THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record of 4-5 (2-1 in Detroit, 0-3 in Atlanta and 2-1 in Baltimore), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a three-game sweep over the Royals, followed by a loss to the Orioles last night...today, the Twins will play the second of three against the Orioles leading up to the All-Star break...the Twins have gone 26-20 at home and 19-24 on the road.

◆ After the All-Star break, the Twins will go on a seven-game roadtrip with three against Oakland from July 14-16 and four against Seattle from July 17-20.

TWINS DROP OPENER WITH 0's IN EXTRAS: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night by a score of 3-1 in 10 innings at Target Field, making them 8-4 in extras this season...Bailey Ober sthe starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...Jhoan Duran (2-4) was issued the loss, allowing two runs to cross in the top of the 10th inning...the offense recorded five hits and was led by Willi Castro, who went 1-for-3 with the only RBI on the night...the attendance was 32,724, the fourth highest at Target Field this season and highest since June 13 vs. Milwaukee (34,514).

IT'S ALL SON SHINE, NOTHING BUT SON SHINE: Sonny Gray will be the lone representative for the Twins during the All-Star break this upcoming week...it marks his third career selection after being named to the 2015 team with Dakland (DNP) and the 2019 team with Cincinnati (DNP)...Gray has gone 4-2, 2.50 ERA (93.2 IP, 26 ER) with 36 walks, 96 strikeouts and just three home runs allowed in 17 starts...among AL starters, he ranks first in home runs allowed (3) and opponent slugging percentage (.326), second in FIP (2.82) and ERA, and fifth in WAR (2.90)...Gray is the 18th different starting pitcher in club history to be selected to the All-Star team...below are the Twins All-Star SPs (since 1961):

TWINS AND 0's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fifth of six meetings in 2023...the Iwins are 2-2 vs. Baltimore this season, going 2-1 at Camden last weekend followed by a loss last night at Target Field...if the Twins win the next two games, they will secure the season series over the Orioles for the sixth-consecutive season (4-3 in 2022, 4-2 in 2021, 6-0 in 2019, 6-1 in 2018 and 5-2 in 2017).

♣ The Twins are 38-19 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

♣ Byron Buxton has an .886 OPS in his last 10 games vs. Baltimore, with four home runs and 10 RBI in that span.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .296 (29-for-98) with seven doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, six walks, a .349 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and an .869 OPS in his last 26 games vs. the Orioles (since May of 2017).

♣ Max Kepler is hitting .337 (35-for-104) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 24 RBI, 12 walks, a .402 OBP and a 1.113 OPS in 29 career games against Baltimore.

NUMBER ONE HIT: Carlos Correa went 1-for-4 last night and has now reached safely in all seven games since being inserted in the leadoff spot on June 30...in those seven games, he is hitting .357 (10-for-28) with two doubles, two walks, five runs scored, a .419 on-base percentage and an .848 OPS...additionally, in those seven games since June 30, his .419 on-base percentage is tied for 11th best in the AL.

DONNIE BARRELS: Since June 1, Donovan Solano has posted a .393 on-base percentage in 31 games, reaching 42 times in 107 plate appearances (25 hits, 15 walks, 2 HBP)...in 39 home games this season, he is hitting .318 (35-for-110) with 15 walks, a .409 on-base percentage and an .855 OPS...in 16 home games since June 1, he is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with a .443 on-base percentage and a .992 OPS.

◆ Solano's .372 OBP and 27 walks this season are both career highs.

FAST WILLI: Willi Castro stole another base last night giving him four in his last four games and 19 on the season...his 19 steals before the break are the most for a Twin since Eduardo Núñez swiped 22 in 2016...seven different Twins have reached 20 steals before the ASB (Rod Carew - 3x, Chuck Knoblauch - 4x, Cesar Tovar - 2x, Carlos Gómez - 1x, Larry Hisle - 1x, Eduardo Núñez - 1x and Willie Norwood - 1x), with Carew's 35 in 1976 being the record...Castro's 19 steals are tied for seventh most in the AL...he is on pace to steal 34 bases this season, which would mark the most for a Twin since Ben Revere stole 40 in 2012.

