THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 2-4 through six games on their current seven-game roadtrip, going 1-3 in Detroit, followed by a split of the first two games in Philadelphia...today, the Twins will wrap the series and roadtrip with the three-game series final at Citizens Bank Park...after today's game, Minnesota will travel back home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow before beginning a six-game, seven-day homestand...the Twins will host the Tigers for two games on Tuesday and Wednesday, spent another off-day on Thursday, then play three against the Pirates next weekend...the Twins have gone 33-24 at home and 28-34 on the road.

Starting tomorrow, Minnesota has three off-days in the next eight days (tomorrow, Thursday and next Monday).

Since the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 16-12, fifth-most wins in the AL.

JOEY GALLO NIGHT IN PHILADELPHIA: The Twins beat the Phillies last night at Citizens Bank Park by a score of 8-1...Pablo Lopez (8-6) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded 11 hits and walked seven times — six of which came off Phillies starter Taijuan Walker, their most against a starter since drawing six against Shohei Ohtani on September 23, 2022...Joey Gallo tied his single-game career highs in hits (4) and times on base (5), recording his 17th multi-homer game, while tying his season high with four RBI...Matt Wallner (8) and Carlos Correa (15) also added homers, as Correa reached three times (2 hits, 1 walk).

SERIES STUFF: The Twins are seeking their 18th series victory this season...they are 17-16-4 in series play in 2023, going 10-6-2 at home and 7-10-2 on the road.

Entering today, the Twins have gone 7-5-1 in their last 13 series, dating back to their June 23-25 series at Detroit.

The Twins are looking to win their third-straight series against an NL opponent and fourth in their last five tries (2-0 vs. MIL — 6/13-14, 0-3 at ATL — 6/26-28, 2-1 at STL — 8/1-3, 3-0 vs. ARI — 8/4-6).

TWINS AND PHILS: The Twins are playing the Phillies for the 24th time in their history today...they are 12-11 all-time against Philadelphia, going 2-1 at Veterans Stadium in 2002, 1-2 at the Metrodome in 2004, 5-4 at Target Field in 2012, '13 and '16, and 4-4 at Citizens Bank Park in 2010, '19 and '23.

These two teams will meet next in 2024 for a three-game series at Target Field from July 22-24.

Max Kepler has hit safely in all eight career games against the Phillies, hitting .375 (12-for-32) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, an .813 slugging percentage and a 1.213 OPS.

Jorge Polanco has nine hits in 19 career at-bats (.474) against the Phillies (all in Philly), with one double, one triple, two home runs and a 1.447 OPS.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins have gone 16-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona and 1-1 at Philadelphia...the Twins have gone 5-1 in their last six in IL Play and 9-5 in their last 14.

After this series, Minnesota's remaining 2023 IL schedule includes Target Field visits from the Pirates (August 18-20) and Mets (September 8-10)...the Twins will also play road games at Brewers (August 22-23), Reds (September 18-20) and Rockies (September 29-October 1).

Max Kepler has six home runs against NL opponents this season...he has 21 career IL home runs, tied with Justin Morneau for fourth most in club history, trailing Torii Hunter (33), Eddie Rosario (23) and Joe Mauer (22).

Gallo's eight IL homers this season are tied for eighth most among American League hitters.

LOVE FOR LEFTIES LATELY: The Twins have faced seven left-handed starters since the All-Star break, going 4-3 in those games...they are 13-14 on the season when facing a lefty starter...below is a comparison of offensive numbers vs. lefties pre-All-Star break and after:

In their last eight games vs. left-handed pitching, the Twins have an OPS of .905 (.343 OBP/.563 SLG) with 10 home runs.

Carlos Correa is hitting .424 (14-for-33) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .486 on-base percentage, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.214 OPS in his last 17 games vs. left-handed pitching.

US AND THEM: Twins starters have combined to go 35-38, 3.86 ERA (668.2 IP, 287 ER) with 167 walks, 732 strikeouts and a .241 opponent batting average...below are other Twins starting pitching ranks among the MLB teams:

C4, IGNITING: Carlos Correa has hit safely in a season-high eight-straight games, his longest since September 18-27, 2022 (also 8)...it is tied for the fifth-longest active streak in the AL...his career high is 16, done in 2019 with Houston...a hit today would tie Edouard Julien for third-longest streak for a Twin this season (Jeffers — 14 and Solano — 11).

During the current streak, he is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.229 OPS.

From August 13, 2022 to the end of the 2022 season, Correa hit .340 (64-for-188) with a .957 OPS in his final 49 games.

JEFF YEA: Since the All-Star break, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, nine walks, a .443 on-base percentage, a .644 slugging percentage and a 1.087 OPS...since the break, he ranks tied for seventh in the AL in batting average, fifth in on-base percentage, ninth in OPS and 10th in slugging percentage.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Low-A Fort Myers infielder Danny De Andrade and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

De Andrade, 19, hit .462 (6-for-13) with two doubles, one home run, six RBI, one walk, six runs scored and a 1.380 OPS for the Mighty Mussels...the Valencia, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in December of 2022.

