THE TWINS: Have gone 0-2 through two games on their current six-game roadtrip after
consecutive losses to the Rays the last two nightsthis afternoon, they will play the three-
game series finale at Tropicana Field before flying to Canada to begin a three-game weekend series at the Rogers Centre in Toronto against the Blue Jaysthe Twins have gone 18-14 at

**Twins have lost a season-long four-straight games, their longest since October 1-4, 2022 (also 4)...they are looking to avoid losing their lifth-straight, which would mark their longest losing streak since dropping five-straight from September 19-23, 2022...the club's last victory came on Friday night at Target Field, a 1-0 win over the Guardians.

**Elast night's loss moved the Twins to their low-water mark of 31-31 and an even .500 for the first time this season...last time they had dipped below .500 was at the end of the 2022 season, when they were 78-84 (.481).

BATS OFF ON PABLO DAY: The Twins lost to the Rays last night at Tropicana Field by a score of 2-1, losing the series and making them 8-10-2 in series play (2-7-1 on the road). the loss made them 1-5-1 in series play since May 15...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run (Paredes 2nd inning HR) on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched...lhoan Duran (1-2) was issued the loss, allowing a walk-off home run to Randy Arozarena on his second pitch in the bottom of the ninth inning...the offense recorded just three hits and walked four times...Royce Lewis drove in the Twins' only run, tying the game with a single in the top of the ninth inning.

X-RAYS: The Twins are playing the Rays for the third of six times in 2023...the next series between these two will come at Target Field for three games from September 11-13...the Twins have won four of their last seven against the Rays and 12 of their last 20, dating back to May of 2019.

◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .289 (33-for-114) with eight doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and an 833 OPS in 30 career regular season games against the Rays...he has hit safely in seven of his last eight against Tampa, batting .438 (14-for-32) with a 1.158 OPS in that span.

◆ Jorge Polanco is hitting .299 (20-for-67) with nine doubles, two home runs and 14 RBI in 17 career games at Tropicana Field...he has 12 RBI in his last 11 games in this building.

STARTING OFF: Twins starters have averaged 5.7 innings-per-outing, up from 4.8 in 2022... they have also struck out 363 hitters and are on-pace to fan 964 batters, which would shatter the ally record of 870 days in 1067, below are Twins starting sitching reads in the All

DON'T TAKE OFFENSE: The Twins have scored five runs in their last five games...in those five games, they are hitting 170 (26-for-153) with eight doubles, two home runs (Polanco on Saturday and Castro on Sunday), 13 walks and a .510 OPS.

LEAVE THE BROOMS ALONE: Twins are looking to avoid being swept today for the first time this season...last time they were swept was in three games at Kansas City from September 20-22, 2022...last time they were swept by the Rays was in three games from April 20-22, 2018 at Tropicana Field...Minnesota was swept seven times in 2022.

**Minnesota has faced a potential sweep three times this season, salvaging the series finale each time...the previous three were April 21-23 vs. Washington, May 2-4 at Chicago-AL and May 22-24 vs. San Francisco.

ROYCE ROLLS ON THE ROAD: Royce Lewis is hitting .350 (7-for-20) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI, five runs scored, an .800 slugging percentage and a 1.181 OPS in five career road games at the major league level, hitting safely in all five.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Twins relievers have combined to post a .218 opponent batting average the fourth lowest in baseball, trailing New York-AL (.212), San Diego (.215) and Cleveland (.218)...they have allowed just 164 hits this season, the fewest in baseball.

THIEVERY CORPORATION: Twins have stolen 30 bases in 36 attempts this season, for a 83.3 success rate, tied for third best in the AL and tied for fifth best in baseball...since May 15, they have successfully stolen 20 consecutive bases, their last caught stealing being Ryan Jeffers on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL (Barnhart/Wesneski)...since May 10, their 20 stolen bases are fourth most in the AL.

ANALYST ANALYSIS: Tampa Bay related notes on Bally Sports North broadcasters Justin

Morneau and Trevor Plouffe:

Morneau played in 58 career games against Tampa Bay, hitting .308 (68-for-221) with 15 doubles, two triples, 12 home runs, 40 RBI and a .908 OPS against them...he homered in his first game at Tropicana Field on May 25, 2004, a solo shot off Victor Zambrano (Rocco Baldelli went 2-for-4 in the game for Tampa)...additionally, Morneau's second career four-hit game was on May 8, 2005 at the Trop, falling a homer short of the cycle.

Plouffe played his first career major league road game at Tropicana Field on August 3, 2010, going 0-for-3 (current Rays analyst Denard Span went 2-for-5 that day for the Twins)...Plouffe hit one career home run off Rays pitching in 101 plate appearances, a two-run shot off Alex Cobb on July 18, 2014 at Target Field.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2013, Joe Mauer hit his 100th career home run during a 4-3 victory at Washington, a fifth-inning solo shot off Gio González...21 players in Twins history (since 1961) have hit 100 home runs as a Twin.

