THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (3-0 vs. Chica-
go-AL and 1-2 vs. Seattle), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a loss
to the Royals at Kauffman Stadium last nighttonight, the Twins will continue the trip with
the second of three at Kauffman Stadiumthey will complete the season series tomorrow
afternoon, then travel to St. Louis for an off-day on Monday, followed by a three-game series
with the Cardinals at Busch Stadium from Tuesday-Thursdaythe Twins have gone 30-24
at home and 24-27 on the road.

To the Twins' 57 remaining games, they have an opponent winning percentage of .477, the second-lowest strength of schedule, trailing only the White Sox (.463).

WITT SLAMS THE DOOR ON THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 8-5 in 10 innings, making the Twins 10-5 in extras this season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Jhoan Duran blew just his fourth save of the season, allowing four runs (3 earned) in the 10th inning, capped off by a Bobby Witt Jr. walk-off grand slam...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Ryan Jeffers, who drove in one run and stole one base...Jorge Polanco returned to the lineup and drove in two runs with a game-tying double in the top of the ninth inning.

◆ The Twins suffered their fifth walk-off defeat of the season (also, April 18 at Boston, May 2 at Chicago-AL, May 15 at Los Angeles-NL and June 7 at Tampa Bay).

◆ Willi Castro stole home on a double steal in the fourth inning, marking the Twins' third steal of home this season — all by Castro — following May 24 vs. San Francisco and July 15 at Oakland...according to Elias, Castro's three steals of home are the second most by a Twin in a single season since 1961, behind Hall of Famer Rod Carew's seven in 1969.

ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 49-29 vs. Kansas City, including a record of 20-18 at Kauffman Stadium...those are both his most wins vs. any opponent and in any non-Target Field ballpark...Rocco and Royals manager Matt Quatraro overlapped on the Tampa Bay Rays' coaching staff for one season in 2018, as Rocco was the major league field coordinator and Quatraro was the third base coach.

◆ Rocco played at Kauffman Stadium as an 11-year-old in 1992 during an AAU National Tournament...he and the team stayed at the Adam's Mark hotel just up the road from the K.

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing the 12th of 13 scheduled meetings in 2023...through 11 games, the Twins have gone 9-2 and outscored the Royals 63-33...the Twins have gone 6-1 at Target Field and 3-1 at Kauffman Stadium.

♣ Twins have scored 5.7 runs-per-game this season vs. the Royals and 6.6 in their last nine.

♣ The Twins '21 wins vs. KC since the start of '22 are their most wins vs. any opponent in that span.

♣ Since the start of last season, Twins starters have gone 15-4, 2.40 ERA (164.2 IP, 44 ER) with 35 walks, 161 strikeouts and a .197 opponent batting average vs. KC.

♣ Twins have a +56 run differential vs. KC since the start of 2022, outscoring them 148-92.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .331 (50-for-151) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 24 walks, a .423 on-base percentage and a .946 OPS in 40 games against the Royals since '19.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .340 (36-for-106) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 16 RBI, 29 runs scored and a 1.043 OPS in his last 27 games against the Royals...in 11 games this season, he is 15-for-38 and slashing .395/.444/.842.

Edouard Julien has an OBP of .490 over the last 14 days (12 games) — tied for fourth best in baseball.
 Max Kepler is batting .320 with two strikes over the last 14 days — tied for seventh best in baseball.
 Carlos Correa has 23 extra-base hits out of 49 total hits against starting pitchers this season — eighth best in baseball.
 Bailey Ober has walked just five of 173 right-handed batters (3%) this season — seventh best in baseball among starting pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched (league avg: 7%)...Ober has not issued a walk to his last 46 batters faced, the fourth-longest active streak in baseball.

ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALL HISTORY: In **2018**, former Twins Jim Thome and Jack Morris were inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame...St. Paul native Morris played one season for the Twins in 1991, going 18-12, 3.43 ERA (246.2 IP, 94 ER), including a World Series record that fall of 2-0, 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER) in three starts against Atlanta, earning World Series MVP honors...he pitched a 10-inning, complete-game shutout in Game 7, with seven hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts opposite Hall of Famer John Smoltz...Thome, who played parts of two seasons with the Twins from 2010-11, hit 37 home runs in 179 games in a Twins uniform, including his 600th and 601st homers at Comerica Park on August 15, 2011, off Rick Porcello and Daniel Schlereth.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision despite recording his seventh-consecutive quality start on July 23 vs. Chicago-AL, a 12-inning, 5-4 Twins' victory...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs (2 ER) on five hits (2 HR), with no walks and six strikeouts...marked the second time in his career he has issued zero walks in at least two-consecutive starts (also, 3 starts from August 30-September 12, 2021)...allowed solo homers to Eloy Jiménez in the second inning and Zach Remillard in the third inning; marked the fourth time this year he has permitted two homers in a start (May 11 vs. San Diego, June 14 vs. Milwaukee, June 20 vs. Boston)...later allowed an unearned run in the top of the sixth inning after Oscar Colás advanced to third on an error and scored on Remillard's RBI single... relieved by Oliver Ortega in the seventh inning who combined with Jorge López to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings (Ortega - 2.0 IP, López - 1.0 IP)...the Twins tied the game in the bottom in the ninth inning with three runs off Kendall Graveman (RBI doubles by Willi Castro and Alex Kirilloff and a sacrifice fly by Carlos Correa)...Jhoan Duran entered in the 10th inning and permitted an RBI double to Tim Anderson...the Twins won the game in the 12th inning via a walk-off RBI single by Ryan Jeffers to complete the sweep of the White Sox.

Among American League pitchers with at least 15 games started in 2023, Ober ranks first in WHIP (0.97), third in ERA (2.76), fifth in walks-per-9.0 innings (1.71), sixth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.00) and seventh in opponent batting average (2.15).

Currently owns a 10-game streak with three-or-fewer earned runs allowed, tied with NYY's Gerrit Cole for the second-longest active streak among American League starters this season, trailing only NYY's Clarke Schmidt (11).

Has recorded a quality start in seven-straight outings, the second-longest active quality start streak among all starters in the majors, trailing only SD's Joe Musgrove
