LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his 50th career quality start and earned the win on August 5 vs. Arizona in the Twins' $12-1$ victory at Target Field...allowed one run on two hits ( 1 HR ) in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...struck out Geraldo Perdomo to lead off the game, recording his 900 th career strikeout....stranded Corbin Carroll on second base in the top of the first inning by striking out Christian Walker to end the inning...allowed a solo home run to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. and a
bunt single to Jace Peterson in the top of the second then retired the final 14 batters he faced relieved by Jordan Balazovic to start the top of the seventh with Minnesota leading 10-1. - Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow. - Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner)
Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's. - Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
