THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record of 4-5 (2-1 in
Detroit, 0-3 in Atlanta and 2-1 in Baltimore), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day
homestand with a three-game sweep over the Royalstonight, the Twins will begin a three- game weekend series against the Orioles leading up to the All-Star breakthe Twins have
game weekend series against the Orioles leading up to the All-Star breakthe Twins have
gone 26-19 at home and 19-24 on the road.

◆ After the All-Star break, the Twins will go on a seven-game roadtrip with three against Oakland from July 14-16 and four against Seattle from July 17-20.

PABLO LÓPEZ RYAN JEFFERS: The Twins beat the Royals on Wednesday night by a score of 5-0, recording their eighth shutout of the season and completing the three-game sweep—their third sweep of the season (2nd of 3 games)...Pablo López (5-5) pitched his first career complete-game shutout, allowing four hits with no walks and a career-high 12 strikeouts... Ryan Jeffers had two of the club's five hits, including his fourth home run of the season.
◆ López and Joe Ryan (June 22 vs. BOS) became the first pair of Twins teammates to both throw a complete-game shutout in the same season since Brian Duensing, Francisco Liriano (no-hitter) and Carl Pavano all did so in 2011.

◆ The Twins are one of four teams in baseball with multiple complete games this season, joining Texas (3), New York-AL (2) and Seattle (2).

TWINS AND O's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fourth of six meetings in 2023...these two played a three-game series last weekend as the Twins won the first two games and outscored the O's 10-3 in the series...Twins vs. Baltimore since 2017 in box to the bottom right.
♣ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 42 home runs against Baltimore for an average of 1.9 home runs-per-game (22 games).
♣ The Twins are 38-18 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.
♣ Byron Buxton has a .982 OPS in his last nine games vs. Baltimore, with four home runs and 10 RBI in that span.
♣ Michael A. Taylor is hitting .301 (34-for-113) with five doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI, 11 walks, a .365 on-base percentage and a .790 OPS in 37 career games against the O's.
♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .298 (28-for-94) with seven doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, six walks, a .352 on-base percentage, a .532 slugging percentage and an .884 OPS in his last 25 games vs. the Orioles (since May of 2017).
♣ Max Kepler is hitting .350 (35-for-100) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 24 RBI, 12 walks, a .416 OBP and a 1.156 OPS in 28 career games against Baltimore.

MAX EFFORT: Max Kepler is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with five home runs, 12 RBI, seven runs scored, four walks, a .367 on-base percentage, a .644 slugging percentage and a 1.012 OPS in his last 15 games...in that span, he is slashing .308/.308/.538 against left-handed pitching with just two strikeouts.

NUMBER ONE HIT: Carlos Correa went 0-for-2 on Wednesday night but drew two walks and has now reached safely in all six games since being placed in the leadoff spot on June 30...in those six games, he is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with two doubles, two walks, five runs scored, a .444 on-base percentage and a .903 OPS.

OUTSTANDING 'PENMANSHIP: Over the last 12 games, since June 21, the Twins bullpen has posted a 2.23 ERA (36.1 IP, 9 ER) with 14 walks, 40 strikeouts, a .183 opponent batting average and a .553 opponent OPS...since that date, they rank second in baseball in opponent batting average and opponent OPS and third in ERA.

DONNIE BARRELS: Since June 1, Donovan Solano has posted a .398 on-base percentage in 30 games, reaching 41 times in 103 plate appearances (24 hits, 15 walks, 2 HBP)...in 38 home games this season, he is hitting .321 (34-for-106) with 15 walks, a .415 on-base percentage and an .867 OPS...in 16 home games since June 1, he is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with a .456 on-base percentage and a 1.031 OPS.

BIRTHDAY BOYS: Twins radio studs Dan Gladden and Cory Provus are both celebrating their birthday today...the Twins are 21-37 all-time on their birthday, tied for fifth-fewest wins of any day in July...they both share a birthday with Gladden's former broadcast partner John Gordon (aka Wally Holland), comedian Jim Gaffigan and musician Ringo Starr.

Gladden appeared in five career games on his birthday, hitting .526 (10-for-19) with one double, four RBI, five runs scored and three three-hit games.

MINOR MATTERS: High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Tanner Schobel has been named Midwest League Player of the Month and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper has been named Florida State League Pitcher of the Month.

Schobel played in 23 games for the Kernels, hitting, 323 (30-for-93) with two doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 26 RBI, 25 runs scored, 11 walks, a. 400 on-base percentage and a 1.013 OPS...he led the league in hits, runs, homers, RBI and slugging percentage (.613).

Culpepper went 3-1, 1.35 ERA (20.0 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks, 24 strikeouts and a .177 opponent batting average...in his first start of the month, he threw 5.0 no-hit innings and in his final start of the month he allowed one hit over 6.0 innings.

LAST START: Earned his fifth win of the season on July 1 at Baltimore...pitched a season-high-tying 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed just two hits, issued zero walks and struck a season-high-tying eight batters in his second-consecutive game...marked his eighth quality start of the season; owns the third-most quality starts in the Twins' rotation, trailing Joe Ryan (12) and Pablo López (11)... pitched a 1-2-3 first inning...allowed a single to Gunnar Henderson in the second inning...retired 13 of the next 14 batters he faced before allowing another single to Anthony Santander in the seventh (hit Ryan O'Hearn with a pitch in the fourth)...relieved by Griffin Jax in the eighth inning who combined with Jhoan Duran to pitch 2.0 scoreless innings to complete the shutout...the only run scored by the Twins was on a solo home run by Joey Gallo in the fourth inning...marked just the second 1-0 shutout of the season for Minnesota (also, June 2 vs. Cleveland, an Ober start).

Among American League pitchers with at least 13 games started in 2023, Ober ranks second in WHIP (0.95), third in opponent batting average (.208), fourth in ERA (2.70), sixth in walksper-9.0 innings (1.76), and sixth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.93).

Currently owns a seven-game streak of allowing three-or-fewer earned runs...tied for the fifthlongest active streak among American League starters this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start on June 25 against Detroit at Comerica Park, a 6-3 Twins' victory...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits, issued one walk and struck out a season-high eight batters in his seventh quality start of the season...pitched 1-2-3 first and second innings before allowing a single and a double to start the third inning; then yielded a two-run double to Zach McKinstry and a go-ahead RBI single to Kerry Carpenter...retired nine of the final 11 batters he faced after the RBI single, including striking out the side in the fifth inning...relieved by Jordan Balazovic in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings with one hit and six strikeouts...Royce Lewis scored the tying run in the seventh inning on a throwing error by Chasen Shreve...the Twins entered extra innings for the 11th time this season; Minnesota scored three runs on three singles by Lewis, Willi Castro and Christian Vázquez to improve to 8-3 in extra innings.

FABULOUS FIRST HALF: Ober has posted a 0.95 WHIP in 13 starts this year, **the lowest WHIP by a qualified pitcher before the All-Star break in Twins history** (since 1961)...also owns the 11th-lowest opponent batting average (.208), 13th-lowest strikeouts-per-walk ratio (4.93) and 14th-lowest first-half ERA (2.70) in Twins history...is 7-7, 3.64 ERA (143.1 IP, 58 ER) with 33 walks and 140 strikeouts in 28 career first-half starts.

ICTERUS GALBULA: Facing the Orioles for the second time in his career...last faced the Orioles in his last start on July 1 for the first time in his career...marks the fourth time in his career Ober has faced the same opponent in consecutive starts (last, September 27- October 3, 2022 against Chicago- AL).

I'M GOING HOME: Ober is making his ninth home start of the season tonight...is 2-3, 3.18 ERA (45.1 IP, 16 ER) with 10 walks and 39 strikeouts in eight home starts this season; earned home victories on April 23 vs. Washington and June 14 vs. Milwaukee...is 3-1, 2.01 ERA (31.1 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 35 strikeouts in five road starts in 2023.

© In 23 career home starts, Ober has gone 6-4 with a 3.61 ERA (117.1 IP, 47 ER), 27 walks and 116 strikeouts...is 4-6 with a 3.26 ERA (107.2 IP, 39 ER), 18 walks and 105 strikeouts in 21 carreer read games.

TO THE LEFT: Left-handed hitters are batting .196 (29-for-148) with 36 strikeouts and 11 walks against Ober after 13 starts this season...right-handed hitters are hitting .221 (29-for-131) with 38 strikeouts and four walks...lefties went just 2-for-18 with seven strikeouts against him in his last start on July 1 at Baltimore while righties went 0-for-5 with one strikeout...in his career, left-handed hitters are batting .247/.309/.395 with 94 strikeouts against Ober...righties are hitting .223/.246/.421 with 127 strikeouts off him.

**Owns the fifth-lowest opponent batting average against left-handed hitters among American League pitchers with at least 13 starts this season...also has the fifth-lowest slugging percentage (.297) and OPS (.558) against lefties this year.

ARSENAL: Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his 13 starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant. mostly uses his slider against righties while relying on his changeup and curveball against lefties... recorded five of his eight strikeouts with his changeup in his last start on July 1 at Baltimore...here's
