THE TWINS: Completed their five-game, six day homestand with a record of 3-2, going 1-1 vs. Detroit, followed by a 2-1 series win over the Pirates...tonight, the Twins will begin a two-game series with the Brewers at American Family Field...following tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis to begin a seven-game homestand with four against the Rangers (August 24-27) and three against the Guardians (August 28-30)...the Twins have gone 36-26 at home and 29-34 on the road.

The Twins have gone 20-14 since the All-Star break, tied for fourth most wins in the AL and tied for seventh most wins in baseball.

Of the Twins' 37 remaining games, they have an opponent winning percentage of .479, the fourth-lowest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball.

TWINS RAISE THE JOLLY ROGER: The Twins shut out the Pirates on Sunday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 2-0...Dallas Keuchel (1-1) was the starter and winner in his third start with Minnesota, pitching 6.1 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and three strikeouts...Keuchel carried a perfect game for all 6.1 innings until allowing a one-out double to Bryan Reynolds in the seventh...Griffin Jax (19) and Caleb Thielbar (10) each earned holds as Jhoan Duran recorded his 23th save (27th opp)...the offense recorded five hits, two from Donovan Solano (single, double)...Edouard Julien went 1-for-2 with a double and drove in both runs.

C4 1K: Carlos Correa is playing in his 1,000th career game tonight, 247 coming with the Twins (2022-present) and 752 coming with the Astros (2015-21)...71 active major leaguers have reached the 1,000 game mark...the closest current Twins to 1,000 career games are Michael A. Taylor with 951 and Max Kepler with 933...992 of Correa's 999 games have been at shortstop, the fifth-most among actives, trailing Elvis Andrus (1,958), Brandon Crawford (1,602), Xander Bogaerts (1,305) and Francisco Lindor (1,168).

BEERFEST: The Twins and Brewers are playing the third of four games this season...Minnesota hosted Milwaukee for two games from June 13-14 and swept, while outscoring the Brewers 11-7...the Twins are 242-231 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 69-57 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998...Twins are 13-8 in their last 21 against the Brewers.

Max Kepler is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three doubles, one triple, five RBI, four walks and an .890 OPS in his last 10 games vs. the Brewers.

Christian Vazquez is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with three doubles, two RBI, three walks and a .982 OPS in seven career games vs. the Brew Crew.

Edouard Julien went 3-for-7 (.429) with two doubles and two walks during the two-game series against the Brewers in June.

NATIONALLY KNOWN: The Twins have gone 19-16 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona, 2-1 at Philadelphia and 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh...the Twins have gone 8-2 in their last 10 in IL Play and 12-6 in their last 18...their 19 wins are their most in IL Play for a single season (16 in 2006).

Max Kepler has six home runs against NL opponents this season...he has 21 career IL home runs, tied with Justin Morneau for fourth most in club history, trailing Torii Hunter (33), Eddie Rosario (23) and Joe Mauer (22).

C4 IGNITING: After going 1-for-4 on Sunday, Carlos Correa has reached base safely in 12-straight games, since August 5...since that date, he is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, seven walks, a .438 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.038 OPS.

From August 1 of last season to the end of the 2022 season, Correa hit .323 (72-for-223) with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 28 RBI, a .402 on-base percentage, a .498 slugging percentage and a .900 OPS in his final 59 games.

LOVE FOR LEFTIES LATELY: The Twins have faced nine left-handed starters since the All-Star break, going 6-3 in those games...they are 15-14 on the season when facing a lefty starter...below is a comparison of offensive numbers vs. lefties before the All-Star break and after:

Table comparing AVG, OBP, SLG, OPS, BB%, K% for PRE-ASG and POST-ASG.

In their last 13 games vs. left-handed pitching, the Twins have an OPS of .833 (.330 OBP/.503 SLG) with 11 home runs.

Carlos Correa is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with four doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, a .475 on-base percentage, a .686 slugging percentage and a 1.161 OPS in his last 19 games vs. left-handed pitching.

STARTERS ON STRIKE: Twins starters have struck out an MLB-best 768 batters and are on pace to strike out 995 hitters this season, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967...in fact, 995 would land them eighth on baseball's all-time list, behind the 2018 Astros (1,101), 2017 Guardians (1,066), 2018 Guardians (1,066), 2019 Astros (1,063), 2017 Nationals (1,012), 2019 Nationals (1,010) and 2017 Red Sox (1,001).

768 strikeouts rank fourth most in club history...next is the 1964 staff that had 777 (right).

HBD, MOLLIE: Happy 67th birthday to Hall of Famer and former Twins manager Paul Molitor, who was born on this day in St. Paul in 1956...Mollie's 75.7 bWAR is the second highest by any major leaguer born on August 22, behind fellow Hall of Famer Carl Yastrzemski (96.5)...Twins went 2-1 on Mollie's birthday with him as manager.

Christian Vazquez celebrated his 33rd birthday yesterday.

MINOR THINGS: Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher John Klein was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week and FCL Twins right-handed pitcher Kyle Bischoff has been named FCL Pitcher of the Week.

Klein, 21, made the start on Saturday at Palm Beach, pitching 6.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts, earning his first victory of the season...Klein was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in August of 2022 from Iowa Central Community College.

Bischoff, 24, made the start on Saturday against the FCL Red Sox, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, no walks and six strikeouts, earning the win...Bischoff was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in May of 2023 out of Michigan State University.
