FEDORAS ON AND DICE IN THEIR POCKET: The Twins completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4, going 1-3 at Detroit last week, followed by a 2-1 series win in Philadelphia over the weekend...tonight, the Twins will begin a five-game, six-day homestand with the first of two against the Tigers...they will complete the series tomorrow afternoon, enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play the Pirates for three games over the weekend...the Twins have gone 33-24 at home and 29-34 on the road...12 of the final 14 August games will be at Target Field.

SONNY GRAY'S THE MOST POPULAR GUY HERE NOW!: The Twins shut out the Phillies on Sunday afternoon at Citizens Bank Park by a score of 3-0...Sonny Gray (6-5) was the starter and winner, allowing two hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 6.0 shutout innings... Griffin Jax (17), Caleb Thielbar (8) and Emilio Pagán (6) each earned a hold, while Jhoan Duran earned his 21st save...the offense recorded 10 hits, three from Donovan Solano (all singles)... the top five in the batting order (Solano, Jorge Polanco, Jordan Luplow, Ryan Jeffers and Christian Vázquez) combined to go 9-for-22... Polanco drove in two of the club's three runs while Luplow drove in the other with his first home run of the season.

ROYCE ZIP LINING IN FROM ST. PAUL: The Twins have returned infielder Royce Lewis from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Lewis, who missed the Twins' last 36 games with a left oblique strain, played in four games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, going 5-for-12 (.417) with two home runs and three walks...to make room for Lewis on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed utility player Willi Castro on the 10-day IL with a mild left oblique strain.

COMPLICATED PATTERNS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 12th of 13 meetings in 2023...the Iwins have gone 4-7 vs. Detroit this season, going 1-3 at Target Field and 3-4 at Comerica Park. The Iwins lost their last series with Detroit at Comerica Park, dropping three of four games from August 7-10

The Iwins have gone 34-15 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season... in fact, in that time frame, the Iwins only lost two home series' to the Tigers, holding a 12-2-1 series record in that span.

Carlos Correa is hitting .312 (29-for-93) with six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and a 904 OPS in his last 23 games vs. the Tigers.

SLICKED BACK HAIR: Twins starters have struck out an MLB-best 739 batters and are on pace to strike out 997 hitters this season, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967...in fact, 997 would land them eighth on baseball's all-time list, behind the 2018 Astros (1,101), 2017 Guardians (1,066), 2018 Guardians (1,066), 2019 Astros (1,063), 2017 Nationals (1,012), 2019 Nationals (1,010) and 2017 Red Sox (1,001).

◆ Their 739 strikeouts already rank as the ninth most in club history...next is the 1966 staff that had 742 (chart lower right).

TC SLUGGERS: The Twins have hit 49 home runs since the All-Star break, the most in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (60)...on the season, they have homered 164 times, fourth most in the AL and seventh most in baseball...Max Kepler and Matt Wallner are Minnesota's co-leaders in homers since the break, with seven each.

DRIVING CORR-OONER: Carlos Correa has hit safely in a season-high eight-straight games, his longest since September 18-27, 2022 (also 8)...it is tied for the third-longest active streak in the AL...his career high is 16, done in 2019 with Houston...a hit today would tie Edouard Julien for third-longest streak for a Twin this season (Jeffers — 14 and Solano — 11).

♣ During the current streak, he is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.229 OPS.

DOUBLES OF THE BARRACUDA AND THE ROADRUNNER: The Twins enter today with 199 doubles...the team leader in doubles is Carlos Correa, with 25, one more than his 2022 total...finally, Joey Gallo enters today needing two doubles to reach 100 for his career, sitting at 98.

D(UR)AN FLASHES: Jhoan Duran recorded his 21st save on Sunday afternoon at Philadelphia, giving him nine saves in his last 10 chances... on the season, Duran has posted a 12.02 K/9.0 IP ratio, a 2.76 ERA and a .210 opponent batting average...he is one of six pitchers in baseball with a minimum of 12.00 K/9.0 IP, 20 saves, a BAA under .210 and an ERA less than 3.00, the others being Alexis Díaz, Camilo Doval, Félix Bautista, Devin Williams and Josh Hader...additionally, Duran has thrown 269 pitches at 101+ mph this season, the most in baseball.

