twins' last 13 games with pneumonia, recently played in three games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 1-for-9 with one home run, two RBI, three walks and three runs scored...prior to being placed on the 10-day Injured List, he played in 39 games for the Twins, hitting .215 (28-for-130) with four doubles, two triples, five home runs, 27 RBI, 20 walks and a .316 on-base percentage.

RAY MATTERS: The Twins are playing the Rays for the first time in 2023...after this three-game series, they will host the Rays at Target Field for three games from September 11-13...the Twins went 4-2 against Tampa last season, outscoring the Rays 34-25...the Twins have won four of their last five against the Rays and four of their last 18, dating back to May of 2019.

Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 12-7 against the Rays, going 6-4 at Tropicana Field and 6-3 at Target Field (since 2019). Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (32-for-106) with seven doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and an .866 OPS in 28 career regular season games against the Rays...he has multiple hits in each of his last five games vs. TB, dating back to April 29, 2022. Last season, Correa went 12-for-21 (.571) against the Rays in five games. Jorge Polanco is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with nine doubles, two home runs and 14 RBI in 15 career games at Tropicana Field.

WE'RE NOT SO DIFFERENT, YOU AND I: Twins starters have averaged 5.7 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022...below are Twins starting pitching ranks in the American League:

PLUSES AND MINUSES: The Twins have a run differential of +45 (267-222), fourth best in the American League, trailing Texas' +153 (380-227), Tampa Bay's +125 (359-234) and Houston's +65 (278-213)...they rank second in all of baseball in runs allowed but 15th in runs scored.

EXTRA STRENGTH: The Twins rank fourth in the AL in isolated power at .170 and eighth in all of baseball...additionally, 38.4% of their hits have gone for extra bases, third most in the AL:

KIRILLOFF TURNING IT ON: Alex Kirilloff has reached base safely in 18 of his last 34 plate appearances since May 27, posting an on-base percentage of .559 in that span...since that date, he has nine hits, nine walks and one hit-by-pitch...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Kirilloff has hit .304 (24-for-79) with four doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, 16 walks, a .439 on-base percentage and a .907 OPS in 26 games...among players with at least 90 PA this season, his .439 OBP leads the American League.

WILLI GOING WILD: Willi Castro is hitting .323 (20-for-62) with two doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, 13 runs scored, nine stolen bases and an .897 OPS in his last 17 games. He is hitting .357 (10-for-27) with a 1.121 OPS in his last 10 games vs. right-handed pitching.

DON'T STOP RELIEVIN': Twins relievers have combined to post a .219 opponent batting average, the fourth lowest in baseball, trailing New York-AL (.214), San Diego (.214) and Cleveland (.218)...they have allowed just 162 hits this season, tied with Cleveland for the fewest in baseball...additionally, their .353 opponent slugging percentage is third best in the majors.

TAKE IT ON THE RUN: Twins have stolen 28 bases in 34 attempts this season, for a 82.4 success rate, the fifth best in the AL and eighth best in baseball...since May 15, they have successfully stolen 18 consecutive bases, their last caught stealing being Ryan Jeffers on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL (Barnhart/Wesneski)...since May 10, their 18 stolen bases are fifth most in the AL.

TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALLNER: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner yesterday was named International League Player of the Week for May 29-June 4...in six games for the Saints, Wallner hit .423 (11-for-26) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.483 OPS...he homered in three-straight games against Buffalo from Tuesday-Thursday.

2023 PCF HOME RUN CHALLENGE: Beginning last Saturday night (June 3) through Father's Day on Sunday, June 18, the Twins organization has pledged \$7,500 to the Prostate Cancer Foundation (PCF) for every home run hit by a Twins player during those 12 games, as well as \$1,000 for every strikeout recorded by a Minnesota pitcher, up to \$50,000 (donations counter in the right margin)...this year's efforts continue the Twins' longstanding support of the PCF Home Run Challenge; since 2013 alone, the organization has donated \$881,000 to fund research and advocacy efforts...fans can join in the fight against prostate cancer and pledge their own donation by visiting www.homerunchallenge.org.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third win of the season in the 8-2 Twins victory against the Houston Astros on May 31 at Minute Maid Park, opposite Hunter Brown...pitched a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings, with one walk and five strikeouts...marked his second scoreless start of his career and first since going 5.0 scoreless innings on October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL...tossed 86 pitches; 76.7 percent were strikes, the highest single-start strike percentage of his career...relieved by Jorge López in the eighth, who allowed back-to-back solo home runs to outfielder Jake Meyers and catcher Yainer Diaz to start the inning...López was replaced by Brock Stewart in the eighth after failing to record an out... Stewart combined with José De León to pitch 2.0 scoreless innings to secure the win in the rubber game of the three-game series.

☞ Recorded his fifth quality start of the season, tied with Sonny Gray for the third most on the Twins staff (Joe Ryan – 9, Pablo López – 6).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his first loss of the season, despite recording a quality start, in the 3-1 Twins defeat on May 26 vs. Toronto at Target Field, opposite Kevin Gausman...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits, with no walks and three strikeouts...tossed 100 pitches for the first time in his career...yielded all three runs in the top of the third inning via two home runs; a solo shot from centerfielder Kevin Kiermaier and a two-run home run by shortstop Bo Bichette (Bichette's home run was just the second off Varland with men on base in his career)...relieved by Emilio Pagan in the seventh inning, as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings.

