THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their six-game, seven-day homestand, going 3-0 vs. Kansas City and 0-2 vs. Baltimore...this afternoon, the Iwins will complete the pre-ASG portion of their schedule with the three-game series finale against the Orioles...the Iwins have gone 26-21 at home and 19-24 on the road.

◆ After the All-Star break, the Twins will go on a seven-game roadtrip with three against Oakland from July 14-16 and four against Seattle from July 17-20.

**SATURDAY'S ARE FOR THE 0's:** The Twins lost to the Orioles yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6-2...Sonny Gray (4-3) was the starter and loser, allowing a season-high six runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched...all six runs allowed scored in the top of the second inning on six singles and two walks...it tied his career-high for most runs allowed in a single inning...Sonny retired 13 of the final 14 batters he faced...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Donovan Solano, who matched his career high with three doubles and recorded one RBI.

TWINS AND 0's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the sixth and final time in 2023...the Twins are 2-3 vs. Baltimore this season, going 2-1 at Camden last weekend followed by consecutive losses this weekend at Target Field...a win today and the Twins will avoid losing the season series to the Orioles to the first time since going 1-5 in 2016.

♣ The Twins are 38-20 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

♣ Byron Buxton has an .851 OPS in his last 11 games vs. Baltimore, with four home runs and 10 RBI in that span.

♣ Max Kepler is hitting .330 (35-for-106) with seven doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 24 RBI. 14 walks, a .405 OBP and a 1.103 OPS in 30 career games against Baltimore.

♣ Michael A. Taylor is hitting .305 (36-for-118) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI. 12 walks, a .371 on-base percentage and an .803 OPS in 39 career games against the 0's.

**DONNIE DOUBLES:** Donovan Solano hit three doubles last night, the 17th, 18th and 19th of his season...the 17th tied his single-season career high, done with San Francisco in 2021, while the 18th set a career high in the fourth inning...since June 1, Donovan Solano has posted a 405 on-base percentage in 32 games, reaching 45 times in 111 plate appearances (28 hits, 15 walks, 2 HBP)...through five games on the homestand, he is hitting .500 (9-for-18) with a 1.526 OPS, hitting safely in all five, including a pair of three-hit games.

LEAVE THE BROOMS ALONE: Twins are looking to avoid being swept today for the third time this season, the other two sweeps came in three games at Tropicana Field from June 6-8 against the Rays and three games at Truist Park from June 26-28 against the Braves...the last time the Twins were swept at Target Field was by the Guardians in three games from September 9-11, 2022.

◆ The last time the Twins were swept by the Orioles was April 4-7, 2016 at Camden Yards...
the last time the Twins were swept by the Orioles in Minnesota was in four games from August 22-25, 2011.

◆ Minnesota has faced a potential sweep five times this season, salvaging the series finale three of five times...the three times they avoided a sweep were April 21-23 vs. Washington, May 2-4 at Chicago-AL and May 22-24 vs. San Francisco.

**FIRE FEST:** The SiriusXM Futures Game was played at T-Mobile Park in Seattle last night as the Twins lone representative David Festa, the Twins lone representative and number eight prospect per MLB.com, pitched a scoreless fifth inning, inducing a lineout, allowing a single, then getting a popout and strikeout.

**FEELING A DRAFT:** The Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft will take place tonight, starting at 6 pm (CT)...the Twins will select at fifth overall (1st round), 34th overall (Competitive Balance Round A) and 49th overall (2nd round) this evening...in the 2022 draft, the Twins selected infielder Brooks Lee (8th overall), Connor Prielipp (48th overall) and Tanner Schobel (68th overall) on day one.

TWINS ML WEEKLYS: Dominican Summer League infielder Dameury Peña and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher C.J. Culpepper have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

♣ Peña, 17, played in four games, hitting .429 (6-for-14) with three doubles, one triple, two RBI, three runs scored, one walk, no strikeouts and a 1.252 OPS...the Bonao, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January.

♣ Culpepper, 21, made two starts for the Kernels, going 1-0, 0,00 ERA (11.0 IP) with one walk and eight strikeouts...the Upland, California native was selected by the Iwins in the 13th round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of California Baptist University.

LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his team-leading 12th quality start but did not factor into the decision on July 3 vs. Kansas City in the Twins' 8-4 win at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and nine strikeouts, one short of his season high (done 3 times)... allowed a leadoff home run in his second-straight start, as third baseman Maikel Garcia took him deep to start the game...allowed an RBI single to first baseman Nick Pratto in the third inning, then retired 10 of the final 13 batters he faced, striking out the side in the fourth and sixth innings... was relieved by Jovani Moran to start the seventh inning with Minnesota leading 3-2...Brent Headrick blew a save opportunity by allowing a solo homer to Pratto in the top of the eighth, but the Twins' offense scored five runs in the bottom of the eighth to win the series opener.