55 GAMES, 55 RBI, 995 GAMES....: Carlos Correa needs five games played to reach 1,000 career games, sitting at 995. **☎** In Correa's final 55 games of the 2022 season, he hit .329 (69-for-210) with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 27 RBI and a .916 OPS. **☎** Correa leads the team with 54 RBI this season, including nine RBI in his last eight games.

I LOVE THIS STUFF, I LOVE OLD STUFF!: On this day in 2011, Jim Thome hit two home runs in a 9-6 win at Detroit to become the eighth player to reach 600 home runs; Thome hit a two-run homer off Rick Porcello in the sixth for number 599, then a three-run shot against Daniel Schlereth in the seventh.

CELEBRATING AT TRUFFONI'S TONIGHT: Former manager Tom Kelly is celebrating his 73rd birthday today...Kelly is the Twins all-time managerial wins leader (1,140)...on his birthday, Kelly held a managerial record of 7-6.

LAST START: Took his sixth loss of the season in his last start on August 9 at Detroit, a 9-5 Twins' defeat at Comerica Park...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed five runs (4 earned) on a season-hightying 11 hits (1 HR), with one walk and a season-high nine strikeouts...marked his most strikeouts since recording a career-high 10 strikeouts on September 27, 2022 vs. Chicago-AL...snapped his four-game streak with no walks issued after issuing a walk to Riley Greene in the first inning...Greene scored after a single by Kerry Carpenter, Matt Vierling also scored on a throwing error by Max Kepler... yielded consecutive RBI singles in the second inning to Greene and Vierling...pitched scoreless third and fourth innings...permitted his seventh home run in five games to Spencer Torkelson in the fifth inning...relieved by Emilio Pagán who pitched a scoreless sixth inning...lordan Balazovic entered in the seventh inning; yielded a solo home run to Torkelson and an RBI single to Eric Haase... in the eighth inning, Vierling scored on a wild pitch and Balazovic allowed an RBI single to Carpenter.

The Has yielded seven home runs in his last five starts, tying his career high over a five-game span (also, June 22-July 20, 2021 and June 30-July 25, 2021).

Has pitched five-innings-or fewer in three-consecutive starts, tying the third-longest streak in his career (also, September 6- September 18, 2021).

Marked his 50th career start...tied for the seventh-most strikeouts in the first 50 games by a Twins' starter (254)...also owns the ninth-lowest ERA (3.64).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in his start on August 4 vs. Arizona, a 3-2 Twins' victory...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...tossed a career-high 104 pitches, passing his previous high of 102 done on May 16 at Los Angeles-NL...allowed a solo home run to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. in the second inning...yielded an RBI single to Jose Herrera in the fourth inning...pitched a 1-2-3 fifth inning to end his outing...relieved by Dylan Floro in the sixth as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings...the Twins tied the game in the bottom of the sixth inning with a solo home run by Max Kepler and took the lead in the seventh on a solo shot by Michael A. Taylor.

© Marked a career-high four-consecutive starts without issuing a walk...became the 10th individual Twins starter to issue zero walks through at least four-consecutive starts.

AGAINST DETROIT: Facing the Tigers for the third time this season and the seventh in his career tonight...is 0-1, 5.73 ERA (11.0 IP, 7 ER) with two walks and 17 strikeouts in two starts against the Tigers this season; both at Comerica Park...is 1-2, 5.70 ERA (30.0 IP, 19 ER) with six walks and 33 strikeouts in his six previous career starts against the Tigers; the Twins are 4-2 in those starts... is 1-2, 3.63 ERA (39.2 IP, 16 ER) with five walks and 43 strikeouts in seven starts against the AL is 1-2, 3.63 ERA (39 Central this season.

BACK AT HOME: Ober is making his 12th home start of 2023 tonight... Twins have won six of his 11 home starts this year, with Ober going 2-3, 3.03 ERA (62.1 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks, 53 strikeouts and six quality starts... owns the eighth lowest walks-per-9.0-innings-pitched ration among American League starts at home this season (min. 10 GS)...is 4-3, 3.88 ERA (46.1 IP, 20 ER) with six walks and
