THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their seven-game roadtrip, winning game one on Monday night in Detroit, followed by consecutive losses at Comerica Park Tuesday and Wednesday...today, the Twins will play the four-game series finale and their final game in the Motor City in 2023...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Philadelphia for three games against the Phillies over the weekend...the Twins have gone 33-24 at home and 27-32 on the road.

◆ The Twins are 15-10 since the All-Star break, tied for seventh-most wins in baseball in that span.

◆ The Twins have gone 17-15-4 in series play this season, including a 7-9-2 record on the road...they are 6-3-1 in series play on the road since May 29.

TIGERS SCORE ALL NIGHT ON TWINS: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 9-5...Bailey Ober (6-6) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs (4 earned) on 11 hits (tied career high) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and a season high nine strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits and walked five times...Joey Gallo hit his 18th home run, tying Max Kepler for team lead, while Carlos Correa hit his 14th home run.

MOTOR CITY MATCHUP: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 11th of 13 meetings in 2023... the Twins have gone 4-6 vs. Detroit this season, going 1-3 at Target Field and 3-3 at Comerica Park...these two will wrap up the season series with a two-game series at Target Field next Tuesday and Wednesday.

♣ A win today and the Twins can finish their season 4-3 at Comerica Park, which would mark their first winning season in Detroit since going 8-2 in 2019 (4-6 in 2022, 4-5 in 2021 and 0-3 in 2020).

♣ The Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 113, 22 ahead of Chicago-AL (91)...49 of those have come at Comerica Park, also most among opponents.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .315 (28-for-89) with six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and a 922 OPS in his last 22 games vs. the Tigers...in his last 17 games at Comerica Park, he is hitting .357 (25-for-70) with two doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 12 runs scored, a .395 on-base percentage and a 1.109 OPS in that span.

♣ Jorge Polanco has hit safely in eight-straight games vs. the Tigers...he is a career .295 (117-for-397) hitter with 23 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 55 RBI, 32 walks, 53 runs scored and an .811 OPS in 102 games against the Tigers...in 53 career games at Comerica, he is hitting .301 (62-for-206) with 12 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 21 RBI, 29 runs scored and an .813 OPS.

DIVISION SIGNS: The Twins have gone 22-17 against the AL Central this season, going 3-4 vs. the Guardians, 9-4 vs. the Royals, 6-3 vs. the White Sox and 4-6 vs. the Tigers...the Iwins 4.5 game lead on the Guardians is the largest division lead among the AL divisions and third best in baseball (Atlanta - 10.5+ in NL East and Los Angeles-NL - 6.0+ in NL West)...below are the Twins pitching numbers compared to other AL divisions/NL:

ALSO: After today's game, 12 of the next 14 games for Minnesota are outside of the division...the Twins have nine more game against AL Central opponents...they host Detroit for two games August 15-16, travel to Cleveland for three September 4-6 and four at Chicago September 14-17.

MAXIN' OUT: Max Kepler has hit safely in five-straight games, one short of his season high of six, done from July 14-19...his career high is 10, done twice in 2019...in his last 24 games, since July 14, Kepler is hitting .307 (27-for-88) with six doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, 18 runs scored, five walks, a .347 on-base percentage, a .580 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS.

◆ Kepler has an RBI in five-straight games, one shy of his career-best streak of six, done twice (2016 and 2019).

TOP JEFF: Last night's second-inning double extended Ryan Jeffers' hitting streak to 14 games with a plate appearance (career best)...it marks the longest streak by a Twin this season and longest since Jorge Polanco's 14-game hitting streak from May 27-June 13, 2019...the last Twin with a streak longer than 15 games was Brian Dozier, who hit safely in 24-straight from September 22, 2017-April 23, 2018...the last 15-plus game streak in a single season was Eddie Rosario, who hit safely in 15-straight from April 17-May 5, 2017.

During the current streak, Jeffers is hitting 388 (19-for-49) with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, seven walks, a .474 on-base percentage, a .755 slugging percentage and a 1290 OPS.

MIC DROPS: Detroit related notes on Bally Sports North pregame analyst Trevor Plouffe and in-game color analyst Glen Perkins:

♣ Plouffe drove in 40 runs in 81 career games against the Tigers, his second most vs. any opponent (Chicago-AL - 48)...Plouffe started his first career game in leftfield at Comerica Park on August 15, 2011, playing all nine innings there, making two putouts in two total chances.

♣ Perkins struck out 62 Tigers in his career, his most vs. any opponent...the Tiger he struck out the most was Miguel Cabrera (8)...Perk earned his second career win at Comerica Park on May 25, 2008, allowing one run on seven hits in 7.2 innings pitched, opposite Justin Verlander...Miguel Cabera went 0-for-4 in that game with two strikeouts (1 by Perk).

