THE ARSENAL: In eight starts this season, Maeda has used a five-pitch mix, throwing his slider and split finger the most; he utilizes the pair a combined 67.0 percent of the time...favors his split finger (121/191-63.3\%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (147/207-71.0\%) and sinker (33/33 $-100 \%$ ) against righties...recorded three strikeouts each with his slider and split finger in his last outing on July 14 at Oakland...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

## CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow. - Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on I-MLB Second Team
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers. - His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