CATCHING SOME RAYS: Making his first career start against the Rays; Tampa Bay will become the ninth different team he has faced since his debut last season...in eight previous starts when facing a new opponent, Varland is 2-3, 3.50 ERA (46.1 IP, 18 ER) with 10 walks and 37 strikeouts...has never faced any current Tampa Bay hitters in his career...tonight marks his fourth career start against an American League East division opponent, having faced the New York Yankees once both in 2022 and 2023 and the Toronto Blue Jays on May 26; went 0-1, 4.15 ERA (17.1 IP, 8 ER) with two walks and 18 strikeouts in those three starts, with the Twins going 1-2.

SMOOTH ROAD: Varland is making back-to-back road starts for the first time since his first two starts of the year on April 14 at New York-AL and May 3 at Chicago-AL...in his four road starts this season, he is 2-0, 3.57 ERA (22.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and 23 strikeouts, with the Twins going 3-1 in those four games...at home this year, he is 1-1, 3.44 ERA (18.1 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and 16 strikeouts...is 3-1, 3.55 ERA (38.0 IP, 15 ER) with eight walks and 38 strikeouts in seven career starts on the road...Tropicana Field will become the seventh ballpark Varland has pitched in since his debut...in six previous starts when pitching in a new ballpark, he is 3-2, 3.67 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER) with seven walks and 27 strikeouts, having won each of his last three starts at new ballparks.

LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES: Through his first seven starts this season, left-handed hitters are batting .240 (12-for-50) with 14 strikeouts against Varland...righties are hitting .248 (27-for-109) with 25 strikeouts...lefties went 0-for-5 vs. Varland in his last start on May 31 at Houston; also recorded all five of his strikeouts against right-handed hitters in the outing...in his career, righties are slashing .253/.299/.482 with 10 home runs and 37 strikeouts against Varland, while left-handed hitters are slashing .250/.289/.413 with three home runs and 23 strikeouts.

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Varland has used a four-pitch mix in his first seven starts this season, including a four-seam fastball, cutter, slider and changeup, according to Baseball Savant...Houston batters hit just .118 (2-for-17) combined against his cutter, slider and changeup in his last start on May 31...also recorded strikeouts with three of his four pitch types in his last outing (four-seam fastball - 2, cutter - 2, slider - 1)...below is a look at his 2023 repertoire:

☞ Has averaged 10.7 inches of horizontal movement on his slider this season, the second-most slider horizontal movement on the Twins staff in 2023, according to Baseball Savant (Bailey Ober - 10.8).

GAINING GROUND: In his last start on May 31 at Houston, Varland recorded a 73.7 groundball percentage, inducing 14 groundballs according to Baseball Savant...marked the highest single-game groundball percentage of his career (previous highest was 53.8 percent on October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL)...his 45.8 groundball percentage this season ranks 16th highest in the American League (min. 7 GS) and second in the Twins' rotation, trailing Sonny Gray (48.1%)...Varland owns a 42.9 percent groundball percentage in his career.

WITH THE SAINTS: In his three starts with Triple-A St. Paul this season, Varland went 2-0, 4.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 7 ER) with four walks and 25 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 27, he earned the win in a 5-1 St. Paul victory at Rochester...pitched 5.1 innings, allowed one run on four hits, walked one batter and fanned eight...is 20-10, 2.70 ERA (253.0 IP, 76 ER) with 80 walks and 323 strikeouts in 50 career minor league appearances (45 starts).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 3-3, 4.54 ERA // CAREER: 31-34, 4.01 ERA)

Pablo López is set to start the second game of the three-game series against the Tampa Bay Rays at Tropicana Field tomorrow night...took a no-decision in his last start on June 1 vs. Cleveland; went 5.2 innings, allowing a season-high-tying six runs and eight hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...left with Minnesota trailing 6-3, but the Twins came back to win 7-6...facing the Rays for the sixth time in his career, going 1-3, 3.72 ERA (29.0 IP, 12 ER) with five walks and 29 strikeouts in five previous starts vs. Tampa Bay, all with Miami...last faced the Rays on May 24, 2022, taking the loss in a 4-0 Marlins defeat at Tropicana Field (7.0 IP, 4 R/ER, 9 H, 0 BB, 8 K)...is 1-2, 5.29 ERA (17.0 IP, 10 ER) with three walks and 20 strikeouts in three career starts at the Trop.

CAREER NOTES

- Made his major league debut in game one of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL, becoming the 10th player to make his major league debut for the Twins in 2022 (5th pitcher).
- Earned first major league win October 5, 2022 at Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 5 K).
- Had allowed three-or-fewer earned runs in 18-straight minor league starts from May 18-August 31, 2022, going 4-4, 2.85 ERA (94.2 IP, 30 ER) with 31 walks and 111 strikeouts in that span...his teams went 12-6.
- Went 7-4, 3.34 ERA (105.0 IP, 39 ER) with 39 walks and 119 strikeouts in 20 games (19 starts) for Wichita in 2022 -- was promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on August 8.
- Earned the win in his first career Triple-A start/appearance on August 12, 2022 vs. Columbus (5.1 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K).
- Led all Twins minor leaguers in strikeouts (146) and innings pitched (126.1), tied for first in games started (23) and was second in ERA (3.06), second in winning percentage (.615), fourth in opponent batting average (.242) and WHIP (1.26), and tied for fifth in wins (8) in 2022.
- Named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022, one of two pitchers to ever win the award twice, joining José Berrios (2014-15).
- One of 32 Minnesota natives to play for the Twins and one of 16 to pitch...was one of three Minnesota natives on the Twins roster at one point in 2022 (also, Caleb Thielbar and Matt Wallner).
- Named starting pitcher on 2021 Twins MiLB.com organizational All-Star team.
