FEDORAS ON AND DICE IN THEIR POCKET: The Twins completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 1-3 at Detroit last week, followed by a 2-1 series win in Philadelphia over the weekend...

SONNY GRAY'S THE MOST POPULAR GUY HERE NOW!: The Twins shut out the Phillies on Sunday afternoon at Citizens Bank Park by a score of 3-0. Sonny Gray (6-5) was the starter and winner, allowing two hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 shutout innings...

ROYCE ZIP LINING IN FROM ST. PAUL: The Twins have returned infielder Royce Lewis from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List. Lewis, who missed the Twins' last 36 games with a left oblique strain, played in four games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 5-for-12 (41%) with two home runs and three walks...

COMPLICATED PATTERNS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 12th of 13 meetings in 2023...the Twins have gone 4-7 vs. Detroit this season, going 1-3 at Target Field and 3-4 at Comerica Park...

HE'S REAL, HE LIVES WITH US ON EARTH: Sunday afternoon's victory in Philadelphia marked Rocco Baldelli's 350th career managerial win...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

SLICKED BACK HAIR: Twins starters have struck out an MLB-best 739 batters and are on pace to strike out 997 hitters this season, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967...in fact, 997 would land them eighth on baseball's all-time list, behind the 2018 Astros (1,011), 2017 Guardians (1,066), 2018 Guardians (1,066), 2019 Astros (1,063), 2017 Nationals (1,012), 2019 Nationals (1,010) and 2017 Red Sox (1,001).

BABY OF THE YEAR: On the season, Edouard Julien ranks in the top five among AL rookies in several offensive categories (minimum of 225 plate appearances):

TC SLUGGERS: The Twins have hit 49 home runs since the All-Star break, the most in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (60)...on the season, they have homered 164 times, fourth most in the AL and seventh most in baseball...Max Kepler and Matt Wallner are Minnesota's co-leaders in homers since the break, with seven each.

DRIVING CORR-ONER: Carlos Correa has hit safely in a season-high eight-straight games, his longest since September 18-27, 2022 (also 8)...it is tied for the third-longest active streak in the AL...his career high is 16, done in 2019 with Houston...a hit today would tie Edouard Julien for third-longest streak for a Twin this season (Jeffers — 14 and Solano — 11).

DOUBLES OF THE BARRACUDA AND THE ROADRUNNER: The Twins enter today with 199 doubles...the team leader in doubles is Carlos Correa, with 25, one more than his 2022 total...finally, Joey Gallo enters today needing two doubles to reach 100 for his career, sitting at 98.

D(UR)AN FLASHES: Jhoan Duran recorded his 21st save on Sunday afternoon at Philadelphia, giving him nine saves in his last 10 chances...on the season, Duran has posted a 12.02 K/9.0 IP ratio, a 2.76 ERA and a .210 opponent batting average...he is one of six pitchers in baseball with a minimum of 12.00 K/9.0 IP, 20 saves, a BAA under .210 and an ERA less than 3.00, the others being Alexis Diaz, Camilo Doval, Felix Bautista, Devin Williams and Josh Hader...additionally, Duran has thrown 269 pitches at 101+ mph this season, the most in baseball.

55 GAMES, 55 RBI, 995 GAMES...: Carlos Correa needs five games played to reach 1,000 career games, sitting at 995. In Correa's final 55 games of the 2022 season, he hit .329 (69-for-210) with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 27 RBI and a .916 OPS. Correa leads the team with 54 RBI this season, including nine RBI in his last eight games.

YOUR FIRST THOUGHT IS GREAT, I DON'T HAVE TO GO TO WORK TOMORROW: The Twins have gone 6-8 following an off-day in 2023...Minnesota has six more off-days the rest of the way, with 42 left to play...they have two off-days in the next seven days (Thursday and Monday).

I LOVE THIS STUFF, I LOVE OLD STUFF!: On this day in 2011, Jim Thome hit two home runs in a 9-6 win at Detroit to become the eighth player to reach 600 home runs; Thome hit a two-run homer off Rick Porcello in the sixth for number 599, then a three-run shot against Daniel Schlereth in the seventh.

CELEBRATING AT TRUFFONI'S TONIGHT: Former manager Tom Kelly is celebrating his 73rd birthday today...Kelly is the Twins all-time managerial wins leader (1,140)...on his birthday, Kelly held a managerial record of 7-6.
