THE TWINS: Have gone 1-4 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, getting swept in three games in Kansas City last weekend, followed by a split of the first two games in St. Louis...tonight, Minnesota will complete the trip and series with the third of three at Busch Stadium against the Cardinals...after tonight's game, the Twins will travel back to Minneapolis to play a three-game homestand/weekend series with the Arizona Diamondbacks...they will hit the road again after the Arizona series and play a seven-game roadtrip with stops in Detroit (August 7-10) and Philadelphia (August 11-13)...the Twins have gone 30-24 at home and 25-30 on the road.
The Twins are 1-6 in their last seven games after going 9-2 in their first 11 coming out of the All-Star break.

RYAN CAN'T TURN DOWN VOLUME ON FIREWORKS: The Twins lost to the Cardinals last night at Busch Stadium by a score of 7-3. Joe Ryan (9-8) was the starter and loser, allowing seven runs on nine hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and four strikeouts...he allowed four home runs on the night, three coming in the second inning, accounting for all his runs allowed...Josh Winder pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in relief...the offense recorded just four hits on the night and were held hitless until a Michael A. Taylor sixth-inning single...Matt Wallner drove in all three runs for Minnesota with a three-run homer in the seventh inning.

SHOW ME STATE OF MIND: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other in the regular season for the 36th time in their regular season history...Twins will host the Cardinals in 2024 for a three-game weekend series at Target Field from August 23-25...twins are 18-17 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997) and 10-5 in their last 15...they were 2-7 all-time in the regular season at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 7-7 all-time at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23).
Donovan Solano is slashing .333/.368/.352 in 18 career games at Busch Stadium.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE: The Twins have gone 11-14 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta and 1-1 at St. Louis.
After this series, Minnesota's remaining 2023 IL schedule includes Target Field visits from the Diamondbacks (August 4-6), Pirates (August 18-20) and Mets (September 8-10)...the Twins will also play road games at Phillies (August 11-13), Brewers (August 22-23), Reds (September 18-20) and Rockies (September 29-October 1).
Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 12 of 13 Interleague games this season, hitting .294 (15-for-51) with four doubles, three home runs, five RBI, five walks, and a .906 OPS...he has reached safely in seven of his last 17 plate appearances in IL Play (5 hits, 2 walks).

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 16th series victory this season...they are 15-15-4 in series play in 2023, going 9-6-2 at home and 6-9-2 on the road.
Twins are 6-3-3 all-time vs. the Cardinals in series play...their last series victory over St. Louis was a two-game sweep at Target Field from July 28-29, 2020...their last series win at Busch Stadium came in a two-game sweep from May 7-8, 2018.
Entering today, the Twins have gone 5-4-1 in their last 10 series, dating back to their June 23-25 series at Detroit.

THE LEFTORNIUM: Today marks the 24th time this season Minnesota has faced a lefty starter...Twins are 11-12 when a left-hander is the opposing starter...the Twins have faced three left-handed starters since the All-Star break: Oakland's Ken Waldichuk (5-4 win on 7/14), Oakland's JP Sears (5-4 win on 7/16) and Kansas City's Ryan Yarbrough (2-1 loss on 7/30).
The Twins have the lowest batting average (.219) and lowest OPS (.657) vs. lefties in baseball.

RATED ROOKIE: Edouard Julien is hitting .317 (40-for-126) with nine doubles, one triple, six home runs, 10 RBI, 22 runs scored, 18 walks, a .404 on-base percentage and a .952 OPS in 41 games since June 10.
Among all major league rookies with a minimum of 200 plate appearances, Julien ranks second in OPS (.889), and third in batting average (.287), on-base percentage (.373) and slugging percentage (.516).

MAD MAX, FURY ROAD: In 15 road games since June 30, Max Kepler is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with four doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, four walks, a .368 on-base percentage, a .635 slugging percentage and a 1.003 OPS.

