BUCK-ING BRONCO ON COUNTRY NIGHT: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 9-4...Joe Ryan (9-6) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and 10 strikeouts...it marked Ryan's sixth career double-digit strikeout total, tied his season-high (3x previously) and was one short of his career high...the offense recorded nine hits, four being home runs from Byron Buxton (16, 17), Alex Kirilloff (8) and Ryan Jeffers (5)...Buxton and Kirilloff each drove in four runs... for Buck, it marked his 10th career multi-homer game, second this season and third of his career against the Sox.

TWINS AND SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the eighth of 13 meetings this season... Minnesota has gone 4-3 against the Sox this season, going 3-1 at Target Field and 1-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...since 2015, the Twins have gone 82-68 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

◆ The Iwins have beat the Sox 68 times (53 losses) at Target Field (since 2010), second most against any opponent (Kansas City - 72).

◆ Christian Vazquez is hitting .333 (38-for-114) with five doubles, one home run, 16 RBI, nine walks, a .382 on-base percentage and a .786 OPS in 36 career games vs. the Sox.

◆ Max Kepler has three home runs in 22 career at-bats vs. Dylan Cease...one of five pitchers that Kepler has homered at least three times against (Trevor Bauer - 5, Mike Clevinger - 3, Lucas Giolito - 3 and Anibal Sánchez - 3).

**BUX FRESH SOX:** Byron Buxton is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with one double, four home runs eight RBI, five walks, a .429 on-base percentage, an .870 slugging percentage and a 1.298 OPS in seven games vs. the White Sox this season...for his career, Buxton is hitting .282 (72-for-255) with 21 doubles, one triple, 19 home runs, 45 RBI, 49 runs scored and a .933 OPS in .74 games vs. the White Sox...below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019). compared to his last 26 (June 30, 2019-present):

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 15th series victory this season...they are 14-13-4 in series play in 2023, going 8-5-2 at home and 6-8-2 on the road.

Twins are seeking their second series win over the Sox this season (also 2 of 3 from 4/10-12)...they are 4-1-0 in series play vs. the Sox at Target Field, dating back to August of 2021.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Despite being swept in three games by Baltimore from July 7-9, leading up to the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 6-3 in their last nine home games...Twins batters have slashed .244/.321/.433 with a .754 OPS and 4.5 runs-per-game in 49 home games this season, compared to .228/.306/.390 with a .696 OPS and 4.2 runs-per-game in 50 road games.

◆ Donovan Solano is hitting .317 (38-for-120) with 11 doubles, two home runs, 15 walks, a .406 on-base percentage and an .864 OPS in 42 games at Target Field this season...Solano ranks fifth in the AL in OBP at home and 12th in batting average (min. 100 PA).

STEADY EDDIE: Edouard Julien has reached base safely in 22 of his last 34 plate appearances...in 12 games since July 3, he is hitting .559 (19-for-34) with three doubles, five home runs, seven RBI, 12 runs scored, six walks and a 1.713 OPS...since being recalled on June 10, he's hitting .380 (35-for-92) with nine doubles, five home runs, eight RBI, 14 walks, 19 runs scored, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.099 OPS in 31 games; since that date, he ranks among the major league leaders (minimum of 100 plate appearances) in batting average (2nd), on-base percentage (3rd), OPS (5th) and slugging (9th .641).

4 Julien has hit safely in a season/career-long nine-straight games, hitting .586 (17-for-29) with a 1.647 OPS in that span...the streak is the second longest by a Twin this season, trailing Donovan Solano's 11-game hitting streak from April 5-16.

**I'LL TAKE BATTING AVERAGE FOR 300, ALEX:** Alex Kirilloff is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 18 RBI, four walks, eight runs scored, a .394 on-base percentage, a .625 slugging percentage and a 1.019 OPS in his last 18 games, since June 26...he has four home runs and 13 RBI in his last six games...additionally, he has 17 RBI this month, fifth most in the AL.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2021, the Twins acquired last night's starter Joe Ryan (along with Drew Strotman) from Tampa Bay, in exchange for Nelson Cruz...at the time, Ryan was in Tokyo, Japan, participating in the delayed 2020 Olympics as a member of the United States Baseball Team...since joining the Twins, Ryan has gone 24-15, 3.73 ERA (292.0 IP, 121 ER) with 74 walks and 322 strikeouts in 52 starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his second-consecutive loss in his last start on July 17 against Seattle at T-Mobile Park...pitched 5.2 innings and allowed five runs on five hits, with a season-high-tying four walks and five strikeouts in a 7-6 Twins' defeat, opposite Logan Gilbert...recorded a 1-2-3 first, third and fourth innings...allowed three runs in the fourth inning (an RBI single by José Caballero, a bases-loaded walk to Julio Rodríguez and a two-run single to Jarred Kelenic)...allowed Cal Raleigh to score on a wild pitch after walking Mike Ford in the sixth inning...replaced by Oliver Ortega in the sixth inning; pitched 1.1 innings and allowed a two-run home run to Eugenio Suárez in the seventh inning...Jorge López pitched a 1-2-3 ninth.

CHICAGO FREESTYLE: Gray is facing the White Sox for the 12th time in his career, going 5-2, 4.08 ERA (57.1 IP, 26 ER) with 23 walks and 53 strikeouts in his 11 previous appearances (including 10 starts)...last faced Chicago-AL on April 12 at Target Field, in a 3-1 Twins' victory in the rubber game of a three-game series...pitched 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits, two walks and five strikeouts...allowed a double to Luis Robert Jr. in the first inning and singles to Andrew Benintendi and Andrew Vaughn in the third inning...retired seven of the final eight batters he faced...relieved by Jorge Alcala in the sixth inning as he combined with Jorge López and Griffin Jax to pitch 3.0 shutout innings (1.0 IP each)...Jhoan Duran entered in the ninth inning and allowed a solo home run to Lenyn Sosa.

◆ Is 1-1, 5.68 ERA (12.2 IP, 8 ER) with four walks and 10 strikeouts in three starts against Chicago-AL since joining the Twins...his ERA against the White Sox is his second highest against any team since the start of 2022, trailing Texas (5.91).

◆ Marks his seventh intra-division start of the season, going 3-1, 2.56 ERA (31.2 IP, 9 ER) with 14 walks and 24 strikeouts in his previous six starts...is 9-3, 2.84 ERA (88.2 IP, 28 ER) with 26 walks and 84 strikeouts in 17 starts against the AL Central since joining the Twins.

TARGET RUN: Gray is making his 11th home start of the season; is 3-2, 3.00 ERA (57.0 IP, 19 ER) with 18 walks and 63 strikeouts in his 10 prior home outings...is 7-4, 2.82 ERA (124.2 IP, 39 ER) with 43 walks and 141 strikeouts in 23 home starts since becoming a Twin; owns the lowest ERA at Target Field since the start of 2022 and owns the second most strikeouts (min. 10 GS), trailing Joe Ryan (170). 

◆ Is 1-1, 6.23 ERA (8.2 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and eight strikeouts in two starts against the White Sox at Target Field...is 3-1, 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP, 9 ER) with 11 walks and 26 strikeouts in five career home games vs. Chicago-AL.
