THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record of 4-5 (2-1 in Detroit, 0-3 in Atlanta and 2-1 in Baltimore), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a three-game sweep over the Royals, followed by a loss to the Orioles last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three against the Orioles leading up to the All-Star break...the Twins have gone 26-20 at home and 19-24 on the road.

TWINS DROP OPENER WITH 0'S IN EXTRAS: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night by a score of 3-1 in 10 innings at Target Field, making them 8-4 in extras this season...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...Jhoan Duran (2-4) was issued the loss, allowing two runs to cross in the top of the 10th inning...the offense recorded five hits and was led by Willi Castro, who went 1-for-3 with the only RBI on the night...the attendance was 32,724, the fourth highest at Target Field this season and highest since June 13 vs. Milwaukee (34,514).

IT'S ALL SON SHINE, NOTHING BUT SON SHINE: Sonny Gray will be the lone representative for the Twins during the All-Star break this upcoming week...it marks his third career selection after being named to the 2015 team with Oakland (DNP) and the 2019 team with Cincinnati (DNP)...Gray has gone 4-2, 2.50 ERA (93.2 IP, 26 ER) with 36 walks, 96 strikeouts and just three home runs allowed in 17 starts...among AL starters, he ranks first in home runs allowed (3) and opponent slugging percentage (.326), second in FIP (2.82) and ERA, and fifth in WAR (2.90)...Gray is the 18th different starting pitcher in club history to be selected to the All-Star team...below are the Twins All-Star SPs (since 1961):

TWINS AND O'S: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fifth of six meetings in 2023...the Twins are 2-2 vs. Baltimore this season, going 2-1 at Camden last weekend, followed by a loss last night at Target Field...if the Twins win the next two games, they will secure the season series over the Orioles for the sixth-consecutive season (4-3 in 2022, 4-2 in 2021, 6-0 in 2019, 6-1 in 2018 and 5-2 in 2017).

The Twins are 38-19 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.
Byron Buxton has an .886 OPS in his last 10 games vs. Baltimore, with four home runs and 10 RBI in that span.
Carlos Correa is hitting .296 (29-for-98) with seven doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, six walks, a .349 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS in his last 26 games vs. the Orioles (since May of 2017).
Max Kepler is hitting .337 (35-for-104) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 24 RBI, 12 walks, a .402 OBP and a 1.113 OPS in 29 career games against Baltimore.

ALSO: Seven-consecutive quality starts is the club's longest streak since 10-consecutive from July 9-20, 2011...the franchise record (Twins and Senators since 1901) is 17 from August 26-September 9, 1915. (Elias)

NUMBER ONE HIT: Carlos Correa went 1-for-4 last night and has now reached safely in all seven games since being inserted in the leadoff spot on June 30...in those seven games, he is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with two doubles, two walks, five runs scored, a .419 on-base percentage and an .848 OPS...additionally, in those seven games since June 30, his .419 on-base percentage is tied for 11th best in the AL.

DONNIE BARRELS: Since June 1, Donovan Solano has posted a .393 on-base percentage in 31 games, reaching 42 times in 107 plate appearances (25 hits, 15 walks, 2 HBP)...in 39 home games this season, he is hitting .318 (35-for-110) with 15 walks, a .409 on-base percentage and an .855 OPS...in 16 home games since June 1, he is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with a .443 on-base percentage and a .992 OPS.
Solano's .372 OBP and 27 walks this season are both career highs.

FAST WILLI: Willi Castro stole another base last night giving him four in his last four games and 19 on the season...his 19 steals before the break are the most for a Twin since Eduardo Nuñez swiped 22 in 2016...seven different Twins have reached 20 steals before the ASB (Rod Carew - 3x, Chuck Knoblauch - 4x, Cesar Iovar - 2x, Carlos Gomez - 1x, Larry Hise - 1x, Eduardo Nuñez - 1x and Willie Norwood - 1x), with Carew's 35 in 1976 being the record...Castro's 19 steals are tied for seventh most in the AL...he is on pace to steal 34 bases this season, which would mark the most for a Twin since Ben Revere stole 40 in 2012.

ARE YOU SIRIUS?: The SiriusXM Futures Game will take place at 5 pm (CT) at T-Mobile Park in Seattle today on Peacock and SiriusXM...Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher David Festa will be representing the Twins for the American League team...the following players have represented the Twins over the last 10 years: Spencer Steer and Matt Wallner in 2022, Josh Winder in 2021, Jordan Balazovic and Royce Lewis in 2019, Alex Kirilloff and Lewis Thorpe in 2018, Nick Gordon in 2017, JT Chargois in 2016, José Berrios in 2015 & '14, Max Kepler in 2015, Trevor May, Alex Meyer and Kennys Vargas in 2014, and Byron Buxton and Miguel Sanó in 2013. ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2015, Bally Sports North analyst Glen Perkins converted his 28th-straight save opportunity, setting a club record, passing Joe Nathan's 27 straight (May 8-August 15, 2004)...it marked his 116th career save, tying Eddie Guardado for third on the Twins all-time list (Joe Nathan - 260, Rick Aguilera - 254)...Perkins finished his career with 120 saves.

Jax (1.0 IP), Moran (1.0 IP), Duran (1.2 IP) and Pagan (0.1 IP) all combined to work 4.0 IP last night allowing 2 R (1 ER) in the 10th inning; Duran taking his second-straight loss of the year, both vs BAL. 'Pen has allowed just 24 H and 11 R, w/ 46 K and a .176 BAA in last 13 G (40.1 IP, 2.23 ERA). 'Pen is 0-2-1, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER) with 6 H, 2 BB & 12 K in 4 games vs BAL this season. 'Pen has thrown 924 offspeed pitches, 5th most in baseball trailing NYY (1,087), CIN (1,087), DET (1,025) & TB (925)...they have averaged 90.3 mph on all pitches, 6th-hardest throwing 'pen in MLB (3rd in AL).