NEXT LEVEL JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in each of his last nine games with a plate appearance (career-best)...in his last 19 games, Jeffers is hitting .377 (23-for-61) with four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, nine runs scored, seven walks, a .449 on-base percentage, a .541 slugging percentage and a .990 OPS.
Among primary catchers with a minimum of 175 plate appearances, his .829 OPS ranks third in all of baseball, trailing Atlanta's Sean Murphy (.902) and Los Angeles-NL's Will Smith (.853).

HEART AND HUSTLE: The MLBPA announced the 30 preliminary winners of the 2023 Heart and Hustle Award earlier today...this year's Twins winner is right-handed pitcher Pablo López...the award honors active players who demonstrate a passion for the game and best embody the values, spirit and traditions of the game...the Heart and Hustle Award is the only award in MLB that is voted on by former players...the overall winner will be announced in mid-November.

THROWBACK THURSDAY: Bally Sports North TV analyst Roy Smalley never played any regular season games in his career vs. the Cardinals, but played in four of the 1987 World Series games...in the series, he went 1-for-2 with a double and two walks in four plate appearances...he appeared in Game 4 and Game 5 at old Busch Stadium as a pinch hitter, reaching on an E3 in Game 4 and drawing a walk in Game 5.
Due to the scheduling format at the time, the Cardinals were the only National League team that Smalley played against in his 13-year career.

OH JEEZ, YA KNOW, THAT'S PRETTY COOL: Prior to Saturday's game against Arizona, the Twins will formally enshrine club legend Joe Mauer as the 38th member of the Twins Hall of Fame...the St. Paul, Minnesota native and former number one overall selection in the 2001 First-Year Player Draft played 15 seasons for the Twins from 2004-18.

- ☞ Looking for his first win since April 30 vs. Kansas City...his 15-game winless streak is the longest of his career...owns the third-longest winless streak in Twins' history (since 1961).
- ☞ Facing St. Louis for the first time since September 12, 2021...is 2-5, 5.74 ERA (42.1 IP, 27 ER) with 19 walks and 44 strikeouts in his previous nine starts.
- ☞ Acquired by the Twins on March 13, 2022 in a trade with the Cincinnati Reds, along with right-handed pitcher Francis Peguero, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Chase Petty.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start on July 28 against Kansas City at Kauffman Stadium...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts in a 10-inning 8-5 Twins' defeat...picked off Bobby Witt Jr. at first base after allowing a single in the first inning...tossed a 1-2-3 second inning...yielded a solo home run to Kyle Isbel to lead off the third inning, marked the first home run Gray has allowed to a Royals batter since August 1, 2014 (Raúl Ibáñez), snapping a 73.2 IP homerless streak...pitched 1-2-3 fourth and fifth innings...permitted an RBI double to Witt Jr. and an RBI single to MJ Melendez in the sixth inning...relieved by Emilio Pagan in the seventh inning...Dylan Floro replaced Jovani Moran in the eighth inning in his Twins debut; allowed an RBI single to Witt Jr. (run charged to Moran)...Griffin Jax pitched a scoreless ninth inning...Joan Duran entered in the 10th inning and yielded a walk-off grand slam to Witt Jr.

- ☞ Gray extended his career-long winless streak to 15 starts, last earning a victory on April 30 vs. Kansas City; owns the third-longest winless streak by a starter in Twins history (1961-), behind only Roger Erickson (17; September 19, 1978-August 15, 1979) and Liam Hendriks (17; September 6, 2011-September 13, 2012).
- ☞ Allowed more than two runs against Kansas City for the first time since April 17, 2015 (4 runs), snapping a streak of nine-consecutive starts vs. the Royals in which he pitched at least 5.0 innings and allowed two-or-fewer runs...tied Nolan Ryan (September 21, 1972-July 25, 1974) for the third-longest streak, trailing Teddy Higuera (10 starts, June 5, 1985-June 22, 1989) and Roger Clemens (11 starts, August 21, 1984-April 8, 1989).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start on July 22 against Chicago-AL at Target Field...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two runs on seven hits, with one walk and four strikeouts in a 3-2 Twins' victory, opposite Dylan Cease...worked around a pair of singles to Andrew Benintendi and Eloy Jiménez, and a walk to Yasmani Grandal to complete a scoreless first inning...tossed a 1-2-3 second inning...allowed both runs in the third inning after yielding one-out singles to Tim Anderson and Luis Robert Jr., who then executed a double steal of home and second to get the White Sox on the board; Grandal then singled home Robert Jr. for the second run...relieved by Jordan Balazovic in the seventh inning as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins completed their 23rd come-from-behind win of the season in the seventh inning via an RBI double by Christian Vázquez and an RBI single from Michael A. Taylor (both off Gregory Santos).