2023 PCF HOME RUN CHALLENGE: From June 3 through Father's Day on Sunday, June 18, the Twins organization has pledged \$7,500 to the Prostate Cancer Foundation (PCF) for every home run hit by a Twins player during those 12 games, as well as \$1,000 for every strikeout recorded by a Minnesota pitcher, up to \$50,000 (donations counter in the right margin)...this year's efforts continue the Twins' longstanding support of the PCF Home Run Challenge; since 2013 alone, the organization has donated \$881,000 to fund research and advocacy efforts...fans can join in the fight against prostate cancer and pledge their own donation by visiting www.homerunchallenge.org.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision, despite recording a quality start, in a 1-0 Twins victory against the Cleveland Guardians at Target Field on June 2...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed four hits, no walks and three strikeouts, opposite Aaron Civale...pitched 3.2 hitless innings until first baseman Josh Naylor singled in the fourth inning...marked his second-lowest single-game strikeout total this season (2 K vs. San Francisco on May 22)...joined Detroit's Eduardo Rodriguez as the only pitchers to record two starts against Cleveland this year with 6.0-or-more scoreless innings...relieved by Jovani Moran in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins scored their lone run on a Jorge Polanco RBI double in the seventh inning...marked the fourth shutout victory for the Twins this season (also, back-to-back shutouts on March 30 and April 1 at Kansas City, and May 5 at Cleveland).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his second loss of the season in a 3-0 Twins defeat in the finale of the three-game series against the Toronto Blue Jays at Target Field on May 28; paired with his start on May 22 vs. San Francisco, marked the first time in his career he had lost consecutive starts... pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...tied his previous start on May 22 vs. San Francisco for his shortest outing of the year...his seven strikeouts marked a season high and the most strikeouts he has recorded since he struck out a career-high 10 batters on September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL...allowed both runs in the second inning on a two-RBI single to catcher Alejandro Kirk...relieved by Griffin Jax in the sixth inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 innings, allowing one run (an RBI single by Bo Bichette off José De León in the eighth inning)...the Twins were shut out at Target Field for the first time this season and the fourth time overall (also, April 4 at Miami, April 16 at New York-AL and May 7 at Cleveland).

OBER VS. TAMPA BAY: Facing the Rays for the first time in his career...making his sixth career start against an American League East opponent, second this season...is 1-3, 2.49 ERA (25.1 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 26 strikeouts in his five previous career starts vs. an AL East opponent... Tampa Bay will be the 16th team he has faced since his major league debut on May 18, 2021... in 15 career starts when facing a new opponent for the first time, Ober is 2-3, 4.14 ERA (71.2 IP, 33 ER) with 18 walks and 68 strikeouts...has never faced an current Rays batters.

ROAD WORK AHEAD: Ober is making his first road start since May 16, third this season and 19th of his career...in his two previous road starts this season, Ober is 2-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and 12 strikeouts...is 3-5, 3.32 ERA (89.1 IP, 33 ER) with 15 walks and 82 strikeouts in 18 career road starts...Twins have gone 10-8 in his road starts.

© Pitching at Tropicana Field for the first time in his career...the Trop will be 12th ballpark he has pitched in since his debut...in 11 career starts when pitching in a new ballpark for the first time, Ober is 2-2, 4.59 ERA (45.1 IP, 23 ER) with nine walks and 53 strikeouts.

EQUAL OPPORTUNIST: Right-handed hitters are batting .216 (16-for-74) with 20 strikeouts and two walks against Ober after eight starts this season...left-handed hitters are hitting .196 (18-for-92) also with 20 strikeouts and nine walks...in his career, right-handed hitters are batting .222/.243/.408 with 109 strikeouts against Ober...lefties are hitting ..255/.320/.416 with 78 off him.

© Owns the 10th-lowest batting average against lefties in the American League (min. 45.0 IP).

ARSENAL: Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his eight starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...two out of the three strikeouts he recorded in his last start came from sliders...mostly uses his slider (134 pitches) against righties while relying on his changeup (137 pitches) and gruydhall (51 pitches) against lofties, hore's a look at his reportain.

GOOD MORNING STARSHINE: Ober is making his fifth day start of the season...is 1-1, 2.82 ERA (22.1 IP, 7 ER) with six walks and 23 strikeouts in his four previous day starts this season...is 3-3, 3.78 ERA (78.2 IP, 33 ER) with 20 walks and 71 strikeouts in 16 career day starts...tied with Sonny Gray for the second-most day starts on the Twins staff since 2021, trailing Joe Ryan (18).

ACROSS THE RIVER: In his four starts with Triple-A St. Paul this season, Ober went 2-1, 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER) with six walks and 22 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on April 18, earned the win in 6-0 St. Paul victory vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, walked one batter and fanned six.