Varland, 25, made the start on Friday night vs. Louisville, pitching 7.1 shutout innings with three hits allowed, one walk and six strikeouts in the Saints' 5-0 victory over the Bats.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his fifth loss of the season in his last start on August 8 at Detroit...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs (2 earned) on seven hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts in a 6-0 Twins' defeat...marked the second time this season Gray has reached double-digit strikeouts (season-high 13 on April 7 vs. Houston)...in the first inning Riley Greene scored on a throwing error by Jorge Polanco after a groundball by Miguel Cabrera (the run was unearned)...retired seven of the next 10 batters he faced before allowing back-to-back RBI singles to Javier Báez and Zach McKinstry in the fourth inning...pitched a scoreless fifth inning and a 1-2-3 sixth to end his outing...relieved by Josh Winder in the seventh inning who permitted a solo home run to Jake Rogers...Winder also yielded a two-run single to Zack Short in the eighth inning.

- ☞ Extended his quality start streak to four games...is 1-1 with a 3.24 ERA (25.0 IP, 9 ER), one walk and 27 strikeouts in those games.
- ☞ Has not issued a walk in three-consecutive starts, tying his career high (also May 29-June 22, 2022).

TWO STARTS AGO: Snapped his career-high 15-game winless streak in his last start on August 3 at St. Louis...pitched a season-high-tying 7.0 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and eight strikeouts in a 5-3 Twins' victory...tossed a 1-2-3 first inning...yielded an RBI double to Dylan Carlson in the second inning...retired 13 of the next 15 batters he faced before allowing a solo home run to Alec Burleson in the sixth inning...pitched a 1-2-3 seventh to finish his outing...relieved by Griffin Jax, who pitched a scoreless eighth inning...Joan Duran replaced Jax and allowed an RBI groundout to Carlson in the ninth inning.

- ☞ In his 15-game winless streak, dating back to May 6 at Cleveland, Gray went on a career-high-tying four-game losing streak, with a 4.26 ERA (82.1 IP, 39 ER), 32 walks and 74 strikeouts.

ANYBODY WANT A CHEESESTEAK?: Gray is looking for his first win against Philadelphia after going 0-1, 4.29 ERA (21.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 20 strikeouts in his four previous career starts...Phillies are one of two teams he's made at least four career starts against and never defeated (also, Atlanta, 0-3 in 6 career starts)...last faced the Phillies on August 15, 2021 at Citizens Bank Park, when he did not factor into the 7-4 Cincinnati Reds' victory after pitching 4.2 innings and allowing three runs on four hits, with three walks and a season-low two strikeouts...just one of his four career starts against the Phillies has been quality, a no-decision on September 5, 2019 with Cincinnati at Great American Ball Park (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 7 K)...owns no record and a 5.23 ERA (10.1 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and five strikeouts in two career starts at Citizens Bank Park.

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: Making his sixth Interleague start of the season (May 12 vs. Chicago-NL, May 17 at Los Angeles-NL, May 23 vs. San Francisco, June 26 at Atlanta and August 3 at St. Louis)...is 1-1, 3.21 ERA (28.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks and 32 strikeouts in his previous five starts, earning the win in St. Louis and taking the loss in Atlanta...is 2-1, 3.16 ERA (42.2 IP, 15 ER) with 14 walks and 46 strikeouts in eight Interleague starts since joining the Twins.

- ☞ Making his 26th career start against the National League and second since becoming a Twin (June 26 at Atlanta)...is 8-5, 3.45 ERA (143.2 IP, 55 ER) with 48 walks and 137 strikeouts in his previous 25 starts against the NL East...owns the second-lowest opponent batting average vs. the NL East (.214) since 2014 (min. 25 GS), trailing only Clayton Kershaw (.211)...also owns the fifth-lowest OPS (.613), trailing Kershaw (.562), Jacob DeGrom (.584), Zack Greinke (.607) and Hyun-Jin Ryu (.609).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his 4-seam fastball the most at 24.7 percent...recorded eight of his 10 strikeouts using his sweeper in his last start on August 8 at Detroit, his second-most effective put away pitch at 27.1 percent (trailing his cutter at 28.1%)...primarily uses his curveball (262 pitches) and changeup (133 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (231 pitches), sinker (295 pitches) and sweeper (293 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

- Acquired by Minnesota on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.
- Has made eight Opening Day rosters with the Athletics (2014-2016), Yankees (2018), Reds (2019-2020) and Twins (2022-2023).
- Named to American League All-Star team in 2015 for Oakland and the National League squad in 2019 for Cincinnati (did not pitch in either).
- 2019 recipient of the Johnny Vander Meer Award as the Reds' Most Outstanding Pitcher and finished second to Atlanta's Josh Donaldson in voting for the MLBPA's National League Comeback Player of the Year Award.
- Named to *Baseball America's* 2019 major league All-Star second team...named American League Pitcher of the Month for April in 2014...in 2013 was the Athletics' Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a *Baseball America* Triple-A All-Star.
