LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss and snapped his season-long five-game quality start streak in his last start on August 19 vs. Philadelphia...pitched 6.2 innings and allowed four runs on four hits, three walks and seven strikeouts in a 7-4 Twins' defeat...tossed 5.1 perfect innings before allowing a single Warks and seven strikeouts in a 7-4 twins defeat...tossed 5.1 perfect timings before anowing a single to Liover Peguero; after allowing another single and issuing a wark, Gray permitted a two-run single to Andrew McCutchen and an RBI single to Ke'Bryan Hayes...relieved by Dylan Floro in the seventh inning after issuing two walks, Floro yielded an RBI double to Ji Hwan Bae (run charged to Gray)...
 Floro was replaced by Jordan Balazovic after issuing two walks in the eighth...Balazovic surrendered a three-run home run to McCutchen in the ninth.
 Φ Has pitched at least 6.0 innings in six-straight starts, his longest streak as a Twin and his longest since another six-start streak from August 20-September 17, 2019 with Cincinnati (career birth is 13 in 2015 with Okland).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned the win in his fifth-consecutive quality start on August 13 against Philadelphila at Citizens Bank Park...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings and allowed a season-low tying two hits, three walks and seven strikeouts in a 3-0 Twins' victory...allowed a single to Alec Bohm in the first inning...yielded another single to Jake Cave in the second for his final hit allowed...retired 13 of the final 16 batters he faced after the second single...relieved by Griffin Jax in the seventh inning who loaded the bases with two singles to Cave and Garrett Stubbs and hit Johan Rojas with a pitch...replaced by Caleb Thielbar who escaped the bases-loaded jam...Thielbar combined with Emilio Pagan to pitch a scoreless eighth inning...hoan Duran pitched a scoreless ninth...the Twins' In support came from Jordan Luplow (solo home run in the first) and Jorge Polanco (two RBI singles in the third and ninth innings).

 Φ Extended his quality start streak to five games, his longest quality start streak as a Twin... went 2-1 with a 2.61 ERA (31.0 IP, 9 ER), four walks and 34 strikeouts in that span.

LIMITING THE LONGBALL: Gray has allowed only five home runs in 25 starts this season, the fewest in baseball among pitchers with at least 15 starts...is one of two pitchers in Twins' history (since 1961) to allow five-or-fewer home runs in his first 25 starts of the year, joining Francisco Liriano (3 HR through first 25 GS in 2010)...his 0.31 home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio is the lowest by a qualified pitcher in Twins' history (1961-) and the lowest by any pitcher in baseball since teammate Dallas Keuchel posted a 0.28 home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio in 2020 with Chicago-AL.

BIG TEX: Gray is looking to avoid extending his two-game losing streak against the Rangers, dating back to July 8, 2022...owns a 5.91 ERA (10.2 IP, 7 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts in those games... is 9-5, 3.17 ERA (105.0 IP, 37 ER) with 32 walks and 89 strikeouts in 17 appearances against Texas (including 16 starts)...last faced the Rangers on August 22, 2022 at Target Field, when he took the 2-1 Twins' defeat after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts; marked his first loss in a quality start in 2022...pitched 4.0 scoreless innings before permitting a home run to Adolis García to lead off the fifth...allowed an RBI single to Corey Seager in the sixth for his final run...is 3-4, 4.06 ERA (51.0 IP, 23 ER) with 13 walks and 45 strikeouts in nine career appearances (8 starts) against the Rangers at home.
Ø Owns the second-lowest ERA against the Ranger since 2014 (min. 15 GS), trailing only Justin Verlander (2.20)...also owns the third-lowest opponent batting average (.235), trailing Félix Hernández (.205) and Verlander (.218).

 THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his

 4-seam fastball the most at 25.9 percent...recorded five of his seven strikeouts using his sweeper in

 his last start on August 19 vs. Pittsburgh...primarily uses his curveball (275 pitches) and changeup

 (142 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (238 pitches), sinker (312 pitches) and sweeper (309 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:
