LAST START: Did not factor into the decision, despite recording a quality start, in a 1-0 Twins victory against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field on June 2...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed four hits, no walks and three strikeouts, opposite Aaron Civale...pitched 3.2 hitless innings until first baseman Josh Naylor singled in the fourth inning...marked his second-lowest single-game strikeout total this season (2 K vs. San Francisco on May 22)...joined Detroit's Eduardo Rodríguez as the only pitchers to record two starts against Cleveland this year with 6.0-or-more scoreless innings...relieved by Jovani Moran in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins scored their lone run on a Jorge Polanco RBI double in the seventh inning...marked the fourth shutout victory for the Twins this season (also, back-to-back shutouts on March 30 and April 1 at Kansas City, and May 5 at Cleveland).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his second loss of the season in a 3-0 Twins defeat in the finale of the three-game series against the Toronto Blue Jays at Target Field on May 28; paired with his start on May 22 vs. San Francisco, marked the first time in his career he had lost consecutive starts...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...tied his previous start on May 22 vs. San Francisco for his shortest outing of the year...his seven strikeouts marked a season high and the most strikeouts he has recorded since he struck out a career-high 10 batters on September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL...allowed both runs in the second inning on a two-RBI single to catcher Alejandro Kirk...relieved by Griffin Jax in the sixth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 innings, allowing one run (an RBI single by Bo Bichette off José De León in the eighth inning)...the Twins were shut out at Target Field for the first time this season and the fourth time overall (also, April 4 at Miami, April 16 at New York-AL and May 7 at Cleveland).

OBER VS. TAMPA BAY: Facing the Rays for the first time in his career...making his sixth career start against an American League East opponent, second this season...is 1-3, 2.49 ERA (25.1 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 26 strikeouts in his five previous career starts vs. an AL East opponent...Tampa Bay will be the 16th team he has faced since his major league debut on May 18, 2021...in 15 career starts when facing a new opponent for the first time, Ober is 2-3, 4.14 ERA (71.2 IP, 33 ER) with 18 walks and 68 strikeouts...has never faced an current Rays batter.

ROAD WORK AHEAD: Ober is making his first road start since May 16, third this season and 19th of his career...in his two previous road starts this season, Ober is 2-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts...is 3-5, 3.32 ERA (89.1 IP, 33 ER) with 15 walks and 82 strikeouts in 18 career road starts...Twins have gone 10-8 in his road starts.

- ☞ Pitching at Tropicana Field for the first time in his career...the Trop will be 12th ballpark he has pitched in since his debut...in 11 career starts when pitching in a new ballpark for the first time, Ober is 2-2, 4.59 ERA (45.1 IP, 23 ER) with nine walks and 53 strikeouts.

EQUAL OPPORTUNIST: Right-handed hitters are batting .216 (16-for-74) with 20 strikeouts and two walks against Ober after eight starts this season...left-handed hitters are hitting .196 (18-for-92) also with 20 strikeouts and nine walks...in his career, right-handed hitters are batting .222/.243/.408 with 109 strikeouts against Ober...lefties are hitting .255/.320/.416 with 78 off him.

- ☞ Owns the 10th-lowest batting average against lefties in the American League (min. 45.0 IP).

ARSENAL: Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his eight starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...two out of the three strikeouts he recorded in his last start came from sliders...mostly uses his slider (134 pitches) against righties while relying on his changeup (137 pitches) and curveball (51 pitches) against lefties...here's a look at his repertoire:

- ☞ Owns the seventh-lowest opponent batting average against a curveball in the American League (min. 500 pitches)...also owns the 13th-best opponent batting average against a changeup (min. 40 PA).

CHASE U: According to Baseball Savant, Ober owns a 34.5 chase percentage this season, ranking in the 94th percentile in baseball...just passes his chase percentage last year at 34.4 for the highest rate of his career...ranks third on the Twin's pitching staff, trailing Joe Ryan (36.8) and Pablo López (35.2).

GOOD MORNING STARSHINE: Ober is making his fifth day start of the season...is 1-1, 2.82 ERA (22.1 IP, 7 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts in his four previous day starts this season...is 3-3, 3.78 ERA (78.2 IP, 33 ER) with 20 walks and 71 strikeouts in 16 career day starts...tied with Sonny Gray for the second-most day starts on the Twins staff since 2021, trailing Joe Ryan (18).

ACROSS THE RIVER: In his four starts with Triple-A St. Paul this season, Ober went 2-1, 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 18, earned the win in 6-0 St. Paul victory vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one batter and fanned six.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.

TURF'S UP: Making his second career start on artificial turf...last pitched in a ballpark with turf on September 18, 2021 against Toronto at Rogers Centre...took the loss after pitching 4.0 innings and allowing four runs on four hits (2 HR), with two walks and three strikeouts.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 4-1, 2.15 ERA // CAREER: 94-78, 3.50 ERA)

Right-hander Sonny Gray is set to pitch in the opener of the three-game series against the Toronto Blue Jays tomorrow night at Rogers Centre...took his first loss of the season in last start on June 3 against Cleveland in a 4-2 Twins defeat at Target Field; pitched 6.2 innings and allowed three runs on 10 hits (1 home run - his first permitted all year), with no walks and two strikeouts...marked the fourth time in his career allowing 10-or-more hits (10 on August 6, 2014 vs. Tampa Bay, 11 on April 17, 2015 at Kansas City and May 3, 2016 vs. Seattle)...last faced Toronto on August 4, 2022 at Target Field; did not factor into the 9-3 Twins loss after pitching 5.0 scoreless innings and allowing one hit, issuing five walks and striking out five batters...looking for his first win against Toronto since September 23, 2017 when he earned the 5-1 New York-AL win (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 4 K).