₹ Allowed a leadoff homer in back-to-back starts, after Atlanta's Ronald Acuña Jr. hit a leadoff homer off him in his previous outing; marked the first time a Twins' pitcher has allowed a leadoff homer in consecutive starts since Kyle Gibson from July 22-28, 2016...Gibson will oppose Ryan in today's game.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss on June 27 at Atlanta in the Twins' 6-2 defeat at Truist Park...pitched a career-low 3.0 innings, allowing six runs on a season-high nine hits (career-high-tying 5 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts...allowed three home runs and one triple in the first inning, yielding solo homers to rightfielder Ronald Acuña Jr. and catcher Sean Murphy and a two-run homer to third baseman Austin Riley; his four runs allowed in the first inning were the most he has allowed in the first in any start of his career...allowed back-to-back solo home runs to centerfielder Michael Harris II and Acuña Jr. in the second inning; marked the first time he has allowed back-to-back home runs in his career...pitched a scoreless third inning before being relieved by Oliver Ortega to start the fourth...Twins went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position and dropped the middle game of the three-game series.

© Tied his start on July 29, 2022 at San Diego for the most home runs he has allowed in his career...is one of three pitchers in Twins/Senators history (since 1961) to allow five home runs in a game (also, Carlos Silva on August 22, 2006 at Baltimore and Bert Blyleven on September 13, 1986 vs. Texas).

**GLASS HALF FULL:** Through 17 starts this year, Ryan owns a 7.13 strikeout-to-walk ratio, the fourth-highest strikeout-to-walk ratio before the All-Star break among qualified pitchers in Twins history (since 1961)...also has a 0.98 WHIP, the sixth-best WHIP in club history before the All-Star break, and a 1.40 walks-per-9.0 innings ratio, tied for the 14th best among Twins pitchers prior to the break.

**JOE VS. THE 0'S:** Facing Baltimore for the first time this season and third time in his career...in two previous starts against the Orioles, both in the 2022 season, Ryan went 0-0, 2.31 ERA (11.2 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts; Twins won both of his starts against Baltimore last season...most recently faced the Orioles on July 1, 2022 at Target Field, taking a no-decision in a 3-2 Minnesota win; pitched 7.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts..his only other start against Baltimore was on May 3, 2022 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, also taking a no-decision in the Twins' 7-2 victory (4.2 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 3 K).

AL EAST BEAST: Ryan is undefeated in five starts against American League East division opponents this year, going 4-0 with five quality starts, a 2.06 ERA (35.0 IP, 8 ER), two walks, 33 strikeouts and a .197 (25-for-127) opponent batting average...the Twins have won each of his five starts against the AL East this year...in 10 career starts vs. the AL East, Ryan is 5-2, 3.06 ERA (61.2 IP, 21 ER) with nine walks and 61 strikeouts; Twins have gone 8-2 in those games.

HOME COOKING: In eight starts at Target Field this year, Ryan is 5-2 with a 2.73 ERA (52.2 IP, 16 ER), six walks, 60 strikeouts and a .193 (38-for-197) opponent batting average. Minnesota has gone 6-2 in his eight home starts, winning each of his last two outings at Target Field. his 0.84 WHIP at home this year is tied TEX's Jacob deGrom for the third lowest in the American League (min. 5 home GS), trailing only SEA's Bryce Miller (0.82) and BAL's Tyler Wells (0.82); also owns a 10.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio at home, third best in the AL among pitchers with at least five home starts... is 3-3, 4.14 ERA (50.0 IP, 23 ER) with 10 walks and 54 strikeouts in nine road starts this season; Twins have gone 4-5 in his road starts.

Among pitchers with at least 10 career starts at Target Field, Ryan owns the lowest WHIP (0.96) and opponent batting average (.190), the third-lowest opponent OPS (.574), and the seventh-lowest ERA (3.23) since the park opened in 2010.

Ryan is 12-7, 3.23 ERA (150.1 IP, 54 ER) with 39 walks and 165 strikeouts in 26 career home starts... is 11-7, 3.93 ERA (126.0 IP, 55 ER) with 29 walks and 130 strikeouts in 23 road starts.

### **CAREER NOTES**

2023 marks his sixth professional season, including 2020. In 2022, his first full major-league season, was Twins Opening Day starter and led both the club and all AL rookies in wins (13), innings pitched (147.0) and strikeouts (151).
