THE TWINS: Began their five-game, six-day homestand with a 1-1 series split against Detroit earlier this week, winning on Tuesday night, followed by a loss on Wednesday afternoon...

TWINS COME UP SHORT ON TIGERS: The Twins lost to the Tigers on Wednesday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 8-7...Minnesota jumped out to a four-run lead, allowed seven runs in the middle innings, then scored three in the bottom of the ninth to fall short...

TWINS AND BUGS: The Twins are 23-16 all-time against the Pirates, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium, 8-4 at the Metrodome, 8-4 at PNC Park and 5-4 at Target Field...the Twins have won seven of their last 10 games vs. Pittsburgh, dating back to April of 2018.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins have gone 17-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona and 2-1 at Philadelphia...the Twins have gone 6-1 in their last seven in IL Play and 10-5 in their last 15...their 17 wins are their most in IL Play for a single season (16 in 2006).

LIFE OF PABLO: Pablo López enters today third in baseball in strikeouts with 180 (career high), trailing Spencer Strider (217) and Kevin Gausman (187)...he is on pace to strike out 239 batters, which would land him fifth on the Twins' single-season all-time list: Johan Santana — 265 in 2004, Bert Blyleven — 258 in 1973, Blyleven — 249 in 1974, Santana — 245 in 2006...the last Twin with 200+ Ks was José Berrios with 202 in 2018.

STARTERS ON STRIKE: Twins starters have struck out an MLB-best 751 batters and are on pace to strike out 997 hitters this season, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967...in fact, 997 would land them eighth on baseball's all-time list, behind the 2018 Astros (1,101), 2017 Guardians (1,066), 2018 Guardians (1,066), 2019 Astros (1,063), 2017 Nationals (1,012), 2019 Nationals (1,010) and 2017 Red Sox (1,001).

THE STREAK CONTINUES: Carlos Correa has hit safely in a season-high nine-straight games, his longest since September 20, 2019-July 31, 2020 (also 9)...it is tied for the third-longest active streak in baseball...his career high is 16, done in 2019 with Houston...a hit today would make him the third Twin with a double-digit hit streak this season (Jeffers — 14 and Solano — 11).

ROOKIES THAT RAKE: Edouard Julien recorded a season-high four hits on Wednesday afternoon, passing his previous high of three, done five times...on the season, Julien ranks in the top five among MLB rookies in several offensive categories (minimum of 250 plate appearances):

MAXSLG: Max Kepler hit his 20th home run of the season on Wednesday afternoon, tying Joey Gallo for team lead...it's the second most of Kepler's career for a single season, matching his 2018 total and 16 short of his career high of 36, done in 2019...in his last 27 games, since July 17, Kepler is hitting .305 (29-for-95) with seven doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI, 22 runs scored, seven walks, a .356 on-base percentage, a .632 slugging percentage and a .987 OPS.

JEFF YEA: Since the All-Star break, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .328 (22-for-67) with three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, 10 walks, a .430 on-base percentage, a .597 slugging percentage and a 1.027 OPS...he has raised his batting average 24 points since the break, going from .256 to .280...since the break, he ranks ninth in the AL in OBP and 10th in OPS.

ROYCE OF SUMMER: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .420 (29-for-69) with a 1.003 OPS in his last 20 games, including six three-plus-hit games...he has three three-hit games in his last seven games overall...among all rookies in baseball with a minimum of 100 plate appearances, Royce ranks first in batting average (.343), and runs created-per-27 (8.68), third in OPS+ (140.3), and fourth in both OPS (.873) and wOBA (.380).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third-straight win, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with four hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts in the Twins' 9-3 victory over Philadelphia on August 12 at Citizens Bank Park...did not allow a hit until Nick Castellanos singled with two outs in the bottom of the fourth inning...yielded two singles in the fifth but stranded both runners...retired Castellanos and Bryson Stott to end his outing after Bryce Harper doubled with one out in the sixth inning...three Twins relievers held the Phillies to one run and Minnesota tallied 11 hits to even the three-game series at 1-1.

- ⚔ Set new single-season career highs for quality starts (15) and strikeouts (180), surpassing his 2022 totals (14 QS, 174 K).
- ⚔ Won three consecutive starts for the third time in his career (also, September 14-24, 2020 and April 15-27, 2022)...his three-game win streak is his longest of 2023 and is one shy of his career-high four-game win streak, done with Miami from July 11, 2021-April 27, 2022.

TWO STARTS AGO: Tied his single-season career high with his 14th quality start, earning the win on August 7 at Detroit in the Twins' 9-3 victory at Comerica Park...pitched 7.0 scoreless innings with five hits allowed, no walks and eight strikeouts...received nine total runs of support, his most in any start this year...scattered five singles, allowing just one runner in scoring position in his 7.0 innings of work (Zach McKinstry, fifth inning)...retired 15 of the final 18 batters he faced...was relieved by Brent Headrick to begin the bottom of the eighth inning with Minnesota leading 9-0; Headrick pitched the final 2.0 innings (3 H, 3 R) and the Twins cruised to a win in the four-game series opener.

- ⚔ Won in back-to-back starts for the second time this season, also doing so on June 30 at Baltimore and July 5 vs. Kansas City.
- ⚔ Marked his ninth career start of 7.0-or-more scoreless innings, recording his second such start of 2023 (CGSO on July 5 vs. Kansas City).

AHOY!: Facing the Pirates for the third time in his career tonight...is 1-0, 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and seven strikeouts in two previous starts against Pittsburgh...last faced the Pirates on July 13, 2022 with Miami, taking a no-decision in the Marlins' 5-4 victory at loanDepot Park; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed one run on one hit, with four walks and three strikeouts...both of his two career starts against Pittsburgh were home outings.

- ⚔ Is 2-1, 3.60 ERA (40.0 IP, 16 ER) with nine walks and 47 strikeouts in seven Interleague starts this season; Twins have won in each of his last three Interleague outings.
- ⚔ In two starts vs. National League Central opponents in 2023, he is 1-0, 3.00 ERA (12.0 IP, 4 ER) with one walk and 14 strikeouts...took a no-decision in the Twins' 7-5 win on June 13 vs. Milwaukee and earned the win in Minnesota's 3-2 victory on August 1 at St. Louis...is 6-7, 3.27 ERA (121.0 IP, 44 ER) with 26 walks and 123 strikeouts in 20 career starts vs. the NL Central.

TARGET ACQUIRED: Making his first home start since July 25 vs. Seattle...in 10 home starts this season, López is 3-2, 4.71 ERA (63.0 IP, 33 ER) with 17 walks and 80 strikeouts...Twins are 7-3 in his 10 starts at Target Field in 2023...here are his numbers in his last four home starts compared to his first six:

⚔ In 60 career home starts, he is 17-17, 3.68 ERA (347.0 IP, 142 ER) with 96 walks and 348 strikeouts...is 19-20, 4.08 ERA (310.2 IP, 141 ER) with 83 walks and 321 strikeouts in 58 career road starts.

RIGHT ON: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .204 (58-for-284) batting average this season, with righties going 2-for-9 with two strikeouts against him in his last start on August 12 at Philadelphia...his 104 strikeouts against righties are tied for sixth most in the American League this year...his .204 opponent batting average vs. righties this season ranks sixth in the AL (min. 20 GS)...left-handed hitters are batting .246 (66-for-268) against him in 2023, going 2-for-13 with five strikeouts against him in his last outing.

- ⚔ Has better career numbers against righties (.647 OPS) than lefties (.735 OPS).

PITCH BREAKDOWN: Has used a five-pitch mix in 2023, per Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...opposing hitters went just 1-for-9 (.111) with five strikeouts against his fastball in his last start on August 12 at Philadelphia...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

⚔ In his first 24 starts this year, López has an average fastball velocity of 94.8 mph, a 2.1 mph increase from last season and the largest year-to-year jump of his career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 6-5, 3.04 ERA // CAREER: 96-82, 3.52 ERA)

Sonny Gray is set to start the middle game of the three-game series with Pittsburgh tomorrow night at Target Field...earned the win in his last start on August 13 at Philadelphia, a 3-0 Twins' victory at Citizens Bank Park; pitched 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, three walks and seven strikeouts...extended his quality-start streak to five games, his longest of the season and longest since a six-game quality-start streak from August 20-September 17, 2019 with Cincinnati...facing the Pirates for the 10th time in his career and first time since August 5, 2021; earned the win in a 7-4 Reds' victory at Great American Ball Park (5.0 IP, 6 H, 4 R/ER, 2 BB, 7 K)...is 4-3, 4.20 ERA (45.0 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks and 46 strikeouts in nine career appearances (8 starts) vs. Pittsburgh.

CAREER NOTES

- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings pitched (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as number two starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
- In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
- Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings and allowing three hits and two runs while striking out seven in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
- Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
- In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59).
- Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
- Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
- Started 2018 season with Double-A Jacksonville, earning Southern League Midseason All-Star honors before being promoted to Triple-A New Orleans.
- Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Brayan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
- Spent 2017 season at High-A level in Seattle and Miami organizations.
- Went 6-1, 1.88 ERA (71.2 IP, 15 ER) in 17 appearances (13 starts) for Low-A Clinton (Seattle) in 2016.
