go-Al and : Atter completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (3-0 vs. Chicato the Royals at Kauffman Stadium last night ...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the second of three at Kauffman Stadium..they will complete the season series tomorrow atternoon, then travel to St. Louls for an oft-day on Monday, followed by a three-game series
with the Cardinals at Busch Stadium from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 30-24 with the Cardinals at Busch sta
at home and $24-27$ on the road.
$\Phi$ Of the Twins' 57 remaining games, they have an opponent winning percentage of 477 , the
second-lowest strength of schedule, trailing only the White Sox (.463).
WITT SLAMS THE DOOR ON THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 8 - 5 in 10 innings, making the Twins $10-5$ in extras this season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on five hits in
6.0 innings pitched with no walks and five strikeouts...h'oan Duran blew just his fourth save of the season, allowing four runs ( 3 earned) in the 10th inning capped off by a Bobby Witt Jr. walk-off grand slam...the offense recorded eight hits two from Ryan Jeffers, who drove in one run and stole one base...Jorge Polanco returned to the lineup and drove in two runs with a game-tying double in the top of the ninth inning.
\$ The Twins suffered their fifth walk-off defeat of the season (also, April 18 at Boston, May
2 at Chicago-AL, May 15 at Los Angeles-NL and June 7 at Tampa Bay). क Willi Castro stole home on a doube steal in the fourth innino markin
steal of home this season - all by Castro - following May 24 ' vs. San Francisco and July
15 at Oakland...according to Elias. Castro's three steals of home are the second most by
a Twin in a single season since 1961, behind Hall of Famer Rod Carew's seven in 1969 .
ROCCO-FELLA RECORDS: Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 49-29 vs. Kansas City, including a record of $20-18$ at Kauffman Stadium...those are both his most wins vs any
opponent and in any non-Target Field ballpark...Rocco and Royals manager Matt Quatraro overlapped on the Tampa Bay Rays' coaching staff for one season in 2018, as Rocco was the major league field coordinator and Quatraro was the third base coach.
$\Phi$ Rocco played at Kauffman Stadium as an 11-year-old in 1992 during an AAU National
Tournament...he and the team stayed at the Adam's Mark hotel just up the road from the K.
ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins and Royals are playing the 12 th of 13 scheduled meetings in 2023..through 11 games, the Twins have gone 9-2 and outscored the Royals 63-33...the Twins have gone 6-1 at Target Field and 3-1 at Kauffman Stadium.
T Wins have scored 5.7 runs-per-game this season vs. the Rovals and 6.6 in their last nine. $\Phi$ The Twins 21 wins ss. . C since the start of 22 are their most wins vs. any opponent in that span.

complete-game shutout in Game 7 , with seven hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts opposite Hall of Famer John Smoltz Thome who played parts of two seasons with the Twins from 2010-11, hit 37 home runs in 179 games in a Twins uniform, including his 600th and 601 st homers at Comerica Park on August 15, 2011, off Rick Porcello and Daniel Schlereth.

AST START: Did not factor into the decision despite recording his seventh-consecutive quality start on July 23 vs. Chicago-AL, a 12-inning, 5-4 Twins victory...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs (2 ER) on five hits ( 2 HR ), with no walks and six strikeouts...marked the second time in his career he has issued zero walks in at least two-consecutive starts (also, 3 starts from August 30 -September 12, 2021)...allowed solo homers to Eloy Jimenez in the second inning and Zach Remillard in the third inning; marked the fourth time this year he has permitted two homers in a start (May 11 vs. San sixth inning after Oscar Colas advanced to third on an error and scored on Remillard's RBI single... relieved by Oliver Ortega in the seventh inning who combined with Jorge López to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings (Ortega - 2.0 IP, Lopez - 1.0 IP)...the Twins tied the game in the bottom in the ninth inning with three runs off Kendall Graveman (RBI doubles by Willi Castro and Alex Kirilloff and a sacrifice fly by Carlos Correa)....Jhoan Duran entered in the 10th inning and permitted an RBI double to Tim Anderson...the Twins won the game in the 12th inning via a walk-off RBI single by Ryan Jeffers to

in WHIP (0.97), third in ERA (276) fifth in walks-per-9.0 innings in 2023, Ober ranks first to -walk ratio ( 5.00 ) and seventh in opponent batting average (.215).
$\Phi$ Currently owns a 10-game streak with three-or-tewer earned runs allowed, tied with NYY's Gerrit Cole for the second-longest active streak among American League starters this season, trailing only NYY's Clarke Schmidt (11).
$\Phi$ Has recorded a quality start in seven-straight outings, the second-longest active quality start streak among all starters in the majors, trailing only SD's Joe Musgrove (8).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win in his 10th quality start of the season on July 18 at Seattle, a 10-3 Twins' victory...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits ( 1 HR), issued no walks and struck out five batters...allowed all three runs in the first inning off six hits (a leadoff single by Hernández, an RBI double from Ty France and a single by Mil by Jarred Kelenic, a single by Teoscar a strikeout to Cal Raleigh....assisted by Max Kepler and Joey Gallo who each threw out a runner out at home; per Elias, it marked the first time in Twins history (1961-present) that the club recorded multiple outfield assists resulting in putouts of a runner by the catcher in the first inning, as well as just the third time that the club recorded two such assists in any inning, joining the sixth inning
on April 10,2014 (Darin Mastroianni and Aaron Hicks) and the sixth inning on April Cave and Kyle Garlick)...only allowed two base runners after the first inning (a double in the second inning to Jose Caballero and a fifth-inning hit-by-pitch to Suárez) relieved by Jordan Balazovic in inning to Jose caballero and a fitth-inning hit-by-pitch to Suarez)...relieved
the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings.

OBER VS. KANSAS CITY: Facing the Royals for the second time this season and seventh time in his career tonight...is 0-1, 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER) with five walks and 28 strikeouts in six previous starts against Kansas City; Twins are 3-3' in those starts...last faced the Royals on April 29 at Target Field, taking a no-decision in a 3-2 Twins' loss; allowed one run on four hits in 5.2 inning pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...marked his longest start by innings against Kansas City in his career.

- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in

Fort Myers, FL....was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.

- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.

Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