AGAINST ST. LOUIS: Gray is facing St. Louis for the 10th time in his career, going 2-5, 5.74 ERA (42.1 IP, 27 ER) with 19 walks and 44 strikeouts in his nine prior starts...last faced the Cardinals on September 12, 2021 at Busch Stadium, when he took the 2-0 Cincinnati loss after pitching 7.0 innings and allowing two runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts...his lone blemish was in the first inning on a two-run home run by Nolan Arenado...retired 19 of the 21 batters he faced after the home run...relieved by Tony Santillan in the eighth who pitched a 1-2-3 inning.

- ☞ Owns the fourth-lowest opponent batting average (.228) against the Cardinals since 2019 (min. 8 GS).
- ☞ Tonight is his fifth Interleague start of the season (May 12 vs. Chicago-NL, May 17 at Los Angeles-NL, May 23 vs. San Francisco and June 26 at Atlanta)...is 0-1, 3.43 ERA (21.0 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks and 24 strikeouts in his prior four starts, taking the loss at Atlanta...is 1-1, 3.28 ERA (35.2 IP, 13 ER) with 14 walks and 38 strikeouts in seven Interleague starts since joining the Twins.

ON THE ROAD: Gray is making his 11th road start of the season; is 1-2, 3.48 ERA (54.1 IP, 21 ER) with 25 walks and 48 strikeouts in his 10 prior road outings...is 5-5, 3.55 ERA (106.1 IP, 42 ER) with 36 walks and 87 strikeouts in 21 road starts since becoming a Twin.

- ☞ Looking for his first win at Busch Stadium...is 0-3, 3.49 ERA (28.1 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks and 27 strikeouts in five career starts at St. Louis...owns the fifth-lowest opponent OPS (.609) and sixth-lowest opponent batting average (.202) at Busch Stadium since 2019 (min. 5 GS).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his 4-seam fastball the most at 24.1 percent...recorded all five strikeouts using his sweeper in his last start on July 28 at Kansas City...allowed his fourth home run of the season on a fastball...primarily uses his curveball (244 pitches) and changeup (118 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (216 pitches), sinker (278 pitches) and sweeper (275 pitches) against righties...here's a look at his repertoire so far:

- ☞ Owns a .202 (69-for-341) opponent batting average across all of his secondary pitches (curveball, sweeper, sinker, cutter and changeup).
- ☞ His 57 strikeouts on his sweeper are the second most in the majors, behind LAA's Shohei Ohtani (66).

TOMORROW'S STARTER -BAILEY OBER (2023 SEASON: 6-5, 3.19 ERA // CAREER: 11-11, 3.57 ERA)

Right-hander Bailey Ober is slated to start in the three-game series opener against the Arizona Diamondbacks at Target Field tomorrow night...took his fifth loss of the season and snapped his seven-game quality start streak in the 10-7 Twins' defeat at Kansas City on July 29...pitched a season-low 4.0 innings and allowed a career-high six runs on a career-high 11 hits (2 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts...is due to face the Diamondbacks for the first time in his career...Arizona will be the 19th team he has faced since his debut on May 18, 2021...is 4-4, 3.80 ERA (90.0 IP, 38 ER) with 21 walks and 90 strikeouts in 18 previous starts when facing a new opponent...making his sixth Interleague start of the season...is 3-1, 3.45 ERA (28.2 IP, 11 ER) with eight walks and 25 strikeouts in his five previous Interleague starts this season...is 3-1, 3.89 ERA (37.0 IP, 16 ER) with 11 walks and 33 strikeouts in seven career Interleague starts.
