THE TWINS: Completed their two-game roadtrip in Milwaukee with two losses to the Brewers... tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game homestand with the first of four against the Rangers through the weekend...after this series, Minnesota will host the Guardians for three games from Monday-Wednesday.. the Twins have gone 36-26 at home and 29-36 on the road. ♣ The Twins enter today with a 4.5 game lead on Cleveland, the biggest division lead in the AL. ♣ Of the Twins' 35 remaining games, they have an opponent winning percentage of 475 the third-lowest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball...however, the combined winning percentage of opponents over the next 19 games is .528 (Texas, Cleveland, New York-NL and Tampa Bay).

TWINS WALKED-OFF OUT OF WISCONSIN: The Twins lost to the Brewers yesterday afternoon at American Family Field by a score of 8-7 in 10 innings, making them 10-6 in extras this season... it marked the fifth time the Twins have been swept in 2023, their first time in a two-game series...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow five runs in 4.2 innings of relief as Jhoan Duran was issued the loss after allowing a ground ball chopper to third base that plated the winning run...the offense recorded 10 hits, highlighted by homers from Royce Lewis (5), Kyle Farmer (7) and Michael A. Taylor (17).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Oliver Ortega on the 15-day Injured List with a left lumbar strain...Ortega, who was recalled on Sunday, exited Tuesday night's game in Milwaukee after sustaining the injury in the seventh inning against the Brewers...to replace Ortega on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Jordan Balazovic from St. Paul...Balazovic, who was optioned to St. Paul on Sunday, has gone 1-0, 4.44 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 ER), 12 walks, 17 strikeouts and two holds in 18 appearances for the Twins this season.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other tonight for the first of seven meetings in 2023...they will play three in Texas next weekend, September 1-3...the Twins went 2-5 against the Rangers last season, going 1-2 from July 8-10 at Globe Life Field and 1-3 at Target Field from August 19-22.

◆ Since the start of 2021, 13 of 14 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while eight games have been decided by one run.

◆ Since the start of 2019, the Iwins have scored 5.2 runs-per-game in 21 games against the Rangers...marks the second-most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.8).

◆ Carlos Correa has 20 career home runs vs. the Rangers (98 games), his most against any opponent...20 homers are the fifth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), George Springer (28), Jose Altuve (27) and Nelson Cruz (23).

TEXAS STRANGER: Joey Gallo was selected by the Rangers in the 39th round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft and spent his first 10 professional seasons in the Rangers organization, seven at the major league level with the Rangers...in 568 games for Texas (2015-21), Gallo hit .211 (385-for-1826) with 74 doubles, seven triples, 145 home runs, 317 RBI and an .833 OPS...he was an All-Star for the Rangers in 2019 and '21 and an AL Gold Glove Award winner in 2020 and '21...he homered as a 20-year-old Ranger farmhand in this ballpark during the SiriusXM Futures Game in 2014 and won the game's MVP Award.

◆ Gallo was traded away from Texas on July 29, 2021 to New York-AL, along with Joely Rodríguez and cash, in exchange for Trevor Hauver, Ezequiel Duran, Glenn Otto and Josh H. Smith.

◆ He ranks 17th on the Rangers all-time home run list.

GROUP PROJECT: Twins starters have gone 4-1, 2.52 ERA (50.0 IP, 14 ER) with 18 walks, 52 strikeouts and a .193 opponent batting average in their last nine games...on the season, Twins starters have combined to go 38-39, 3.80 ERA (712.2 IP, 301 ER) with 184 walks, 77 strikeouts and a .238 opponent batting average...below are other Twins starting pitching ranks among the AL teams.

PABLO PAINTING: Pablo López enters today third in baseball in strikeouts with 187 (career high), trailing Spencer Strider (227) and Kevin Gausman (195)...he is on pace to strike out 238 batters, which would land him in a tie with Johan Santana (2005) for fifth on the Twins' single-season all-time list...the top four are Johan Santana — 265 in 2004, Bert Blyleven — 258 in 1973, Blyleven — 249 in 1974 and Santana — 245 in 2006...the last Twin with 200+ strikeouts was José Berríos with 202 in 2018.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: The Twins are playing their sixth home series since the All-Star break and have gone 10-4 in 14 games since...they are 36-26 at home this season, tied for seventh-most home wins in baseball...Twins batters have slashed .252/.328/.446 with a .774 OPS and 4.7 runs-per-game in 62 home games this season, compared to .228/.308/.391 with a .699 OPS and 4.2 runs-per-game in 65 road games.

