THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (3-0 vs. Chicago-AL and 1-2 vs. Seattle), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with consecutive losses to the Royals at Kauffman Stadium...today, the Twins will wrap the series with their final game of 2023 vs. the Royals...after today's game, they will travel to St. Louis for an off-day tomorrow, followed by a three-game series with the Cardinals at Busch Stadium from Tuesday-Thursday...the Twins have gone 30-24 at home and 24-28 on the road.

SATURDAYS ARE FOR THE ROYALS: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium, losing the three-game series, their first series defeat vs. KC this season...Bailey Ober (6-5) was the starter and loser, allowing a career-high six runs on a career-high 11 hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 12 hits, including three from Byron Buxton, who doubled three times and drove in two runs...Max Kepler reached base three times with two hits and a walk, including his 15th home run of the season.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have returned left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Thielbar, who has missed the Twins' last 46 games with a right oblique strain, made two appearances on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings with one walk and two strikeouts. In 12 appearances for the Twins this season, he has gone 0-1, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), two walks, 10 strikeouts, seven holds and a 0.97 WHIP...to make room for Thielbar on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder/first baseman Alex Kirilloff on the 10-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain...Kirilloff has hit .270 (61-for-226) with 13 doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 32 RBI, 25 walks, 24 runs scored and a .799 OPS in 69 games for the Twins this season.

AUGUST RUSH: Today marks the final game of July for the Twins...below are the offense and pitching comparisons for the first four months:

NOTE: The Twins went 14-14 in August of 2022, as pitchers posted a 3.46 ERA...hitters posted a .700 OPS last August and hit 26 home runs, while scoring 117 runs.

TWINS-ROYALS: The Twins and Royals are playing the 13th and final time in 2023...through 12 games, the Twins have gone 9-3, including 6-1 at Target Field and 3-2 at Kauffman Stadium. The Twins will play Kansas City 13 times in 2024, seven at home and six on the road...Minnesota will open the season here again from March 28-31...they will host the Royals for the first time in 2024 from May 27-30. Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 49-30 vs. Kansas City, including a record of 20-19 at Kauffman Stadium...those are both his most wins vs. any opponent and in any non-Target Field ballpark. Twins have scored 5.8 runs-per-game this season vs. the Royals and 6.6 in their last 10. The Twins' 21 wins vs. KC since the start of '22 are their most wins vs. any opponent in that span. Carlos Correa is hitting .327 (51-for-156) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 24 walks, a .417 on-base percentage and a .929 OPS in 41 games against the Royals since '19. Byron Buxton is hitting .358 (39-for-109) with 13 doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 31 runs scored and a 1.099 OPS in his last 28 games against the Royals...in 12 games this season, he is 18-for-41 and slashing .439/.490/.927.

SECOND HALF SURGE: Despite four-straight losses, the Twins have gone 9-6 since the All-Star break, tied with four other teams for the second-most wins in baseball...below are the offensive numbers and MLB ranks pre-All-Star break vs. post-All-Star break:

LEAVE THE BROOMS ALONE: Twins are looking to avoid being swept today for the fourth time this season...the other three sweeps came in three games at Tropicana Field from June 6-8 against the Rays, three games at Truist Park from June 26-28 against the Braves and three game against the Orioles from July 7-9 at Target Field...the last time the Twins were swept by the Royals was in three games at Kauffman from September 20-22, 2022. Minnesota has faced a potential sweep five times this season, salvaging the series finale three of five times...the three times they avoided a sweep were April 21-23 vs. Washington, May 2-4 at Chicago-AL and May 22-24 vs. San Francisco.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Today marks the 23rd time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter...Twins are 11-11 when a left-hander is the opposing starter...the Twins have faced just two left-handed starters since the All-Star break: Oakland's Ken Waldichuk (5-4 win on 7/14) and JP Sears (5-4 win on 7/16). The Twins have the lowest batting average (.218) and lowest OPS (.657) vs. lefties in baseball.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Double-A Wichita infielder Junior Severino and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews are the Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week. Severino, 23, hit .313 (5-for-16) with four home runs, six RBI, two walks, a .389 on-base percentage and a 1.451 OPS for the Wind Surge, including homers in four-straight games from Tuesday-Friday all vs. Frisco...the Santo Domingo, DR native was signed as an international free agent in July of 2016. Matthews, 23, made one start for the Kernels on Thursday at Wisconsin, allowing one run on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the Cullowhee, NC native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Western Carolina University.

- ☞ Facing the Royals for the second time this season and fourth time in his career; earned the win vs. Kansas City on July 4 at Target Field in the Twins' 9-3 victory (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 9 K).
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his second-straight no-decision vs. Seattle and third-consecutive no-decision overall on July 24 at Target Field in a 4-3 Minnesota win...allowed one run on six hits (1 HR) in 6.1 innings pitched, with two walks and eight strikeouts...held the Mariners scoreless through his first 4.0 innings, allowing three singles and one double...yielded a solo homer to catcher Tom Murphy in the top of the fifth inning; marked Murphy's second homer off Maeda in his last two starts...issued two walks in the top of the seventh and was relieved by Jovani Moran, who stranded both inherited runners to preserve the Twins' 2-1 lead...after Griffin Jax blew a save opportunity in the top of the ninth, the Twins rallied for a run in both the ninth and 10th innings to record a walk-off win in the series opener.

☞ Recorded back-to-back quality starts for the first time since July 22, 2021 vs. Los Angeles-AL and July 27, 2021 vs. Detroit.

