THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their current six-game roadtrip, getting swept in three games in Kansas City over the weekend, followed by a win in St. Louis last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three at Busch Stadium against the Cardinals...they will complete the trip with the three-game series finale against St. Louis tomorrow night before traveling home for a three-game homestand/weekend series with the Arizona Diamondbacks...the Iwins have gone 30-24 at home and 25-29 on the road.

◆ Of the Twins' 54 remaining games, they have an opponent winning percentage of .483, the fifth-lowest strength of schedule.

SOLANO CELEBRATES PABLO DAY: The Twins beat the Cardinals last night at Busch Stadium by a score of 3-2...the win snapped their five-game losing streak and marked their first win in eight days (7/24 vs. SEA)...Pablo López (6-6) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Emilio Pagán (4) and Griffin Jax (15) each earned a hold as Jhoan Duran earned his 18th save...the offense recorded seven hits, highlighted by a Donovan Solano pinch-hit go-ahead two-RBI single in the top of the seventh inning...Byron Buxton (17), Matt Wallner (3) and Ryan Jeffers (9) each doubled.

◆ Wallner's outfield assist in the sixth inning, throwing out Lars Nootbaar at third base (also assist from Polanco, the cut-off man), registered at 100.4 mph, the third-fasted outfield assist by a Twin in the Statcast Era (since 2015), trailing Aaron Hicks (101.9 mph on 6/12/15) and Eddie Rosario (100.6 mph on 8/23/18).

FOR STARTERS: Pablo López gave the Twins their MLB-best 54th quality start last night... Twins starters have combined to go 31-33, 3.85 ERA (610.0 IP, 261 ER) with 159 walks, 672 strikeouts and a .237 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks among the other MLB teams:

IT'S A MIDWEST THING: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other in the regular season this series for the 34th, 35th and 36th time in their regular season history...they last played the Cardinals for three games here in 2021 as the Twins won just the middle of the three-game series...Twins are 18-16 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997) and 10-4 in their last 14...they were 2-7 all-time in the regular season at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 7-6 all-time at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23).

© Donovan Solano is slashing .321/.357/.340 in 17 career games at Busch Stadium.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins have gone 11-13 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta and 1-0 at St. Louis.

♣ Twins are 261-245 all-time in IL Play, for a .516 winning percentage, the seventh best in MLB.

♣ After this series, Minnesota's remaining 2023 IL schedule includes Target Field visits from the Diamondbacks (August 4-6), Pirates (August 18-20) and Mets (September 8-10)...the Twins will also play road games at Phillies (August 11-13), Brewers (August 22-23), Reds (September 18-20) and Rockies (September 29-October 1).

♣ Jorge Polanco has hit safely in 11 of 12 Interleague games this season, hitting .313 (15-for-48) with four doubles, three home runs, five RBI, four walks, and a .949 OPS...he has reached safely in 11 of his last 23 IL plate appearances (7 hits, 4 walks).

 SECOND HALF STRENGTH: Despite going 1-5 in their last six games, the Twins have gone 10-7 since the All-Star break, tied for the fifth-most wins in baseball...below are the offensive numbers and MLB ranks pre-All-Star break vs. post-All-Star break:

SERIES BUSINESS: The Twins are seeking their 16th series victory this season...they are 15-15-4 in series play in 2023, going 9-6-2 at

The first business: The first are seeking their 16th series victory this season...they are 19-19-4 in series play in 2023, going 9-6-2 a home and 6-9-2 on the road.

◆ Twins are 6-3-3 all-time vs. the Cardinals in series play...their last series victory over St. Louis was a two-game sweep at Target Field from July 28-29, 2020...their last series win at Busch Stadium came in a two-game sweep from May 7-8, 2018.

◆ Entering today, the Twins have gone 5-4-1 in their last 10 series, dating back to their June 23-25 series at Detroit.

CAN'T SPELL EDOUARD WITHOUT R.O.A.D.: Edouard Julien is hitting .311 (32-for-103) with four doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, 11 walks, 13 runs scored, a .385 on-base percentage, a .466 slugging percentage and an .851 OPS in 32 road games for the Twins this season...since the All-Star break, he is 14-for-31 (.452) on the road, with a 1.205 OPS in 10 games.

MAD MAX, FURY ROAD: Max Kepler is hitting .295 (28-for-95) with six doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, 16 runs scored, seven walks and an .856 OPS in his last 26 games.

◆ In 14 road games since June 30, he is hitting .340 (17-for-50) with four doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, a .370 on-base percentage, a .660 slugging percentage and a 1.030 OPS.

MINOR MATTERS: Double-A Wichita infielder Brooks Lee and High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for July.

4 Lee, 22, played in 20 games for the Wind Surge, hitting .365 (31-for-85) with five doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, 15 runs scored, a .433 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS...the San Luis Obispo, California native was selected by the Twins eighth overall in the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of California Polytechnic State University.

4 Matthews, 23, went 2-0, 3.22 ERA (22.1 IP, 8 ER) with just one walk, 23 strikeouts and a 0.85 WHIP in four starts for the Kernels... the Cullowhee, North Carolina native was selected by the Twins in the eighth round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Western Carolina University.

WAY BACK WEDNESDAY: Twins radio stud Dan Gladden played in 26 career regular season and postseason games against the Cardinals, hitting .279 (29-for-104) with seven doubles, two triples, one home run, 14 RBI, 13 runs scored, six stolen bases (0 caught) and a .738 OPS...in 12 career regular and Postseason games at old Busch Stadium, he hit .295 (13-for-44)...his only career home run against the Cardinals came in Game One of the 1987 World Series, a fourth-inning grand slam off Bob Forsch at the Metrodome...in three '87 World Series games at old Busch Stadium, Gladden went 3-for-12 with two walks, hitting safely in all three.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his seventh loss of the season on July 26 vs. Seattle in an 8-7 Twins' defeat at Target Field...allowed four runs on seven hits (2 HR) in 3.2 innings pitched, his second-shortest career start by innings (3.0 IP on June 27 at Atlanta); also issued two walks and struck out seven batters...after Julio Rodríguez doubled to lead off the game, Ryan allowed an RBI single to Teoscar Hernández...yielded solo homers to Dylan Moore in the second inning and Rodríguez in the third inning...allowed the first four batters of the fourth inning to reach safely, including an RBI single by Kolten Wong, then recorded two strikeouts before being relieved by Jordan Balazovic...Twins rallied for four runs in the bottom of the sixth but were shut out in the final three innings, dropping the rubber game of the three-game series.

♣ Has allowed a homer in six-straight starts, the longest streak of his career...Ryan's 13 homers allowed 13 in six games from April 18-May 14, 2006.

♣ Became the fourth Twin since 1988 to throw 95-or-more pitches in fewer than 4.0 innings and first since Ervin Santana tossed 95 pitches in 3.1 innings on July 21, 2017.

♣ Despite the loss, Ryan remains among the American League leaders in walks-per-9.0 innings (1.77 - 4th), strikeouts (148 - 6th), quality starts (12 - T-7th), WHIP (1.09 - 12th) and WAR (2.3 - 13th).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win on July 21 vs. Chicago-AL, a 9-4 Twins' victory at Target Field... pitched 6.0 innings and allowed four runs on seven hits (2 HR), with one walk and a season-high-tying 10 strikeouts...allowed a leadoff homer to Andrew Benintendi, the third of his career (also, June 27 at Atlanta - Ronald Acuña Jr; July 3 vs. Kansas City - Maikel Garcia)...received five runs of support in the bottom of the first, then tossed scoreless innings in the second, third and fourth innings, allowing just two hits and a walk...yielded a two-out RBI single to Tim Anderson in the top of the fifth and a two-run homer to Yasmani Grandal in the sixth...was relieved by Emilio Pagán to begin the top of the seventh; Pagán (1.0 IP) and Jovani Moran (2.0 IP) kept the White Sox off the board, and the Twins scored nine runs on nine hits to win the series opener.

\$\Pi\$ Struck out a season-high 10 batters for the fifth time this season (also, April 8 vs. Houston, April 13 at New York-AL, May 13 vs. Chicago-NL and July 9 vs. Baltimore)...was one short of his career high of 11 (September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL).

NEW DECK OF CARDS: Facing the Cardinals for the first time in his career tonight...St. Louis will be the 21st team Ryan has faced in the majors; in 20 career starts when facing a new team, he is 5-8, 5.40 ERA (100.0 IP, 60 ER) with 39 walks and 92 strikeouts...has never faced any active Cardinals batters...is 2-1, 2.53 ERA (21.1 IP, 6 ER) with five walks and 29 strikeouts in four career starts vs. National League Central opponents...Twins are 3-1 in his four starts vs. the NL Central.

INTERLEAGUE INTEGERS: Tonight is Ryan's fourth Interleague start of 2023 and 11th of his career...is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (14.0 IP, 7 ER), three walks and 19 strikeouts in three starts against the Senior Circuit this season...earned the win on May 13 vs. Chicago-NL and May 24 vs. San Francisco; took the loss in his last IL start on June 27 at Atlanta...is 5-4, 5.58 ERA (50.0 IP, 31 ER) with 14 walks and 58 strikeouts in 10 career IL starts.

BUMPS IN THE ROAD: After winning each of his first three road starts this year, Ryan has gone winless in his last seven road starts (0-3, 5.20 ERA), with the Twins going 2-5 in those outings...owns a 3-3 record and a 4.23 ERA (55.1 IP, 26 ER) in 10 overall road starts, with 13 walks and 61 strikeouts... took a no-decision in his last road start on July 16 at Oakland, a 5-4 Twins' win; allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings pitched, with three walks and seven strikeouts...is 6-4, 3.92 ERA (66.2 IP, 29 ER) with 11 walks and 87 strikeouts in 11 starts at Target Field this season.

4 Pitching at Busch Stadium for the first time in his career; the venue will be the 18th different ballpark he has pitched at in the majors...in 17 career starts when pitching at a new ballpark, he is 5-7, 5.55 ERA (86.0 IP, 53 ER) with 22 walks and 93 strikeouts.

5 Is 11-7, 3.97 ERA (131.1 IP, 58 ER) with 32 walks and 137 strikeouts in 24 career road starts...in 29 career home starts, he is 13-9, 3.67 ERA (164.1 IP, 67 ER) with 44 walks and 192 strikeouts.

LEFT LEADER: Left-handed hitters are batting just .199 (43-for-216) with a .567 OPS and 58 strikeouts against Ryan this year...his .567 opponent OPS against left-handed hitters is the sixth lowest in the American League this season (min. 15 GS)...right-handed hitters are hitting .263 (66-for-251) with a .787 OPS and 90 strikeouts against Ryan in 2023...his .233 (109-for-467) overall opponent batting average in 2023 ranks 15th in the AL among qualified starters.

© Lefties are hitting just .201 (97-for-483) against Ryan since the start of last season, the 12th-lowest opponent average vs. lefties among starting pitchers with at least 106.0 IP (*Inside Edge*).

© Over his career, lefties are batting .196 (104-for-530) with a .605 OPS against him...his .605 career opponent OPS vs. lefties is the fifth lowest in the American League since his debut (min. 250 at-bats)...righties are hitting .235 (136-for-578) with a .719 OPS off Ryan in his career.

THE ARSENAL: Has utilized a four-pitch mix in his first 21 starts of the 2023 season...has leaned on his four-seam fastball and split finger, combining to throw the two pitches 85.6 percent of the time this year...struck out three batters with his sweeper in his last start on July 26 vs. Seattle, tying his season high (also, June 16 vs. Detroit and July 3 vs. Kansas City)...here's a look at Ryan's repertoire, per Baseball Savant:

Made his major league debut for the Twins on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (L, 5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/3 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K).
Helped Team USA win the silver medal in baseball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics... went 1-0, 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), one walk and eight strikeouts in two starts.