LEAGUE LEADER LATELY: Since being returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) on June 23, Maeda is 3-2 with a 2.47 ERA (43.2 IP, 12 ER), 13 walks, 58 strikeouts and a .195 (30-for-154) opponent batting average in eight starts...here's how his numbers rank among American League pitchers since June 23 (min. 8 GS):

LAST TIME OUT: Recorded his 50th career quality start and earned the win on August 5 vs. Arizona in the Twins' 12-1 victory at Target Field...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...struck out Geraldo Perdomo to lead off the game, recording his 900th career strikeout...stranded Corbin Carroll on second base in the top of the first inning by striking out Christian Walker to end the inning...allowed a solo home run to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. and a bunt single to Jace Peterson in the top of the second, then retired the final 14 batters he faced...was relieved by Jordan Balazovic to start the top of the seventh with Minnesota leading 10-1; Balazovic (2.0 IP) and Jovani Moran (1.0 IP) held the Diamondbacks scoreless as the Twins offense produced 12 runs on 17 hits to win the game and claim the series victory.

© Recorded his fourth quality start in his last six outings after failing to record a quality start in his first six starts of 2023.

© Allowed only two hits, his fewest in a start of 6.0-or-more innings since July 4, 2021 at Kansas City (also 6.0 IP, 2 H).

© Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last eight starts, tied with TB's Jalen Beeks and CWS's Mike Clevinger for the fourth-longest active streak among American League starters...Maeda's current streak is his second longest as a Twin (14-start streak allowing 3-or-fewer runs from July 26, 2020 to April 14, 2021).

TWO STARTS AGO: Suffered the loss on July 30 at Kansas City in the Twins' 2-1 defeat at Kauffman Stadium...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts...retired the first five batters he faced before allowing a solo home run to Freddy Fermin in the second inning...allowed one run on two hits, including an RBI double by Maikel Garcia, in the bottom of the third...escaped a bases-loaded, two-out jam by inducing an inning-ending flyout from Nicky Lopez to end the fourth inning...retired the side in order with two strikeouts in the fifth inning... was relieved by Dylan Floro to begin the sixth inning; Minnesota's bullpen fired 3.0 scoreless innings, but the Twins' offense scored just one run on seven hits to drop the series finale.

KING OF THE K: Maeda has struck out six-or-more batters in six-consecutive starts, tied with PHI's Aaron Nola for the fourth-longest active streak in baseball...has struck out 10.86 batters-per-9.0 innings this season, the seventh-highest strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ratio in the American League (min. 12 GS)...has struck out 30 percent of the batters he has faced in 2023, tied for the 10th-best strikeout rate in baseball among starters with at least 44.0 IP (*Inside Edge*).

CRUISING INTO THE MOTOR CITY: Facing Detroit for the second time this year and 10th time in his career...is 3-2, 3.33 ERA (51.1 IP, 19 ER) with five quality starts, nine walks, 66 strikeouts, a .196 (36-for-184) opponent batting average and a 0.88 WHIP in nine career starts vs. the Tigers...his 0.88 WHIP against Detroit is the third lowest against any opponent in his career (min. 5 GS), trailing only his 0.83 WHIP vs. Miami (6 G/5 GS) and his 0.87 WHIP against Cleveland (5 GS)..earned the win in his last start vs. the Tigers on June 23 at Comerica Park, a 4-1 Twins' victory; fired 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits, issuing two walks and striking out eight batters in his return from the 15-day Injured List.

© Twins are 5-2 in his last seven starts against Detroit, since September 5, 2020.

CENTRAL COMMAND: Maeda is 2-2, 2.74 ERA (23.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 27 strikeouts in four starts against American League Central opponents this year...lost to Chicago-AL on April 10, earned wins on June 23 at Detroit and on July 4 vs. Kansas City, and lost on July 30 at Kansas City... in 25 career starts against the AL Central, Maeda is 12-6, 3.31 ERA (138.2 IP, 51 ER) with 31 walks and 157 strikeouts...his 3.31 ERA vs. the AL Central is the second lowest against any division in his career (3.07 ERA vs. National League East).

8 MILE ROAD: Making his eighth road start of 2023 today...is 1-4, 3.16 ERA (31.1 IP, 11 ER) with 11 walks and 43 strikeouts in seven road starts this season...has received only 11 runs of support on the road this year, tied for the third fewest in baseball (min. 7 road GS), only ahead of DET's Joey Wentz (7) and SF's Ross Stripling (9)...is 2-2, 5.40 ERA (28.1 IP, 17 ER) with five walks and 29 strikeouts in five home starts in 2023.

♣ In five career road starts against Detroit, Maeda is 2-2, 3.86 ERA (28.0 IP, 12 ER) with four walks and 37 strikeouts, pitching at least 5.0 innings in all five starts.

♣ Is 27-26, 4.60 ERA (419.0 IP, 214 ER) with 135 walks and 462 strikeouts in 97 career road appearances (81 starts)...in 84 career home appearances (66 starts), he is 35-21, 3.17 ERA (402.2 IP, 142 ER) with 101 walks and 444 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, throwing his slider and split finger the most; he utilizes the pair a combined 66.6 percent of the time...favors his split finger (182/298 - 61.1%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (226/336 - 67.3%) and sinker (55/55 - 100%) against righties...has allowed one home run off his split finger in back-to-back starts (Freddy Fermin - July 30 at Kansas City; Lourdes Gurriel Jr. - August 5 vs. Arizona)...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:
