THE TWINS: Completed their four-game series with Texas by going 3-1, winning on Thursday and Friday, losing on Saturday then winning the finale yesterday afternoon...

DIVISION SIGNS: The Twins have gone 23-19 against the AL Central this season, going 3-4 vs. the Guardians, 9-4 vs. the Royals, 6-3 vs. the White Sox and 5-8 vs. the Tigers...

ALSO: After this series, the Twins will have just seven more games against AL Central opponents...they will travel to Cleveland for three September 4-6 and four at Chicago September 14-17.

THE SHOW-RREA: Carlos Correa has reached base safely in a season high 18-straight games, since August 5...since that date, he is hitting .258 (16-for-62) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 12 walks, a .382 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .882 OPS.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins have hit 67 home runs since the All-Star break, third most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (75) and Seattle (68)...

RED HOT ROYCE: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .352 (37-for-105) with a .942 OPS in his last 29 games...

MAX EFFORT: In his last 35 games, since July 17, Max Kepler is hitting .325 (40-for-123) with 12 doubles, nine home runs, 20 RBI, 24 runs scored, 11 walks, a .382 on-base percentage, a .642 slugging percentage and a 1.025 OPS.

- ☞ Making his 16th start and appearance of 2023, and his seventh home start...also his 185th career appearance and 151st start.
- ☞ Facing Cleveland for the first time this season and sixth time in his career; is 3-1, 2.51 ERA (28.2 IP, 8 ER) with five walks and 29 strikeouts in five previous starts vs. the Guardians.
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in the Twins' 8-7, 10-inning loss on August 23 at Milwaukee in 97-degree heat at American Family Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on four hits (1 HR) with two walks and six strikeouts...allowed two runs on two singles, one walk and one hit-by-pitch in the first inning, yielding a two-run single to Andruw Monasterio...surrendered a solo homer to William Contreras in the third inning, then retired eight of the final nine batters he faced...was relieved by Emilio Pagan to start the sixth inning with Minnesota leading 6-3; Twins bullpen surrendered the lead, and the Brewers won on a walk-off infield single by Brice Turang to sweep the two-game series.

- ☞ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in each of his last 11 starts, the second-longest active streak among American League starters (CLE's Tanner Bibee - 12)...Maeda's current streak is his second longest as a Twin (14-start streak allowing 3-or-fewer runs from July 26, 2020 to April 14, 2021).
- ☞ Has yielded at least one home run in seven-consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career...marks the second-longest such streak by a Twin this season (Joe Ryan and Bailey Ober - 8).
- ☞ Marked the fourth-highest gametime temperature in any start in his career and warmest since he started for Los Angeles-NL on July 6, 2018 at Los Angeles-AL with a gametime temperature of 108 degrees.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision on August 16 vs. Detroit in the Twins' 8-7 defeat at Target Field...pitched 4.0 innings plus one batter and allowed three runs on seven hits (season-high 2 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts...struck out the side in the first inning...allowed four hits, including two home runs (Riley Greene, 2-run; Spencer Torkelson, solo), in the third inning...retired the side in order in the top of the fourth inning before yielding a single to Greene to start the fifth, ending his outing; was relieved by Dylan Floro, who did not allow the inherited runner to score...Twins' bullpen allowed five runs in 5.0 innings as Minnesota dropped the two-game series finale.

- ☞ Allowed multiple home runs for the first time this season...last allowed multiple homers on August 3, 2021 at Cincinnati (3 HR)...ended a 16-start streak in which he yielded one-or-fewer homers, his longest as a Twin and second longest of his career (17, September 21, 2017-July 11, 2018).

BRAND NEW MAN: Since being returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) on June 23, Maeda is 3-3 with a 2.91 ERA (58.2 IP, 19 ER), 17 walks, 74 strikeouts and a .210 (44-for-210) opponent batting average in 11 starts...he owns the fourth-lowest opponent batting average and sixth-lowest ERA in the American League in that span (min. 10 GS)...here's how his numbers since June 23 compare to his first four starts this year:

ROCKIN' VS. CLEVELAND: Facing Cleveland for the sixth time in his career...is 3-1, 2.51 ERA (28.2 IP, 8 ER) with five walks, 29 strikeouts and a .192 (20-for-104) opponent batting average in five previous starts vs. the Guardians, all with Minnesota from 2020-21...his 2.51 ERA against Cleveland is his second lowest against any opponent in his career (min. 5 GS), trailing only his 2.20 ERA vs. Miami; his .192 opponent batting average vs. the Guardians is also his second lowest vs. any opponent in his career (Milwaukee - .190)...last faced Cleveland on May 22, 2021, taking a no-decision in the Twins' 5-3 loss at Progressive Field; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed three runs on three hits (1 HR) with one walk and six strikeouts.

CENTRAL COMMANDER: Maeda is 2-3, 3.00 ERA (33.0 IP, 11 ER) with seven walks and 37 strikeouts in six starts vs. American League Central opponents this season...since becoming a Twin in 2020, he is 9-6 against the AL Central with a 3.38 ERA (127.2 IP, 48 ER), 28 walks, 148 strikeouts and a .212 (99-for-468) opponent batting average in 23 starts...his 10.43 strikeouts-per-9.0 inning ratio vs. the AL Central since 2020 is seventh best in baseball in that span (min. 15 GS).

SUMMER BREEZE: In 14 starts in August with the Twins (since 2020), Maeda is 6-3 with a 3.53 ERA (79.0 IP, 31 ER), 16 walks, 88 strikeouts and a .198 (57-for-288) opponent batting average...in 36 career appearances in August (32 starts), he is 14-8, 4.07 ERA (179.0 IP, 81 ER) with 46 walks, 203 strikeouts and a .211 (140-for-663) opponent batting average, the sixth-lowest opponent batting average in baseball since 2016 (min. 30 August starts).

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, mostly using his slider, split finger and 4-seam fastball, throwing the trio 89.9 percent of the time...favors his split finger (219/374 - 58.6%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (262/409 - 64.1%) and sinker (83/83 - 100%) against righties...allowed his first home run on a sinker this season in his last start on August 23 at Milwaukee (W. Contreras)...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

- ☞ Has averaged 91.5 mph on his four-seam fastball in four August starts, a 0.9-mph increase from his four-seam fastball average in his first 11 starts this season (90.6).
- ☞ Opposing hitters are batting just .171 (6-for-35) against Maeda's four-seam fastball in his last seven starts after hitting .423 (11-for-26) off his four-seamer in his first eight starts this season.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow.
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.

FINDING HIS TARGET: Making his seventh home start of the season tonight...is 2-2, 5.57 ERA (32.1 IP, 20 ER) with six walks and 35 strikeouts in six previous starts at Target Field this year...half of his earned runs allowed at home came on April 26 vs. New York-AL (career-high 10 ER allowed)...since that outing, he is 2-0 with a 2.31 ERA (23.1 IP, 6 ER), four walks, 30 strikeouts and a .209 (18-for-86) opponent batting average in four home starts, with the Twins going 3-1 in those games...his 2.31 ERA at home since July 4 is the fifth lowest in the American League in that span (min. 5 GS)...in nine road starts in 2023, he is 1-5, 3.19 ERA (42.1 IP, 15 ER) with 14 walks and 53 strikeouts.

- ☞ In two career home starts vs. Cleveland, Maeda is 2-0, 0.00 ERA (13.0 IP, 0 ER) with three walks and 13 strikeouts; both wins were with Minnesota during the 2020 season.
- ☞ Is 35-21, 3.21 ERA (406.2 IP, 145 ER) with 102 walks and 450 strikeouts in 85 career home appearances (67 starts)...in 99 career road appearances (83 starts), he is 27-27, 4.56 ERA (430.0 IP, 218 ER) with 138 walks and 472 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT: Right-handed hitters are slashing .239/.284/.484 with 48 strikeouts and a .768 OPS against Maeda this year...left-handed hitters are slashing .240/.304/.347 with 40 strikeouts and a .651 OPS...in his last start on August 23 at Milwaukee, righties went 3-for-9 one double, one home run (W. Contreras) and two strikeouts off him; lefties went 1-for-8 with four strikeouts.

- ☞ Righties are batting just .207 (335-for-1618) with a .619 OPS and 547 strikeouts vs. Maeda in his career...owns the third-lowest opponent batting average vs. righties since 2016 (min 750.0 IP), trailing only Max Scherzer (.181) and Jacob deGrom (.203); also ranks sixth in opponent OPS in that span.
- ☞ Lefties are hitting .249 (378-for-1517) with a .737 OPS and 375 strikeouts off Maeda in his career.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2023: 9-6, 3.69 ERA // CAREER: 37-37, 3.88 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is slated to start the middle game of the three-game series against Cleveland tomorrow night at Target Field...did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 24 vs. Texas, allowing five runs on a season-high 10 hits (3 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched as the Twins came from behind to beat the Rangers 7-5 at Target Field...issued one walk, allowed a career-high-tying three homers (done four times previously) and struck out a season-low-tying four batters (also, 4 K on May 15 at Los Angeles-NL); also snapped his career-high 19.0-inning scoreless streak in the first inning, allowing a leadoff homer to Marcus Semien...facing the Guardians for the second time this season and third time in his career; took a no-decision in his last start vs. Cleveland on June 1 at Target Field, a 7-6 Twins' win (5.2 IP, 8 H, 6 R/ER, 1 BB, 5 K)...is 1-0, 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and 11 strikeouts in two career starts vs. the Guardians.

Keuchel, Duran, Thielbar, Pagán and Floro (W 5) all combined to throw 9.0 IP allowing 1 R (unearned) on 5 H w/ 3 BB & 7 K in yesterday's extra inn. win vs. TEX.
 Keuchel pitched in relief for the 12th time in his career in the regular season and first time since October 2, 2021 vs. Detroit with Chicago-A. tossed 5.0 scoreless IP w/ 5 H, 2 BB & 3 K.
 'Pen is 2-1, 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER) w/ 9 H, 2 HR (Kwan x2), 6 BB, 17 K, 1 HLD & 2 SV in 7 G this season vs. CLE...is 2-0, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER), HR (Kwan), 5 BB, 9 K 1 SV in 4 G at home vs. CLE.
 'Pen has thrown 1,335 offspeed pitches, 4th most in baseball trailing NYY (1,787), DET (1,416) & CIN (1,412)...averaging 90.3 mph on all pitches, T-6th-hardest throwing 'pen in MLB (3rd in AL).
 'Pen has T-12th lowest xBA (.233) and 15th lowest wOBA (.306) in MLB...also, MIN relievers have allowed the fewest hits (382) among all MLB bullpens.
 'Jhoan has 4.41 ERA w/ 9.0 K/9.0 IP & .244 BAA in 65 road games, compared to 3.92 ERA w/ 9.1 K/9.0 IP & .229 BAA in 64 home games.
