LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have hit 50 home runs since the All-Star break, the most in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (62)....on the season, they have homered 165 times, fourth most in the AL and seventh most in baseball.
WALLY WORLD: Matt Wallner has posted an . 831 OPS with eight home runs since the All-Star break, the most homers on the team since the break ..in his last 63 games between Minnesota and Triple-A St. Paul, he has hit 14 doubles and 15 home runs, with 49 RBI, while posting
a . 923 OPS since May 30 .

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa has hit safely in a season-high nine-straight games, his longest since September 20, 2019-July 31,2020 (also 9)..it is the fourth-Iongest active streak in baseball...his career high is 16, done in 2019 with Houston...a hit today would make him

क Making his 14th start and appearance of 2023, and his sixth home start... also his 183rd career appearance and 149th start
玉Facing Detroit for the second-straight start and third time this season...is 1-1, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP 1 ER) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in two previous starts vs. the Tigers this year.
Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.


LEAGUE LEADER LATELY: Since being returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) on June 23, Maeda is 3-3 with a 2.36 ERA (49.2 IP, 13 ER), 14 walks, 62 strikeouts and a 190 (33-for-174) opponent batting average in nine starts...here's how his numbers rank among American League pitchers since June 23 (min. 9 GS ):


LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss despite allowing just one run on three hits ( 1 HR ) in 6.0 innings pitched on August 10 at Detroit, a 3-0 Twins' defeat... issued one walk and struck out four batters, his lowest single-game total since June 28 at Atlanta (also 4 K )...retired 16 of the first 19 batters he faced... allowed his only run on a solo home run by Riley Greene in the bottom of the sixth...was relieved by Dylan Floro to begin the top of the seventh...Twins were shut out for the ninth time this season and ost the series finale.
strak and three-or-fewer runs in each of his last nine starts, the second-longest active streak among American League starters (CLE's Tanner Bibee -10)...Maeda's current streak
is his second longest as a Twin (14-start streak allowing 3-or-fewer runs from July 26, 2020 is his second longe
to April 14, 2021).
$\Phi$ Recorded his fifth quality start in his last seven outings after failing to record a quality start in his first six starts of 2023.
TWO STARTS AGO: Recorded his 50th career quality start and earned the win on August 5 vs. Arizona in the Twins' 12-1 victory at Target Field....allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...struck out Geraldo Perdomo to lead off the game, recording his 900 th career strikeout...stranded Corbin Carroll on second base in the top of the first inning by striking out Christian Walker to end the inning...allowed a solo home run to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. and a relieved by Jordan Balazovic to start the top of the seventh with Minnesota beading 10-1. Balazovic (20 IP) and Jovani Moran (1.0 IP) held the Diamondbacks scoreless as the Twins offense produced 12 runs on 17 hits to win the game and claim the series victory.
$\Phi$ Allowed only two hits, his fewest in a start of 6.0-or-more innings since July 4, 2021 at Kansas
City (also 6.0 IP, 2 H).
TOUGH LUCK: Maeda has a 300 winning percentage (3-7) despite owning a 3.97 ERA...is one of four pitchers in baseball with an ERA of 4.00-or-less and a winning percentage of . 300 or less (min. 10 GS), joining CLE's Gavin Williams (1-3, 2.80 ERA), PHI's Ranger Suárez (2-6, 3.88 ERA) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (1-3, 3.39 ERA)...his expected ERA is 3.34 , a difference of 0.64 from his actual ERA,
the second-largest difference in the Twins' rotation this year (1.16, Joe Ryan - 4.43 ERA, 3.27 xERA).

EYE OF THE TIGER: Facing Detroit for the second-consecutive start and third time this year...lost to the Tigers in his last start on August 10 at Comerica Park, a 3-0 Twins' defeat ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 3 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}$, 1 the Tigers in his last start on August 10 at Comerica Park, a 3 . 1 Twins defeat ( $6.0 \mathrm{PP}, 3 \mathrm{~A}, 1 \mathrm{R}, \mathrm{ER}$, the Tigers this year, fired 5.0 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits, issuing two walks and striking out eight batters in his return from the 15-day Injured List.

CENTRAL COMMAND: Maeda is 2-3, 2.48 ERA ( 29.0 IP, 8 ER) with six walks and 31 strikeouts in five starts against American League Central opponents this year...lost to Chicago-AL on April 10, earned wins on June 23 at Detroit and on July 4 vs. Kansas City, and lost on July 30 at Kansas City and August with 32 walks and 161 strikeouts...his 3.24 ERA vs. the AL Central is his second lowest against any division in his career (3.07 ERA vs. National League East).

FINDING HIS TARGET: Making his sixth home start of the season today...is 2-2, 5.40 ERA (28.1 IP, 17 ER) with five walks and 29 strikeouts in five starts at Target field this year.... wins have won each of his last three home starts, with Maeda going 2-0, 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and 24 strikeouts....won his last home start on August 5 vs. Arizona, a $12-1$ Twins' victory ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 2 \mathrm{H}$, 1R/ER, 1 HR, O BB, 7 K )...is 1-5, 2.89 ERA ( 37.1 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 47 strikeouts in eight road starts in 2023.
$\Phi$ In four career home starts against Detroit, Maeda is $1-0,2.70 \mathrm{ERA}(23.1 \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{ER})$ with five walks,

## CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow. - Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner)
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's. - Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12)
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers. - His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished
