- ☞ Owns most strikeouts (295) and second-most wins (23) through a pitcher's first 49 career games in Twins history (since 1961).

LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his team-leading 12th quality start but did not factor into the decision on July 3 vs. Kansas City in the Twins' 8-4 win at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and nine strikeouts, one short of his season high (done 3 times)...allowed a leadoff home run in his second-straight start, as third baseman Maikel Garcia took him deep to start the game...allowed an RBI single to first baseman Nick Pratto in the third inning, then retired 10 of the final 13 batters he faced, striking out the side in the fourth and sixth innings...was relieved by Jovani Moran to start the seventh inning with Minnesota leading 3-2...Brent Headrick blew a save opportunity by allowing a solo homer to Pratto in the top of the eighth, but the Twins' offense scored five runs in the bottom of the eighth to win the series opener.

☞ Allowed a leadoff homer in back-to-back starts, after Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. hit a leadoff homer off him in his previous outing; marked the first time a Twins' pitcher has allowed a leadoff homer in consecutive starts since Kyle Gibson from July 22-28, 2016...Gibson will oppose Ryan in today's game.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on June 27 at Atlanta in the Twins' 6-2 defeat at Truist Park...pitched a career-low 3.0 innings, allowing six runs on a season-high nine hits (career-high-tying 5 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts...allowed three home runs and one triple in the first inning, yielding solo homers to rightfielder Ronald Acuña Jr. and catcher Sean Murphy and a two-run homer to third baseman Austin Riley; his four runs allowed in the first inning were the most he has allowed in the first in any start of his career...allowed back-to-back solo home runs to centerfielder Michael Harris II and Acuña Jr. in the second inning; marked the first time he has allowed back-to-back home runs in his career...pitched a scoreless third inning before being relieved by Oliver Ortega to start the fourth...Twins went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position and dropped the middle game of the three-game series.

☞ Tied his start on July 29, 2022 at San Diego for the most home runs he has allowed in his career...is one of three pitchers in Twins/Senators history (since 1961) to allow five home runs in a game (also, Carlos Silva on August 22, 2006 at Baltimore and Bert Blyleven on September 13, 1986 vs. Texas).

LEAGUE LEADER: Ryan enters today leading American League pitchers in several statistical categories...here are his numbers through 17 starts and how they rank among qualified AL pitchers:

GLASS HALF FULL: Through 17 starts this year, Ryan owns a 7.13 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the fourth-highest strikeout-to-walk ratio before the All-Star break among qualified pitchers in Twins history (since 1961)...also has a 0.98 WHIP, the sixth-best WHIP in club history before the All-Star break, and a 1.40 walks-per-9.0 innings ratio, tied for the 14th best among Twins pitchers prior to the break.

JOE VS. THE O'S: Facing Baltimore for the first time this season and third time in his career...in two previous starts against the Orioles, both in the 2022 season, Ryan went 0-0, 2.31 ERA (11.2 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts; Twins won both of his starts against Baltimore last season...most recently faced the Orioles on July 1, 2022 at Target Field, taking a no-decision in a 3-2 Minnesota win; pitched 7.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts...his only other start against Baltimore was on May 3, 2022 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, also taking a no-decision in the Twins' 7-2 victory (4.2 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K).

AL EAST BEAST: Ryan is undefeated in five starts against American League East division opponents this year, going 4-0 with five quality starts, a 2.06 ERA (35.0 IP, 8 ER), two walks, 33 strikeouts and a .197 (25-for-127) opponent batting average...the Twins have won each of his five starts against the AL East this year...in 10 career starts vs. the AL East, Ryan is 5-2, 3.06 ERA (61.2 IP, 21 ER) with nine walks and 61 strikeouts; Twins have gone 8-2 in those games.

HOME COOKING: In eight starts at Target Field this year, Ryan is 5-2 with a 2.73 ERA (52.2 IP, 16 ER), six walks, 60 strikeouts and a .193 (38-for-197) opponent batting average...Minnesota has gone 6-2 in his eight home starts, winning each of his last two outings at Target Field...his 0.84 WHIP at home this year is tied TEX's Jacob deGrom for the third lowest in the American League (min. 5 home GS), trailing only SEA's Bryce Miller (0.82) and BAL's Tyler Wells (0.82); also owns a 10.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio at home, third best in the AL among pitchers with at least five home starts...is 3-3, 4.14 ERA (50.0 IP, 23 ER) with 10 walks and 54 strikeouts in nine road starts this season; Twins have gone 4-5 in his road starts.

☞ Among pitchers with at least 10 career starts at Target Field, Ryan owns the lowest WHIP (0.96) and opponent batting average (.190), the third-lowest opponent OPS (.574), and the seventh-lowest ERA (3.23) since the park opened in 2010.

☞ Ryan is 12-7, 3.23 ERA (150.1 IP, 54 ER) with 39 walks and 165 strikeouts in 26 career home starts...is 11-7, 3.93 ERA (126.0 IP, 55 ER) with 29 walks and 130 strikeouts in 23 road starts.

THE ARSENAL: Ryan has utilized a four-pitch mix in his first 17 starts of the 2023 season...has leaned on his four-seam fastball and split finger, combining to throw the two pitches 86.4 percent of the time this year...threw 20 sweepers in his last start on June 3 vs. Kansas City, the second-most sweepers he has thrown in a start in 2023 (24 on April 8 vs. Houston); also recorded three strikeouts with his sweeper in his last outing, his highest strikeout total with the sweeper in a start this season...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

☞ Ryan's split finger has accumulated a run value of -8 this season, the second-best run value on a splitter in the majors according to Baseball Savant, trailing only TOR's Erik Swanson (-14)...also has a run value of -14 on his four-seam fastball, tied for the third-best run value on a four-seamer in baseball.

☞ His .220 opponent batting average against his four-seam fastball is the eighth-lowest batting average vs. a four-seamer in baseball (min. 150 plate appearances)...his .176 opponent batting average against his splitter is the ninth-lowest batting average against a splitter in baseball (min. 50 plate appearances).

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020.
- In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
- Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
- Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics...went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
- Acquired by the Twins on July 22, 2021 from the Tampa Bay Rays, alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz...learned about the trade while in Japan with Team USA.
- In 2020, was part of the Rays 60-man player pool and spent the summer at the alternate training site in Port Charlotte, Florida...ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 12 prospect in the Rays system following the season.
- In 2019, was named Rays minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 9-4, 1.96 ERA (123.2 IP, 27 ER) in his first full professional season...divided the year between Low-A Bowling Green (6 starts), High-A Charlotte (15 games, 13 starts) and Double-A Montgomery (3 starts).
- Garnered several other awards in 2019, including: MiLB.com organization All-Star honors, *Baseball America* High Class A All-Star, two-time Florida State League Pitcher of the Week (June 17-23 and August 5-11) and Rays minor league Pitcher of the Month for July and August.
- Made professional debut in 2018 for Short-A Hudson Valley...went 2-1, 3.72 ERA (36.1 IP, 15 ER) in 12 games (7 starts) for the Renegades, with 14 walks and 51 strikeouts.
- Selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Division II California State University, Stanislaus.
- Went 8-1, 1.65 ERA (98.1 IP, 18 ER) in 14 starts as a senior at Stanislaus and led all divisions of college baseball with 127 strikeouts...earned three selections to All-America teams...pitched three seasons at California State University, Northridge before transferring to Stanislaus.

LEFT/RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are batting just .197 (36-for-183) with a .526 OPS and 46 strikeouts against Ryan this year...his .526 opponent OPS against lefties is the fourth lowest in the American League this season (min. 10 GS)...right-handed hitters are hitting .240 (49-for-204) with a .703 OPS and 68 strikeouts...his .220 (85-for-387) overall opponent batting average in 2023 ranks sixth in the AL among qualified starters.

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting just .195 (97-for-497) with a .592 OPS against him...right-handed hitters are hitting .224 (119-for-531) with a .680 OPS off Ryan.
