THE TWINS: Have gone 3-4 through seven games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Detroit last weekend, 0-3 in Atlanta earlier this week, followed by a victory in Baltimore last night...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the second of three at Baltimore through tomorrow...after tomorrow afternoon's series/roadtrip finale, the Twins will travel back home to finish the pre-ASG portion of their schedule with a six-game, seven-day homestand, which consists of three games against the Royals (July 3-5) and three games against the Orioles (July 7-9)...the Twins have gone 23-19 at home and 18-23 on the road.

YES, THAT RIGHT THERE. MORE OF THAT: The Twins beat the Orioles last night in Baltimore by a score of 8-1, snapping their three-game losing streak...it marked their largest margin of victory since a 16-3 win on May 14 vs. Chicago-NL...Pablo López (4-5) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits, six going for extra-bases...Byron Buxton led the club with a 2-for-4 night, including a three-run jimmy jack in the top of the fourth inning...Royce Lewis had three hits for the third time in his last nine games...Joey Gallo (14) and Max Kepler (11) each homered...Minnesota finished 3-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the second of six times in 2023...the Orioles will travel to Target Field for three games next weekend...Twins vs. Baltimore since 2017 in box to the bottom right.

- Since 2019, the Twins have hit 41 home runs against Baltimore for an average of 2.1 home runs-per-game (20 games)...2.1 HR/G leads all AL teams vs. the Orioles in that span.
The Twins are 37-17 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.
Max Kepler is hitting .347 (33-for-95) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 24 RBI, 12 walks, a .417 OBP and a 1.175 OPS in 26 career games against Baltimore...he is hitting .342 (13-for-38) with four doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, five walks, a .419 on-base percentage and a 1.103 OPS in 10 career games at Camden Yards.
Byron Buxton has hit safely in eight-straight games at Oriole Park, hitting .353 (12-for-34) with six doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.095 OPS in that span.
Carlos Correa is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with five doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.081 OPS in his last nine games at Baltimore.
Michael A. Taylor is hitting .306 (33-for-108) with four doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .367 on-base percentage and a .793 OPS in 35 career games against Baltimore.
Christian Vázquez is hitting .293 (39-for-133) with nine doubles in 39 career games at Camden Yards...the 39 hits are his most in any opposing ballpark.

MAXING OUT: Max Kepler has hit four home runs in his last 10 games...in those 10, he has posted a .690 slugging percentage with a 1.033 OPS...last night's home run was the 140th of his career, one short of tying Michael Cuddyer for 13th on the Twins all-time list (since 1961):

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 12th series victory this season...they are 11-12-3 in series play in 2023, going 7-4-2 at home and 4-8-1 on the road.

- The Twins have gone 7-1-2 in their last 10 series vs. Baltimore, dating back to May of 2017...they are 3-1-1 at Camden Yards in that span.
Twins have won three of their last five road series (2-1 at HOU from 5/29-31, 0-3 at TB from 6/6-8, 2-1 at TOR from 6/9-11, 2-1 at DET from 6/23-25 & 0-3 at ATL from 6/26-28).

ROYCE RULES: Royce Lewis is hitting .421 (16-for-38) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, one walk, a .450 on-base percentage, a .605 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS in his last 10 games.

- In 12 road games for the Twins this season, Lewis is hitting .408 (20-for-49) with a .982 OPS...in his last eight road games, he has recorded at least three hits four times (4 on 6/9 at TOR, 3 on 6/11 at TOR, 3 on 6/25 at DET & 3 on 6/30 at BAL).
Among all AL rookies with a minimum of 75 at-bats, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.333), runs created-per-27 (8.02) and OPS+ (134.7), second in OPS (.845) and wOBA (.368), and fourth in slugging (.484) and on-base percentage (.361).

IF IT WORKS...: After going 2-for-4 with a double and two runs scored last night, Carlos Correa is leading off today for the second-straight game and fifth time in his career...prior to last night, he made three starts from the leadoff spot came during a three-game stretch for Houston from April 22-24, 2021 vs. Los Angeles-AL...in four career games from that spot in the batting order, he is now 7-for-19 (.368) with five doubles, one home run, four RBI and seven runs scored

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have homered 107 times this season, fifth most in the AL and eighth most in baseball...Twins have gone 33-25 when homering at least once, 23-8 when homering at least twice and 11-2 when homering three times.

TWINS ML MONTHLYS: Triple-A St. Paul catcher/first baseman Chris Williams and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Cory Lewis have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for June.

- Williams, 26, played in 20 games for the Saints, hitting .352 (25-for-71) with one double, 10 home runs, 29 RBI, 17 walks, a .478 on-base percentage, a .789 slugging percentage and a 1.267 OPS...the Garden Grove, California native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft from Clemson University.
Lewis, 22, started four games between the Kernels and Low-A Fort Myers, combining to go 3-1, 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 1 ER) with seven walks, 21 strikeouts, a .146 opponent batting average and a .424 opponents OPS...the Fountain Valley, California native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from the University of California, Santa Barbara.

PROUD AS A PEACOCK: Tomorrow afternoon's game will be on Peacock, the first time ever for the Twins.

- ☞ Facing the Orioles for the first time in his career...is 3-4, 4.12 ERA (83.0 IP, 38 ER) with 21 walks and 82 strikeouts in 17 career starts when facing new opponents.
- ☞ Began the season with Triple-A St. Paul and was recalled when Kenta Maeda landed on the Injured List on April 29...since being inserted into the rotation, the Twins have gone 7-5 in his 12 starts.
- ☞ Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start on June 25 against Detroit at Comerica Park, a 6-3 Twins' victory...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits, issued one walk and struck out a season-high eight batters in his seventh quality start of the season...pitched 1-2-3 first and second innings before allowing a single and a double to start the third inning; then yielded a two-run double to Zach McKinstry and a go-ahead RBI single to Kerry Carpenter...retired nine of the final 11 batters he faced after the RBI single, including striking out the side in the fifth inning...relieved by Jordan Balazovic in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit and six strikeouts...Royce Lewis scored the tying run in the seventh inning on a throwing error by Chasen Shreve...the Twins entered extra innings for the 11th time this season; Minnesota scored three runs on three singles by Lewis, Willi Castro and Christian Vazquez to improve to 8-3 in extra innings.

- ☞ Among American League pitchers with at least 11 games started in 2023, Ober ranks eighth in ERA (2.97), sixth in WHIP (1.02), seventh in walks-per-9.0 innings (1.94), 11th in opponent batting average (.219) and 12th in walks-per-9.0 innings (4.40).

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Took the loss despite recording a quality start on June 20 vs. Boston at Target Field in a 10-4 Twins' defeat...went 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on a season-high eight hits (2 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts...pitched opposite Kutter Crawford, who earned the win...allowed solo homers to centerfielder Adam Duvall and second baseman Christian Arroyo in the top of the fourth inning; marked the second time this season he allowed multiple homers in an inning (also, June 14 vs. Milwaukee - Brian Anderson and Luis Urias in the second inning)...allowed an RBI single to catcher Connor Wong in the top of the sixth inning...was relieved by Brent Headrick to start the top of the seventh with Minnesota trailing 3-0; Twins' bullpen allowed seven runs as Minnesota fell in the second game of the four-game series.

- ☞ Allowed multiple homers for the third time this year (also, 2 on May 11 vs. San Diego and 2 on June 14 vs. Milwaukee)...six of his eight home runs allowed this season have been solo homers, including all six in the three starts in which he has allowed multiple homers.

**OBER ORNITHOLOGY:** Facing the Orioles for the first time in his career...Baltimore will be the 18th team Ober has faced since his major league debut on May 18, 2021...in 17 career starts when facing a new opponent, Ober is 3-4, 4.12 ERA (83.0 IP, 38 ER) with 21 walks and 82 strikeouts...has only faced Adam Frazier and Ryan O'Hearn in previous starts...Frazier went 1-for-3 with an RBI single in Ober's first start of 2022 vs. Seattle...O'Hearn also went 1-for-3 with two strikeouts on May 27, 2022 as a member of the Kansas City Royals.