☞ Recorded an out in the seventh inning for the third time in his last four starts (7.0 IP on July 4 vs. Kansas City, 6.1 IP on July 19 at Seattle) after pitching 6.0-or-fewer innings in his previous 10 starts from August 3, 2021 to June 28, 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on July 19 at Seattle, a 6-3 Twins' win at T-Mobile Park...pitched 6.1 innings and allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and a season-high-tying nine strikeouts...retired 15 of the first 16 batters he faced, facing the minimum through 5.1 innings...allowed a solo home run to catcher Tom Murphy in the bottom of the sixth...was relieved by Griffin Jax with one out in the sixth inning after allowing a single to leftfielder Jarrod Kelenic; Jax yielded a game-tying two-run homer to third baseman Eugenio Suárez, but the Twins scored three runs in the final two innings to secure the victory.

☞ Struck out a season-high nine batters for the third time this season, also doing so on April 4 at Miami and July 4 vs. Kansas City.

☞ Reached 800.0 career innings after retiring rightfielder Teoscar Hernández to end the bottom of the second; became the seventh Japanese-born pitcher with 800.0 MLB innings.

HEATING UP: Since being returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) on June 23, Maeda is 2-1 with a 2.48 ERA (32.2 IP, 9 ER), 11 walks, 44 strikeouts and a .209 (24-for-115) opponent batting average in six starts...his 44 strikeouts since June 23 are the fourth most in the American League and his 1.07 WHIP ranks 11th (min. 6 GS) in that span...here are his numbers in his last six starts compared to his first four outings of 2023:

KANSAS CITY KING: Facing the Royals for the second time this season and fourth time in his career...is 3-0, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER) with four walks, 24 strikeouts and a .150 (9-for-60) opponent batting average in his three previous starts against Kansas City...earned the win in his last start vs. the Royals on July 4 at Target Field, a 9-3 Twins' victory; pitched a season-high 7.0 innings and allowed two runs (1 ER) on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and a season-high-tying nine strikeouts...marked his longest start by innings since also throwing 7.0 innings on July 22, 2021 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

☞ His 1.00 ERA against Kansas City is his lowest against any opponent in his career (min. 3 GS)...the Royals are one of two teams he owns an undefeated record against (min. 2 GS), also having a perfect mark against the Rangers (2-0 in 4 appearances/3 starts).

☞ Is one of two pitchers (TOR's Alek Manoah, 4-0 in 4 GS) to have an active win streak of three-or-more games against Kansas City to start their career.

ROAD WELL TRAVELED: Making his seventh road start of the season today...is 1-3, 3.08 ERA (26.1 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks, 36 strikeouts and a .204 (19-for-93) opponent batting average in six road starts this year; Twins have gone 3-3 in his six road outings...his .613 opponent OPS on the road is the seventh lowest in the American League this season (min. 6 road GS), and his 1.06 road WHIP is the 11th lowest in the AL...is 1-2, 6.45 ERA (22.1 IP, 16 ER) with five walks and 22 strikeouts in four starts at Target Field in 2023.

☞ Making his second career start at Kauffman Stadium...earned the win in his only previous start here on July 4, 2021, a 6-2 Twins' victory; pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, one walk and a season-high 10 strikeouts.

☞ Is 27-25, 4.61 ERA (414.0 IP, 212 ER) with 133 walks and 455 strikeouts in 96 career road appearances (80 starts)...in 83 career home appearances (65 starts), he is 34-21, 3.20 ERA (396.2 IP, 141 ER) with 101 walks and 437 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Maeda has used a five-pitch mix this year, throwing his slider and split finger the most; he utilizes the pair a combined 68.2 percent of the time...favors his split finger (152/253 - 60.1%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (191/273 - 70.0%) and sinker (48/48 - 100%) against righties...recorded five strikeouts with his slider in his last start on July 24 vs. Seattle, tied for his most in any start this season (also, April 4 at Miami)...also threw a season-high-tying 31 split-fingers in his last outing, done twice previously (July 4 vs. Kansas City, July 19 at Seattle)...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

☞ Opponents own a .016 ISO against Maeda's splitter this season, the second-lowest ISO against a splitter in baseball (min. 20 plate appearances).

TWO DOWN: Opposing batters are hitting just .196 (11-for-56) with a .237 on-base percentage and a .523 OPS against Maeda with two outs this season...his .523 opponent OPS with two outs is the lowest on the Twins staff and fifth lowest in the American League in 2023 (min. 10 GS)...over his career, Maeda has limited opposing hitters to a .203 (190-for-935) batting average and .632 OPS with two outs...his .203 career opposing batting average with two outs is the fifth lowest in baseball since 2016 (min. 750.0 IP).

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 5-6, 4.13 ERA // CAREER: 33-37, 3.97 ERA)

Pablo López is set to start the three-game series opener against the St. Louis Cardinals on Tuesday night at Busch Stadium...recorded a quality start but took a no-decision in his last start on July 25 vs. Seattle, a 9-7 Twins' defeat at Target Field...pitched 7.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (2 HR), with one walk and eight strikeouts; Twins bullpen failed to hold a four-run lead, allowing seven runs in the final two innings...facing St. Louis for the fifth time in his career and first time since June 27, 2022, when he took the loss in the Marlins' 9-0 defeat at Busch Stadium (5.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R/ER, 2 HR, 1 BB, 5 K)...has recorded a quality start in three of his four career outings against the Cardinals, going 1-2, 3.16 ERA (25.2 IP, 9 ER) with four walks and 25 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow.
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
