LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss despite allowing just one run on three hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched on August 10 at Detroit, a 3-0 Twins' defeat...issued one walk and struck out four batters, his lowest single-game total since June 28 at Atlanta (also 4 K)...retired 16 of the first 19 batters he faced... allowed his only run on a solo home run by Riley Greene in the bottom of the sixth...was relieved by Dylan Floro to begin the top of the seventh...Twins were shut out for the ninth time this season and lost the series finale.

TOUGH LUCK: Maeda has a .300 winning percentage (3-7) despite owning a 3.97 ERA...is one of four pitchers in baseball with an ERA of 4.00-or-less and a winning percentage of .300 or less (min. 10 GS), joining CLE's Gavin Williams (1-3, 2.80 ERA), PHI's Ranger Suárez (2-6, 3.88 ERA) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (1-3, 3.39 ERA)...his expected ERA is 3.34, a difference of 0.64 from his actual ERA, the second-largest difference in the Twins' rotation this year (1.16, Joe Ryan - 4.43 ERA, 3.27 xERA).

CENTRAL COMMAND: Maeda is 2-3, 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 31 strikeouts in five starts against American League Central opponents this year...lost to Chicago-AL on April 10, earned wins on June 23 at Detroit and on July 4 vs. Kansas City, and lost on July 30 at Kansas City and August 10 at Detroit...in 26 career starts against the AL Central, Maeda is 12-7, 3.24 ERA (144.2 IP, 52 ER) with 32 walks and 161 strikeouts...his 3.24 ERA vs. the AL Central is his second lowest against any division in his career (3.07 ERA vs. National League East).

FINDING HIS TARGET: Making his sixth home start of the season today...is 2-2, 5.40 ERA (28.1 IP, 17 ER) with five walks and 29 strikeouts in five starts at Target Field this year...Twins have won each of his last three home starts, with Maeda going 2-0, 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and 24 strikeouts...won his last home start on August 5 vs. Arizona, a 12-1 Twins' victory (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 7 K)...is 1-5, 2.89 ERA (37.1 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 47 strikeouts in eight road starts in 2023.
In four career home starts against Detroit, Maeda is 1-0, 2.70 ERA (23.1 IP, 7 ER) with five walks, 29 strikeouts and a .150 (12-for-80) opponent batting average; Twins are 3-1 in those starts.
In 84 career home appearances (66 starts), he is 35-21, 3.17 ERA (402.2 IP, 142 ER) with 101 walks and 444 strikeouts...is 27-27, 4.55 ERA (425.0 IP, 215 ER) with 136 walks and 466 strikeouts in 98 career road appearances (82 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, throwing his slider and split finger the most; he utilizes the pair a combined 65.1 percent of the time...favors his split finger (187/318 - 58.8%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (238/361 - 65.9%) and sinker (63/63 - 100%) against righties...opposing hitters went 0-for-7 with two strikeouts against his fastball in his last start on August 10 at Detroit...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:
