- ☞ Making his 20th start and appearance of 2023 and his 10th home start of the year...also his 52nd career start and appearance.
- ☞ Facing Chicago-AL for the second time this year and third time in his career; is 0-0, 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER) with four walks and 10 strikeouts in two previous starts vs. the White Sox.
- ☞ Owns the most strikeouts (312) and the third-most wins (23) through a pitcher's first 51 career games in Twins history (since 1961).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 16 at Oakland in the Twins' 5-4 win over the Athletics...pitched 5.1 innings and allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), with a season-high-tying three walks and seven strikeouts...allowed a solo home run to designated hitter Jordan Diaz in the second inning...later permitted two runs on three hits, one walk and a sacrifice fly by Diaz in the bottom of the fourth...struck out the side in the fifth inning...was relieved by Jorge López with two on and one out in the sixth inning and Minnesota trailing 3-2; López induced an inning-ending double play to escape the jam...Twins scored three runs in the top of the seventh to complete the comeback win and the three-game series sweep over Oakland.

- ☞ Tied his season high with three walks issued, also walking three on May 30 at Houston.
- ☞ Threw only 55 of his 91 pitches for strikes, a 60.4 strike percentage; marked his lowest strike percentage of the season and second lowest of his career (42/70 - 60.0% on April 8, 2022 vs. Seattle).
- ☞ Through 19 starts, Ryan is among the American League leaders in walks-per-9.0 innings (1.68 - 4th), WHIP (1.03 - 6th), quality starts (12 - T-6th), strikeouts (131 - 7th) and WAR (2.4 - 10th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on July 9 vs. Baltimore in the Twins' 15-2 defeat at Target Field, going 4.1 innings and allowing five runs on five hits (2 HR), with two walks and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...pitched opposite former Twin Kyle Gibson, who earned the win and struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters...allowed a solo home run to leftfielder Austin Hays to start the top of the second...recorded 10 of his first 11 outs via the strikeout...allowed four of the first five batters he faced in the top of the fifth to reach, surrendering a two-run homer to Ramón Urias and issuing back-to-back walks before he was relieved by Jovani Moran, who allowed both inherited runners to score...Twins bullpen allowed 10 runs on 12 hits as Minnesota was swept by the Orioles to end the first half.

- ☞ Struck out a season-high 10 batters for the fourth time this year (also, April 8 vs. Houston, April 13 at New York-AL and May 13 vs. Chicago-NL)...one short of his career high of 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.
- ☞ Threw 98 pitches, the most he has thrown in a start of 5.0-or-fewer innings in his career.

RYAN VS. CHICAGO-AL: Facing the White Sox for the second time this season and third time in his career...is 0-0, 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP, 2 ER) with four walks and 10 strikeouts in his two previous starts vs. Chicago-AL...tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed only one hit vs. the White Sox on May 2 at Guaranteed Rate Field, issuing two walks and striking out seven in a no-decision (Twins fell 3-2)...allowed one-or-fewer hits for the fourth time in his career; had earned the win in his three previous such starts...tonight marks his first career start against Chicago-AL at Target Field.

CENTRAL HEATING: In 21 career starts vs. the American League Central division, Ryan is 12-3 with a 2.22 ERA (125.2 IP, 31 ER), 24 walks, 130 strikeouts and a .183 (82-for-449) opponent batting average...his 2.22 ERA is his lowest against any division in his career...among pitchers who have started at least 20 games against the AL Central, he owns the lowest opponent batting average and third-lowest ERA (Hisashi Iwakuma - 1.99, Pedro Martinez - 2.09) in baseball since the division was formed in 1994.

ON TARGET: In nine home starts this year, Ryan is 5-3, 3.32 ERA (57.0 IP, 21 ER) with eight walks and 70 strikeouts, recording a quality start in five of his nine home outings...Twins have gone 6-3 in his starts at Target Field this season...owns an 8.75 strikeout-to-walk ratio at home in 2023, the third highest among qualified American League pitchers (SEA's George Kirby - 12.80, TB's Zach Eflin - 10.67)...lost his last home start on July 9 vs. Baltimore, allowing five runs on five hits (2 HR) in 4.1 innings, with two walks and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts as the Twins fell 15-2...is 3-3, 4.23 ERA (55.1 IP, 26 ER) with 13 walks and 61 strikeouts in 10 road starts this year.

- ☞ Ryan is 12-8, 3.43 ERA (154.2 IP, 59 ER) with 41 walks and 175 strikeouts in 27 career starts at Target Field...among pitchers with at least 10 career starts at Target Field, he owns the lowest WHIP (0.98), second-lowest opponent batting average (.193), third-lowest opponent OPS (.588), and ninth-lowest ERA since the park opened in 2010.
- ☞ Is 11-7, 3.97 ERA (131.1 IP, 58 ER) with 32 walks and 137 strikeouts in 24 career road starts.

LEFT LEADER: Left-handed hitters are batting just .197 (40-for-203) with a .538 OPS and 55 strikeouts against Ryan this year...his .538 opponent OPS against left-handed hitters is the second lowest in the American League this season (min. 15 GS), trailing only DET's Matthew Boyd (.517)...right-handed hitters are hitting .249 (55-for-221) with a .747 OPS and 76 strikeouts against Ryan in 2023...his .224 (95-for-424) overall opponent batting average in 2023 ranks 10th in the AL among qualified starters.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .195 (101-for-517) with a .594 OPS against him...right-handed hitters are hitting .228 (125-for-548) with a .699 OPS off Ryan.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a four-pitch mix in his first 19 starts of the 2023 season...has leaned on his four-seam fastball and split finger, combining to throw the two pitches 85.7 percent of the time this year...has thrown 1,031 four-seam fastballs this year, the third-highest four-seam fastball total in the American League (NYY's Gerrit Cole - 1,116, CWS's Michael Kopech - 1,045)...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ Ryan has accumulated a run value of 13 on his four-seam fastball, the tied for the fifth-best run value on a four-seamer in baseball this season, according to Baseball Savant...also has a run value of 6 on his splitter, tied for the sixth-best run value on a splitter in the majors.

☞ His .217 opponent batting average against his four-seam fastball is the 10th-lowest batting average vs. a four-seamer in baseball (min. 150 plate appearances)...his .193 opponent batting average against his splitter is the 12th-lowest batting average against a splitter in baseball (min. 50 plate appearances).

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

- ☞ Owns a career-low 2.98 xERA this season, which ranks in the 91st percentile in all of baseball...had a 3.57 xERA in 2022, putting him in the 63rd percentile in MLB...also owns a career-low 6.0 barrel percentage this year, which ranks in the 78th percentile in baseball.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 4-4, 3.16 ERA // CAREER: 94-81, 3.53 ERA)

Sonny Gray is scheduled to start the second game of the three-game series against the White Sox tomorrow night at Target Field...took the loss in his last start on July 17 at Seattle, a 7-6 Twins' defeat; pitched 5.2 innings and allowed five runs on five hits, with a season-high-tying four walks and five strikeouts...has not earned a win since April 30 vs. Kansas City; current 13-start winless streak is the longest of career...facing Chicago-AL for the second time this year and 12th time in his career; is 5-2, 4.08 ERA (57.1 IP, 26 ER) with 23 walks and 53 strikeouts in his previous 11 games (10 starts) vs. the White Sox...earned the win against Chicago-AL on April 12 at Target Field in a 3-1 Twins' victory (5.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 5 K).

- Ortega, López and Sands combined to throw 3.0 IP allowing 3 R (HR - Ford in 8th inn. off López) on 2 H & 4 K in yesterday's loss at SEA...went 4-0 on the 7 G roadtrip allowing 8 R on 15 H, 24 K & 4 S.
- 'Pen is 2-2, 2.53 ERA (21.1 IP, 6 ER), 14 BB, 16 K, 4 HLD, 1 SV, .194 (14-for-72) BAA in 6 games vs. CWS this season.
- 'Pen has thrown 998 offspeed pitches, T-4th most in baseball trailing NYY (1,212), CIN (1,140), DET (1,101) & TB (998)...averaged 90.3 mph on all pitches, T-6th-hardest throwing 'pen in MLB (3rd in AL).
- 'Pen has the 2nd-lowest xBA (.226) in MLB, T-3rd-lowest wOBA (.293) and 11th-lowest xSLG (.380)...also, MIN relievers have allowed the fewest hits (261) among all MLB bullpens.