ALL-STAR SUMMER: Gray was selected as the Twins' representative for this year's MLB All-Star Game in Seattle...this is his third career All-Star selection, also making the American League team in 2015 with the Oakland Athletics and the National League team in 2019 with the Cincinnati Reds; did not make an appearance in either game...owns the 10th-lowest pre-All-Star Break ERA (2.50) in Twins' history (since 1961)...here is where he ranks in several categories among qualified AL pitchers this season:

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start in his last appearance on July 2 against Baltimore at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed just two hits, three walks and seven strikeouts in a 2-1 Twins' defeat, opposite Cole Irvin...allowed a season-low two hits, the fewest hits he has allowed since August 27, 2022 vs. San Francisco when he permitted just one hit...recorded 1-2-3 first and second innings before permitting a single to Anthony Bemboom in the third... recorded another 1-2-3 inning in the fourth...yielded his final hit to start the fifth inning, a double to Ramón Urías...relieved by Griffin Jax who pitched a scoreless seventh inning...Jhoan Duran entered in the eighth inning...Duran struck out the first batter he faced before allowing three-consecutive singles, including an RBI single to Aaron Hicks...issued a bases-loaded hit-by-pitch to Jordan Westburg for the final run of the game...replaced by Emilio Pagán who recorded the final out of the inning...the Twins' only run came from a Willi Castro RBI double in the fifth inning.

 ♠ Marked Gray's first scoreless outing since April 24 vs. New York-AL...the 11-game stretch of allowing one-or-more runs marked the sixth longest of his career and was the longest since a 13-game span from August 20, 2019-August 20, 2020 with Cincinnati.

 ♠ Gray has not earned a win in his last 11 starts, last earning a victory on April 30 vs. Kansas City;
- the 11-start streak without a win is tied for the second-longest such stretch of his career (also, September 1, 2020 to May 22, 2021).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his second loss of the season despite recording a quality start on June 26 against Atlanta at Truist Park...pitched 6.2 innings and allowed three runs on seven hits (1 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts in a 4-1 Twins' defeat, opposite Spencer Strider...tossed 102 pitches, his first time throwing over 100 pitches since May 23 vs. San Francisco when he threw 105 pitches...retired nine of the first 13 batters he faced, including a 1-2-3 first inning...yielded an RBI groundout to catcher Travis d'Arnaud after allowing two singles in the fourth inning...allowed his third home run of the season to designated hitter Marcell Ozuna to start the seventh...recorded the next two outs before permitting a single to Michael Harris and exiting the game, relieved the Filip Pacific when allowed a two run being out to Ronald Avelão Ir (1 Il and exiting the game...relieved by Emilio Pagán, who allowed a two-run home run to Ronald Acuña Jr. (1 ER charged to Gray)...Josh Winder later pitched a scoreless eighth inning...the Twins' only run came from a Joey Gallo home run in the second inning off Strider.

GOOD MORNING BALTIMORE: Gray is facing the Orioles for the 14th time in his career, going 6-5, 4.19 ERA (68.2 IP, 32 ER) with 26 walks and 72 strikeouts in his 13 previous starts...is 0-0, 2.45 ERA (11.0 IP, 3 ER) with six walks and 12 strikeouts in two starts against the Orioles since joining the Twins...is 2-2, 7.03 ERA (24.1 IP, 19 ER) with 11 walks and 24 strikeouts in five career home games vs. Baltimore.

BULLSEYE: Gray is making his 10th home start of the season; is 3-1, 2.29 ERA (51.0 IP, 13 ER) with 15 walks and 58 strikeouts in his nine prior home outings...is 7-3, 2.50 ERA (118.2 IP, 33 ER) with 40 walks and 136 strikeouts in 22 home starts since becoming a Twin...Twins are 13-9 in those starts.

◆ Currently holds the fourth-lowest home ERA in baseball this season (min. 50.0 IP)...also holds the sixth-lowest home ERA since the start of 2022 (min. 115.0 IP).

THE ARSENAL: Grav has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his 4-seam his asstall the most at 23.0 percent...recorded all seven strikeouts in his last start on July 2 at Baltimore off his sweeper...primarily uses his curveball (199 pitches) and changeup (101 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (191 pitches), sinker (231 pitches) and sweeper (219 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far-