ROYCE ROLLS: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .360 (32-for-89) with a .901 OPS in his last 25 games, including six three-plus-hit games...among all rookies in the AL with a minimum of 125 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.311), second in runs created-per-27 (6.87), sixth in OPS+ (124.7) and OPS (.816), and eighth in wOBA (.356).

TARGET FIELD COUNTRY: Country superstar and GRAMMY® Award-winner Carly Pearce will perform a full 75-minute set approximately 20 minutes after tonight's game...tickets to tonight's Twins-Rangers game include free admission to the postgame concert.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1981, in his first major league game, Kent Hrbek hit a 12th-inning home run, giving the Twins a 3-2 victory over the Yankees...Hrbek finished his career with 293 home runs, second most in Twins history trailing only Harmon Killebrew (475).

LAST TIME OUT: Won his fourth-consecutive start on August 18 vs. Pittsburgh, a 5-1 Twins' victory at Target Field...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with six hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts... allowed leadoff baserunners in four of his first 5.0 innings pitched but did not yield a run...stranded six runners in scoring position in his start, with opposing batters going 0-for-10 with five strikeouts with runners in scoring position...was relieved by Caleb Thielbar in the top of the seventh inning: four Twins' relievers held the Pirates to one run as Minnesota won the three-game series opener.

Two four-straight starts for the first time in his career...owns a 0.36 ERA (25.0 IP, 1 ER) on his current streak...his four-game win streak is tied for the longest of his career (4-0 in 7 GS from July 6, 2021-April 27, 2022 with Miami)...with a win tonight, López would tie Joe Ryan's five-start win streak from April 2-25 for the most-consecutive wins by a Twins' pitcher this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his third-straight win, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with four hits allowed, one walk and seven strikeouts in the Twins' 8-1 victory over Philadelphia on August 12 at Citizens Bank Park...did not allow a hit until Nick Castellanos singled with two outs in the bottom of the fourth inning...yielded two singles in the fifth but stranded both runners...retired Castellanos and Bryson Stott to end his outing after Bryce Harper doubled with one out in the sixth inning...three Twins relievers held the Phillies to one run and Minnesota tallied 11 hits to even the three-game series at 1-1.

© Set new single-season career highs for quality starts (15) and strikeouts (180), surpassing his 2022 totals (14 QS, 174 K).

PABLO VS. TEXAS: Facing the Rangers for the second time in his career tonight...took the loss in his only previous start vs. Texas on July 21, 2022, an 8-0 Marlins' defeat at loanDepot Park; allowed five runs on five hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with three walks and six strikeouts...allowed consecutive RBI singles in the third inning to Nathaniel Lowe, Jonah Heim and Adolis García, who later hit a two-run homer off López in the fifth.

In four starts vs. American League West opponents this season (SEA - 2, OAK - 1, LAA - 1), he is 0-2 with a 4.94 ERA (23.2 IP, 13 ER), nine walks and 31 strikeouts...owns a 4.62 ERA (39.0 IP, 20 ER) with 16 walks and 47 strikeouts in seven career starts vs. the AL West.

TARGET ACQUIRED: Making his second-straight home start after three-consecutive road outings...in 11 home starts this season, López is 4-2, 4.30 ERA (69.0 IP, 33 ER) with 19 walks and 87 strikeouts... Twins are 8-3 in his 11 starts at Target Field in 2023...here are his numbers in his last five home starts compared to his first six:

RIGHT ON: López has limited right-handed hitters to a .201 (59-for-293) batting average this season, with righties going 1-for-9 with five strikeouts against him in his last start on August 18 vs. Pittsburgh...his 109 strikeouts against righties are tied for fourth most in the American League this year...his .201 opponent batting average vs. righties this season ranks tied for sixth in the AL (min. 20 GS)...left-handed hitters are batting .253 (71-for-281) against him in 2023, going 5-for-13 with two strikeouts against him in his last outing.

The Has better career numbers against righties (.646 OPS) than lefties (.737 OPS).
