THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their seven-game homestand, going 3-1 vs. Texas over the weekend, followed by a win over the Guardians last night...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of three vs. Cleveland through tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Texas to begin a six-game road trip with three against the Rangers from September 1-3 and three against the Guardians from September 4-6...the Twins have gone 40-27 at home and 29-36 on the road.
The Twins have gone 19-8 in their last 27 home games, dating back to June 21.
The Twins have gone 14-5 in 19 home games since the All-Star break for a .737 winning percentage, the third best in baseball, trailing Washington (.778 — 14-4) and Los Angeles-NL (.750 — 15-5).
A win tonight would make the Twins seven games over .500, which would be their high-water mark for 2023...the last time they were seven games over was through games of August 19, 2022, when they finished the day 62-55.

BATS BRING THE THUNDER, 'PEN BRINGS THE FUNDER: The Twins beat the Guardians last night by a score of 10-6, giving them four wins in their last five games...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing six runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Kody Funderburk (1-0) was the winner in his major league debut, pitching 2.0 perfect innings, with three strikeouts...Funderburk became the first Twins pitcher to earn the win in his major league debut since Fernando Romero (start) on May 2, 2018 and first to do so in relief since Todd Ritchie on April 3, 1997...Josh Winder pitched 3.0 perfect innings to earn his first career save...Royce Lewis had two of the Twins' 12 hits, including his second grand slam in as many days, the first player in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) to hit grand slams in consecutive games.

ON GUARD: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the ninth of 13 times in 2023...the Twins are 4-4 vs. the Guardians this season, outscoring them 26-24.
Since 2022, 21 of the 27 games have been decided by three runs-or-less and 13 by one run.
Since 2019, Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (39-for-129) with four doubles, nine home runs, 17 RBI, 22 runs scored, 15 walks, a .379 on-base percentage and a .922 OPS in 34 games vs. Cleveland...however, he is just 2-for-19 with one walk this season.
Max Kepler has 22 career home runs vs. Cleveland, his personal most vs. any opponent.

REAL DEAL ROYCE: Royce Lewis joined Ken Griffey Jr. as the only player drafted first overall in baseball history to hit grand slams in consecutive games as Junior did it in April of 1999 (drafted in 1987)...Lewis became the 10th player in baseball history with three grand slams as part of his first 10 career home runs, the others being Dom Dallessandro (1941-42), Russ Derry (1944-45), David Eckstein (2001-02), Brian Johnson (1994-96), Justin Maxwell (2007-12), Brian Roberts (2003-05), Shane Spencer (1998), Jim Tabor (1938-39) and Chris Taylor (2016-17).
After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Lewis has hit .358 (39-for-109) with a .976 OPS in his last 30 games, including seven three-plus-hit games...since the All-Star break, Lewis ranks ninth in the AL in wOBA (.423) and 10th in OPS (1.006).

OTHER ROOKIES THAT RAKE:
Edouard Julien is hitting .315 (39-for-124) with 21 walks, a .415 on-base percentage and a .907 OPS in his last 40 games, since July 8.
Matt Wallner has five doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 25 RBI, 10 walks, a .345 on-base percentage, a .554 slugging percentage and an .899 OPS in his last 39 games.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 21st series victory this season...they are 20-17-5 in series play in 2023, going 12-6-3 at home and 8-11-2 on the road.
Entering today, the Twins have gone 10-6-2 in their last 18 series, dating back to their June 23-25 series at Detroit.
A win tonight would give the Twins their first series victory vs. the Guardians since taking two of three games from May 13-15, 2022 at Target Field...Twins have gone 0-5-1 in head-to-head series play against Cleveland since.

PABLO PAINTING: Pablo López enters today fourth in baseball in strikeouts with 191 (career high), trailing Spencer Strider (236), Kevin Gausman (202) and Blake Snell (193)...he is on pace to strike out 234 batters, which would land him in a tie with Dean Chance (1968) for seventh on the Twins' single-season all-time list...the top six are Johan Santana — 265 in 2004, Bert Blyleven — 258 in 1973, Blyleven — 249 in 1974, Santana — 245 in 2006, Santana — 238 in 2005 and Santana — 235 in 2007...the last Twin with 200+ strikeouts was José Berrios with 202 in 2018.

NOT AT THE TABLE, CARLOS: Carlos Correa has reached base safely in a season high 19-straight games, since August 5...since that date, he is hitting .258 (17-for-66) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 13 walks, a .383 on-base percentage, a .485 slugging percentage and an .868 OPS.
Correa's 19-game on-base streak is the third-longest of his career...his career long is 27, done from June 10-July 15, 2017 with Houston...his second-longest streak is 20, done September 13-October 3, 2022.
Correa's streak is the second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Kerry Carpenter's 24.

LAND OF 10,000 RAKES: The Twins hit three more home runs last night, giving them 70 home runs since the All-Star break, tied with Seattle for second-most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (77)...on the season, they have homered 185 times, third most in the AL and fifth most in baseball...Twins have homered in seven-straight games, hitting 17 in that span...their season-long for a homer streak is 18, done from April 18-May 6.

UNLOCKING POLANCO: Jorge Polanco has multiple hits in three-straight games, hitting two home runs with five RBI in that span...he has reached safely in seven-straight games, hitting .360 (9-for-25) with a 1.088 OPS...additionally, in his last 15 games, since August 11, he is hitting .333 (18-for-54) with four home runs, 14 RBI, eight walks, a .415 on-base percentage, a .574 slugging percentage and a .989 OPS.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision on August 24 vs. Texas, a 7-5 Twins' win at Target Field...allowed five runs on a season-high 10 hits (season-high-tying 3 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...snapped his career-high 19.0-inning scoreless streak by allowing a leadoff homer to Marcus Semien in the top of the first, the first time he has yielded a leadoff homer this year (6th of career)...surrendered solo homers to Corey Seager in the third inning and Leody Taveras in the fourth...was lifted after 5.0 innings for the first time since July 20 at Seattle...Twins bullpen tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, and Minnesota came from behind to take the four-game series opener.

☞ Allowed three home runs for the second time this season, also doing so on May 15 at Los Angeles-NL...also allowed 10-or-more hits for the fourth time in his career and first time since September 10, 2022 vs. New York-NL.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Won his fourth-consecutive start on August 18 vs. Pittsburgh, a 5-1 Twins' victory at Target Field...pitched 6.0 scoreless innings with six hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...allowed leadoff baserunners in four of his first 5.0 innings pitched but did not yield a run...stranded six runners in scoring position in his start, with opposing batters going 0-for-10 with five strikeouts with runners in scoring position...was relieved by Caleb Thielbar in the top of the seventh inning; four Twins' relievers held the Pirates to one run as Minnesota won the three-game series opener.

☞ Won four-straight starts for the first time in his career...his four-game win streak is tied for the longest of his career (4-0 in 7 GS from July 6, 2021-April 27, 2022 with Miami).

**ON GUARD:** Facing Cleveland for the second time this season and third time in his career...is 1-0, 4.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and 11 strikeouts in two previous starts vs. the Guardians...took a no-decision in his last start against Cleveland on June 1 at Target Field, a 7-6 Twins' win; pitched 5.2 innings and allowed six runs on eight hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...allowed one run through 5.0 innings, then allowed five runs on six singles in the top of the sixth before being relieved by Emilio Pagan; three of the six singles had an exit velocity under 95.0 mph and Will Brennan's single had an expected batting average of .090, according to Statcast.

**DIVISIONAL DOMINANCE:** López is 4-1, 3.19 ERA (53.2 IP, 19 ER) with eight walks and 68 strikeouts in eight starts against the American League Central division this year...has recorded a quality start in five of those eight outings, and the Twins have gone 7-1 in those eight games...over his career, he is 5-2, 2.85 ERA (66.1 IP, 21 ER) with 10 walks and 80 strikeouts in 10 starts vs. the AL Central...his career 0.95 WHIP against the AL Central ranks seventh in baseball since 2019 (min. 10 GS), while his 10.95 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ranks ninth in that span.

**TARGET ACQUIRED:** Making his third-straight home start tonight...in 12 home starts this season, López is 4-2, 4.62 ERA (74.0 IP, 38 ER) with 20 walks and 91 strikeouts...Twins are 9-3 in his 12 starts at Target Field in 2023...here are his numbers in his last six home starts compared to his first six:

☞ In 62 career home starts, he is 18-17, 3.70 ERA (358.0 IP, 147 ER) with 99 walks and 359 strikeouts...is 19-20, 4.08 ERA (310.2 IP, 141 ER) with 83 walks and 321 strikeouts in 58 career road starts.

**RIGHT ON:** López has limited right-handed hitters to a .204 (62-for-304) batting average this season, with righties going 3-for-11 with one home run (M. Semien) and two strikeouts against him in his last start on August 24 vs. Texas...his 111 strikeouts against righties are the sixth most in the American League this year...his .204 opponent batting average vs. righties this season ranks seventh in the AL (min. 20 GS)...left-handed hitters are batting .265 (78-for-294) against him in 2023, going 7-for-13 with two home runs (C. Seager & L. Taveras) and two strikeouts against him in his last outing.

☞ Has better career numbers against righties (.648 OPS) than lefties (.745 OPS).

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Has used a five-pitch mix in 2023, per Baseball Savant...has primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed hitters, favoring his changeup and curveball against left-handed hitters...allowed two home runs on his changeup in his last start on August 24 vs. Texas (M. Semien & C. Seager); marked the second time in his career that he allowed two homers on the pitch (also, July 25 vs. Seattle)...here is a look at his 2023 arsenal:

☞ López has an average fastball velocity of 94.8 mph this year, a 2.1 mph increase from last season.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SONNY GRAY (2023: 7-6, 3.06 ERA // CAREER: 97-83, 3.51 ERA)**

Right-hander Sonny Gray is set to start the three-game series finale against Cleveland tomorrow afternoon...earned the win in his last start on August 25 vs. Texas, a 12-2 Twins' victory at Target Field; pitched a season-high-tying 7.0 innings and allowed one run on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and four strikeouts...facing the Guardians for the third time this season and 18th time in his career...in two starts vs. Cleveland this year, he is 0-1, 4.63 ERA (11.2 IP, 6 ER) with three walks and eight strikeouts; took a no-decision in the Twins' 4-3 loss at Cleveland on May 6 and suffered the loss on June 3 at Target Field, a 4-2 Twins' defeat...is 3-2, 2.82 ERA (44.2 IP, 14 ER) with seven walks and 45 strikeouts in his last seven starts overall; has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in each of those starts.
