LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss on July 9 vs. Baltimore in the Twins' 15-2 defeat at Target Field, going 4.1 innings and allowing five runs on five hits (2 HR), with two walks and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...pitched opposite former Twin Kyle Gibson, who earned the win and struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters...struck out the side in the first inning before allowing a solo home run to leftfielder Austin Hays to start the top of the second...recorded 10 of his first 11 outs via the strikeout...allowed four of the first five batters he faced in the top of the fifth to reach, surrendering a two-run homer to Ramón Urías and issuing back-to-back walks before he was relieved by Jovani Moran, who allowed both inherited runners to score...Twins bullpen allowed 10 runs on 12 hits as Minnesota was swept by the Orioles to end the first half.

TWO STARTS AGO: Recorded his team-leading 12th quality start but did not factor into the decision on July 3 vs. Kansas City in the Twins' 8-4 win at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and nine strikeouts, one short of his season high (done 4 times)... allowed a leadoff home run in his second-straight start, as third baseman Maikel Garcia took him deep to start the game...allowed an RBI single to first baseman Nick Pratto in the third inning, then retired 10 of the final 13 batters he faced, striking out the side in the fourth and sixth innings...was relieved by Jovani Moran to start the seventh inning with Minnesota leading 3-2...Brent Headrick blew a save opportunity by allowing a solo homer to Pratto in the top of the eighth, but the Twins' offense scored five runs in the bottom of the eighth to win the series opener. Allowed a leadoff homer in back-to-back starts, after Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. hit a leadoff homer in consecutive starts since Kyle Gibson from July 22-28, 2016.
