<b>THE TWINS:</b> After completing their two-game roadtrip in Milwaukee with two losses to the
Brewers, the Twins began their seven-game homestand with consecutive victories over the
Rangers on Thursday and Friday, followed by a loss last nighttoday, they will play the four-
game series finale vs. lexastomorrow night, Minnesota will continue the homestand with
the first of three vs. Cleveland through Wednesday afternoonthe Twins have gone 38-27 at
home and 29-36 on the road.

ক Of the Twins' 32 cm aining games, they have an opponent winning percentage of .463, the third-lowest strength of schedule in Major League Baseball.

NINTH INNING UNKIND TO TWINS: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night at Target Field by a score of 6-2...Joe Ryan made his return from the 15-day Injured List, allowing one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Griffin Jax (5-8) was issued the loss, allowing four runs in the top of the ninth inning...the offense recorded five hits, two from both Jorge Polanco and Max Kepler, who each drove in a run...Polanco hit his ninth home run of the season.

RANGER THINGS: The Twins and Rangers are playing each other today for the fourth of seven meetings in 2023...these two will meet again for a three-game series at Globe Life Field from September 1-3...the Twins went 1-2 at GLF last season from July 8-10.

◆ Since the start of 2021, 14 of 17 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while eight games have been decided by one run.

◆ Carlos Correa has 21 career home runs vs. the Rangers (101 games), his most against any opponent...21 homers are the fifth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), George Springer (28), Jose Altuve (27) and Nelson Cruz (23).

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 20th series victory this season...they are 19-17-5 in series play in 2023, going 11-6-3 at home and 8-11-2 on the road.

◆ Entering today, the Twins have gone 9-6-2 in their last 17 series, dating back to their June 23-25 series at Detroit.

◆ A win today and the Twins would win their first series over the Rangers since sweeping them in three games from June 18-20, 2021 at Globe Life Field...they are 0-2-0 since.

MICHAEL A. TATER: Michael A. Taylor is back in the lineup today after missing the last two games with a tight hamstring...he homered twice on Thursday night, giving him 19 on the season, which tied his single-season career high, done in 2017 with Washington...he has homered seven times in 18 games this month...he ranks tied for seventh in the AL in homers in August and tied for third most among AL outfielders.

Taylor is the fourth player in club history (since 1961) with at least 19 home runs as a centerfielder:

THE SHOW-RREA: Carlos Correa has reached base safely in a season high 17-straight games, since August 5...since that date, he is hitting .276 (16-for-58) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 10 walks, a .386 on-base percentage, a .534 slugging percentage and a .920 OPS. 
◆ Correa's 17-game on-base streak is tied for the fourth longest of his career...his career long is 27, done from June 10-July 15, 2017 with Houston.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have hit 66 home runs since the All-Star break, tied with Seattle for second most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (74)...on the season, they have homered 181 times, third most in the AL and fifth most in baseball.

◆ Twins have 24 homers in their last 14 games, averaging 1.7-per-game in that span... additionally, they have homered 13 times in their last five games.

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Since the All-Star break, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .342 (27-for-79) with four doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI, 10 walks, a .441 on-base percentage, a .620 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS...he has raised his OPS 106 points since the break, going from .778 to .884...since the break, he ranks eighth in baseball in OPS.

© Among all primary catchers in baseball with a minimum of 225 plate appearances, Jeffers ranks first in on-base percentage (.389), batting average (.288) and OPS+ (143.6); second in OPS (.884) and wOBA (.381); third in slugging percentage (.495) and runs created/27 (6.09).

Wins Minor League Weeklys: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder DaShawn Keirsey Jr. and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher David Festa have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

♣ Keirsey, 26, played in five games for the Saints, hitting .412 (7-for-17) with one double one triple, one home run, five RBI, four walks and a 1.289 OPS...the San Diego, California native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Utah.

♣ Festa, 23, made the start on Wednesday at Arkansas, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the Verona, New Jersey native was selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of Seton Hall University.

YOU GUYS KNOW ADAM THIELEN?: It was announced yesterday that the 2023 John Gordon Radio Affiliate of the Year is KDLM (1340AM/93.1 & 96.9 FM) Detroit Lakes...KDLM is one of a handful of affiliates that has been part of the Twins Radio Network since 1961 and is appropriately dubbed "The Station You Can Count On"...on behalf of KDLM, the Minnesota Twins Community Fund will donate a \$5,000 grant to making improvements to Washington Ballpark in Detroit Lakes...the Ballpark was established in 1897 and joined the National Register of Historic Places in 2008...KDLM is one of a cluster of Leighton stations on the Network, and is the first to win the award.

**HIM THOME:** Hall of Famer Jim Thome is celebrating his 53rd birthday today...the last major league game that Thome played on his birthday was in 2011 (with Cleveland) as he hit the 602nd of his 612 career home runs.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 22 at Milwaukee, a 7-3 Twins' defeat at American Family Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR), with a career-high-tying three walks and three strikeouts; has issued career-high walks in back-to-back starts...allowed both runs on a two-run home run to Willy Adames in the first inning...retired 12 of the final 15 batters he faced after the home run; the only hit he allowed was a double to Christian the final 15 batters he faced after the home run; the only hit he allowed was a double to Christian Yelich in the third inning...relieved by Dylan Floro in the sixth inning who permitted five runs on six hits; permitted RBI singles to Mark Canha, Tyrone Taylor and Brice Turang, then Brian Anderson hit a two-run single after Turang stole second...Floro ended the inning after a flyball by Joey Wiemer and a strikeout to Yelich...Oliver Ortega entered the game in the seventh but exited with injury...Cole Sands entered and pitched 1.1 scoreless innings.

The Has seen more success at Target Field than on the road in his career...is 6-4, 3.49 ERA (139.1 IP, 54 ER) with 33 walks and 136 strikeouts in 27 career home starts...in 25 road starts, he is 5-8, 3.81 ERA (127.2 IP, 54 ER) with 22 walks and 127 strikeouts.
