THE TWINS: Have gone 4-4 through eight games on their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip, going 2-1 in Detroit last weekend, 0-3 in Atlanta earlier this week, followed by consecutive wins in Baltimore...today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale at Camden Yards...after today's game, the Twins will travel back home to finish the pre-ASG portion of their schedule with a six-game, seven-day homestand, which consists of three games against the Royals from Monday-Wednesday, an off day on Thursday, then three games against the Orioles next weekend...the Twins have gone 23-19 at home and 19-23 on the road.

BAILEY OBER > BALTIMORE ORIOLES: The Twins beat the Orioles yesterday in Baltimore by a score of 1-0, improving to 8-1-2 in their last 11 series vs. the 0's....t marked the Twins' second 1-0 victory this season, the other coming on June 2 vs. Cleveland...it was the first time the Twins won a 1-0 ballgame in Baltimore since Game 2 of a doubleheader at Memorial Stadium on October 2, 1966... Bailey Ober (5-4) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts...Griffin Jax earned his 11th hold and Jhoan Duran earned his 12th save (14th chance)...the offense scored their only run on a solo home run by Joey Gallo in the fourth inning...the Twins' previous 1-0 win with the only difference being a home run was on June 23, 2022 vs. Cleveland, when Nick Gordon homered for Minnesota.

Michael A. Taylor was caught stealing in the seventh inning, snapping the Twins' club record of 29-consecutive successful stolen bases...it was their first caught stealing since May 13 vs. Chicago-NL.

ROYCE OUT, JOSE IN: The Twins have placed infielder Royce Lewis on the 10-day Injured List with a left oblique strain...in his last 12 games, Lewis hit .381 (16-for-42) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, a. 422 on-base percentage, a. 548 slugging percentage and a. 970 OPS...to replace Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled infielder Jose Miranda from Triple-A St. Paul...Miranda began the season with Minnesota and hit .220 (29-for-132) with four doubles, three home runs. 13 RBI, 12 runs scored and nine walks in 35 games before being optioned to St. Paul on May 10...since joining the Saints, he has played in 39 games, hitting .255 (41-for-161) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, 23 RBI and 24 runs scored... in his last 20 games at St. Paul, the 25-year-old has hit .305 (25-for-82) with an .849 OPS.

© Miranda made his MLB debut in Oriole Park at Camden Yards on May 2, 2022 but went 0-for 4...he recorded his first major league hit the next day with a double off Bruce Zimmermann.

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the third of six times in 2023...the Orioles will travel to Target Field for three games next weekend...Twins vs. Baltimore since 2017 in box to the bottom right.

◆ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 42 home runs against Baltimore for an average of 2.0 home runs-per-game (21 games)...2.0 HR/G leads all AL teams vs. the Orioles in that span.

◆ The Twins are 38-17 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

◆ Michael A. Taylor is hitting .300 (33-for-110) with four doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, 11 walks, a .366 on-base percentage and a .784 OPS in 36 career games against the 0's.

◆ Byron Buxton has hit safely in nine-straight games at Oriole Park, hitting .342 (13-for-38) with six doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.029 OPS in his last 10 games at Camden Yards.

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are seeking their third sweep of the season today...their previous two sweeps were March 30-April 2 at Kansas City (3 games) and June 13-14 vs. Milwaukee (2 games)...last season, they swept opponents eight times, all in three games...Minnesota's last sweep of the Orioles came in three games at Target Field from May 24-25, 2021...their last sweep in Baltimore came in three games April 20-21, 2019 (DH on the 20th).

The Since 2017, the Twins have swept the Orioles five times in 10 chances...the only teams they have swept more in that time frame are the Royals (9 times), the Tigers (8 times) and the White Sox (6 times).

◆ The Twins have the eighth-fewest at-bats in baseball vs. left-handed pitching at 680... also the fifth-fewest hits (147).

◆ Twins are slashing .216/.287/.372 with 23 homers vs. lefties, compared to .237/.315/.409 with 85 homers vs. righties.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Kyle Jones as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

◆ Wallner, 25, played in five games for the Saints, hitting .409 (9-for-22) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, seven RBI and a 1.298 OPS...he had back-to-back three-hit games on Thursday (2 homers) and Friday vs. Gwinnett.

◆ Jones, 23, appeared in two games (1 start) for the Kernels, going 1-0, 1.23 ERA (7.1 IP, 1 ER), with five walks and eight strikeouts, while holding opponents to a .154 batting average...the St. Clair Shores, Michigan native was selected by the Twins in the seventh round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Toledo.

◆ On this day in 2012, the Twins beat the Tigers by a score of 6-4 at Comerica Park to give Ron Gardenhire his 900th career managerial victory...Glen Perkins saved the game with 1.0 scoreless inning and two strikeouts.

◆ Bally Sports North analyst, Glen Perkins, made his second and third career appearances in this ballpark on September 23 and 24, 2006...In the first game, he earned a hold, pitching 0.2 innings, inducing a flyball out to Brian Roberts followed by a groundout from Chris Gomez...in his final appearance at Camden Yards on August 23, 2015, he earned the win with 1.0 scoreless inning of relief in a Twins 4-3 12-inning victory...that marked the 34th of his 35 career big league wins.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his second loss of the season despite recording a quality start in his last appearance on June 26 against Atlanta at Truist Park...pitched 6.2 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts in a 4-1 Twins' defeat, opposite Spencer Strider...tossed 102 pitches, his first time throwing over 100 pitches since May 23 vs. San Francisco when he threw 105 pitches...retired nine of the first 13 batters he faced, including a 1-2-3 first inning...yielded an RBI groundout to catcher Travis d'Arnaud after allowing two singles in the fourth inning...allowed his third home run of the season to designated hitter Marcell Ozuna to start the seventh...recorded the next two outs before permitting a single to Michael Harris II and exiting the game...relieved by Emilio Pagán, who allowed a two-run home run to Ronald Acuña Jr. (1 ER charged to Gray)...Josh Winder later pitched a scoreless eighth inning...The

Twins' only run came from a Joey Gallo home run in the second inning off Strider.

© Gray has not earned a win in his last 10 starts, last earning a victory on April 30 vs. Kansas City; the 10-start streak without a win is tied for the third-longest such stretch of his career (also, September 29, 2018 to May 15, 2019).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his third-consecutive no-decision in his last start on June 21 vs. Boston at Target Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and five strikeouts in a 10-inning 5-4 Twins' victory...yielded an RBI double to infielder Rafael Devers in the top of the first inning; marked the first run he has allowed in the first inning since April 18 at Boston...allowed his second home run of the season to designated hitter Justin Turner in the third inning...permitted an RBI single in the fifth inning to Turner for his final run...relieved by Brock Stewart who combined with Griffin Jax to pitch scoreless sixth and seventh innings...Jhoan Duran entered in the eighth inning and allowed a game-tying RBI double to Triston Casas...the Twins won in walk-off fashion in the 10th inning via an RBI single by Kyle Farmer, his second-walk off plate appearance of the season.

GOOD MORNING BALTIMORE: Gray is facing the Orioles for the 13th time in his career, going 6-5, 4.60 ERA (62.2 IP, 32 ER) with 23 walks and 65 strikeouts in his 12 previous starts...last faced Baltimore on July 2, 2022 at Target Field; did not factor into the decision in the 4-3 Twins' walkoff victory after pitching 5.0 innings and allowing three runs on six hits (1 HR), issuing three walks and striking out five batters...yielded his first run on an RBI double to third baseman Tyler Nevin in the second inning...permitted a solo home run to outfielder Anthony Santander in the third inning and allowed his final run a sacrifice fly by Jorge Mateo... relieved by Jharel Cotton in the sixth inning as he combined with Emilio Pagán to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings (Cotton - 3.0, Pagán - 1.0)...Gray pitched opposite Jordan Lyles who pitched 6.0 scoreless innings before allowing a solo home run to Nick Gordon...current Twin Jorge López entered in the ninth inning to close the game for the O's but allowed a game-tying solo home run to Jorge Polanco and a walk-off single to Jose Miranda.

FAR EAST MOVEMENT: Today will be Gray's ninth start against an American League East opponent since joining the Twins...is 1-1, 2.50 ERA (39.2 IP, 11 ER) with 18 walks and 43 strikeouts in his previous eight starts in that span (BOS - 3, BAL - 1, TOR - 2, NYY - 2)...in 60 career appearances (56 career starts) against the AL East, Gray is 17-23, 4.20 ERA (319.0 IP, 149 ER) with 125 walks and 297 strikeouts.
◆ Owns the seventh-lowest ERA against the AL East since the start of 2022 (min. 35.0 IP).

BACK TO THE ROAD: Gray is making his eighth road start of the season; is 1-1, 3.19 ERA (36.2 IP, 13 ER) with 18 walks and 31 strikeouts in his seven prior road outings...is 5-4, 3.45 ERA (88.2 IP, 34 ER) with 29

walks and 70 strikeouts in 18 road starts since becoming a Twin...Twins are 9-9 in those starts.

◆ Currently holds the 11th-lowest road ERA in the American League this season (min. 35.0 IP).

YARD WORK: Gray is making his first start at Camden Yards since August 25, 2018 when he lead the New York Yankes to a 5-1 victory after pitching 6.1 Scoreless innings and allowing just three hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...currently owns a four-game win streak at Camden Yards dating back to September 7, 2017; owns a 0.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 1 ER) with four walk and 26 strikeouts in that span.

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his 4-seam fastball the most at 22.5 percent...allowed his third home run of the season off a fastball in last start on June 25...primarily uses his curveball (186 pitches) and changeup (94 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (190 pitches), sinker (231 pitches) and sweeper (210 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his