**WINDS IN THE EAST:** In three starts against American League East opponents this season (TOR, TB and BOS), Ober is 0-3 with a 4.41 ERA (16.1 IP, 8 ER), three walks, 18 strikeouts and a .254 (16-for-63) opponent batting average...Twins have lost all three starts, including a 3-0 shutout loss on May 28 vs. Toronto...in seven career starts against the AL East, he is 1-5, 3.19 ERA (36.2 IP, 13 ER) with seven walks and 37 strikeouts; Twins have gone 2-5 in those starts.

- ☞ Has not earned a win against an AL East opponent since September 24, 2021 vs. Toronto when he pitched 5.1 innings and allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts...allowed his only run on a home run by Marcus Semien.
- ☞ Owns the 15th-lowest ERA against the AL East since 2021 (min. 7 GS).

**THE ROAD LESS TRAVELED:** Ober is making his fifth road start of the season today...is 2-1, 2.59 ERA (24.1 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 27 strikeouts in four road starts this season; earned road victories on May 5 at Cleveland and May 16 at Los Angeles-NL, took the loss on June 8 at Tampa Bay and did not factor into the decision his last start at Detroit on June 25...his 2.59 ERA on the road is the eighth-lowest road ERA in the American League (min. 4 GS)...is 2-3, 3.18 ERA (45.1 IP, 16 ER) with 10 walks and 39 strikeouts in eight home starts in 2023.

- ☞ In 20 career road starts, Ober has gone 3-6 with a 3.49 ERA (100.2 IP, 39 ER), 18 walks and 97 strikeouts...is 6-4 with a 3.61 ERA (117.1 IP, 47 ER), 27 walks and 116 strikeouts in 23 career starts at Target Field.

**LEFT LANE:** Left-handed hitters are batting .208 (27-for-130) with 29 strikeouts and 11 walks against Ober after 12 starts this season...right-handed hitters are hitting .230 (29-for-126) with 37 strikeouts and four walks...righties went just 2-for-12 with one double and seven strikeouts against him in his last start on June 25 at Detroit...in his career, left-handed hitters are batting .253/.316/.409 with 87 strikeouts against Ober...righties are hitting .225/.248/.426 with 126 strikeouts off him.

- ☞ Owns the 13th-lowest opponent batting average against left-handed hitters among American League pitchers with at least 12 starts this season...also has the fifth-lowest slugging percentage (.323) and has the seventh-lowest OPS (.598) against lefties this year.

**ARSENAL:** Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his 12 starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...mostly uses his slider against righties while relying on his changeup and curveball against lefties...recorded five of his eight strikeouts with his four-seam fastball in his last start on June 25 at Detroit...here's a look at his repertoire:

- ☞ His .181 opponent batting average against his changeup is the second lowest on the Twins (Jovan Moran - .135) and the 13th lowest in baseball (min. 50 plate appearances)...his .143 opponent batting average on his curveball is the second lowest on the Twins (Johan Duran - .121) and the 19th lowest in baseball (min. 20 plate appearances).
- ☞ His .201 opponent batting average across all of his breaking pitches (changeup, slider and curveball) is tied for 11th lowest in the American League (min. 150 plate appearances).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 4-2, 2.67 ERA // CAREER: 94-79, 3.51 ERA)

Sonny Gray is set to start the three-game series finale against the Baltimore Orioles tomorrow at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...recorded a quality start but took the loss in his last outing on June 26 at Atlanta in a 4-1 Twins' defeat; pitched 6.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts...is 0-2, 3.93 ERA (52.2 IP, 23 ER) in his last 10 games; tied for his third-longest span without a win in his career...facing the Orioles for the 13th time in his career; is 6-5, 4.60 ERA (62.2 IP, 32 ER) with 23 walks and 65 strikeouts in 12 starts vs. Baltimore...last faced the Orioles on July 2, 2022 at Target Field, taking a no-decision in a 4-3 Minnesota win; went 5.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR), with three walks and five strikeouts.

- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022.
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
