THE TWINS: After completing their three-game homestand/weekend series with a three-game series sweep of the Diamondbacks, the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip by splitting the first two games in Detroit over the last two nights...tonight, the Twins will continue the series and trip with the third of four at Comerica Park...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, they will travel to Philadelphia for three against the Phillies over the weekend...the Twins have gone 33-24 at home and 27-31 on the road.
The Twins are 15-9 since the All-Star break, tied for fifth-most wins in baseball in that span.
Minnesota enters the day with a 4.5 game lead over Cleveland in the AL Central, the biggest division lead in the AL.

TWINS SHUT DOWN IN MOTOWN: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Comerica Park by a score of 6-0, suffering their eighth shutout of the season, seven of which have come on the road...Sonny Gray (5-5) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs (2 earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and 10 strikeouts...for Gray, it marked his 14th career game with double-digit strikeout totals and three short of his career high (13 on 4/7 vs. HOU)...the offense recorded six hits, went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position and left eight men on base...Carlos Correa reached three times, going 2-for-3 with one walk.

THE 10-SPOT: Sonny Gray's 10 strikeouts last night gave the Twins their 10th game this season when the starter reaches double-digit strikeout totals, tied for fifth most in club history.

MORE ON THE STARTERS: Twins starters have struck out an MLB-best 712 batters and are on pace to strike out 1,002 hitters this season, which would shatter the club record of 870, done in 1967...in fact, just seven starting staffs in baseball history have struck out 1,000-plus batters: 2018 Astros (1,101), 2017 Guardians (1,066), 2018 Guardians (1,066), 2019 Astros (1,063), 2017 Nationals (1,012), 2019 Nationals (1,010) and 2017 Red Sox (1,001).
Their 712 strikeouts already rank as the ninth most in club history...next is the 2006 staff that had 714 (chart lower right).

ONE MORE TIME FOR THE STARTERS: Sonny Gray gave the Twins their MLB-best 58th quality start last night...Twins starters have combined to go 34-35, 3.82 ERA (650.0 IP, 276 ER) with 162 walks, 712 strikeouts and a .238 opponent batting average...below are Twins starting pitching ranks among the other MLB teams:

MOTOR CITY MATCHUP: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 10th of 13 meetings in 2023...the Twins have gone 4-5 vs. Detroit this season, going 1-3 at Target Field and 3-2 at Comerica Park.
Carlos Correa is hitting .321 (27-for-84) with six doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI and a .916 OPS in his last 21 games vs. the Tigers...in his last 16 games at Comerica Park, he is hitting .369 (24-for-65) with two doubles, one triple, six home runs, 18 RBI, 11 runs scored, a .408 on-base percentage and a 1.116 OPS in that span.
Jorge Polanco has hit safely in seven-straight games vs. the Tigers...he is a career .294 (116-for-394) hitter with 22 doubles, four triples, 12 home runs, 55 RBI, 30 walks, 53 runs scored and an .807 OPS in 101 games against the Tigers...in 52 career games at Comerica, he is hitting .300 (61-for-203) with 11 doubles, one triple, six home runs, 21 RBI, 29 runs scored and an .805 OPS.

MASTER JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in each of his last 14 games with a plate appearance (career best)...it marks the longest streak for a Twin this season and longest since Jorge Polanco's 14-game hitting streak from May 27-June 13, 2019...also the third-longest active streak in baseball, behind Mookie Betts (15) and Ha-Seong Kim (14).
During the current streak, Jeffers is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with two doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, six walks, a .472 on-base percentage, a .761 slugging percentage and a 1.233 OPS.
Among primary catchers with a minimum of 200 plate appearances, his .895 OPS ranks second in all of baseball, trailing only Atlanta's Sean Murphy (.903).

MAXIN' OUT: Max Kepler has six hits in his last 16 at-bats, including three home runs and four RBI in that span...in his last 23 games, since July 14, Kepler is hitting .313 (26-for-83) with six doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, 18 runs scored, five walks, a .356 on-base percentage, a .602 slugging percentage and a .958 OPS.
In his last 17 road games, Kepler is slashing .316/.365/.596 with 10 RBI.

C4 IGNITING: Carlos Correa has hit safely in each of his last four games, hitting .429 (6-for-14) with a 1.181 OPS and seven RBI in that span...one year ago, Correa went 1-for-4 at Los Angeles-NL, which began an eight-game hitting streak...from August 9, 2022 through the end of the 2022 season, Correa hit .333 (67-for-201) with a .926 OPS, nine home runs, 27 RBI and reached base safely in 45 of his 52 final games...he also had 19 multi-hit games in that span.

WONDER WALL: Since his recall from Triple-A St. Paul in mid-July, Matt Wallner has posted an OPS of .853 (.316 OBP/.537 SLG), including six home runs and 12 RBI in 21 games...in fact, since July 25, he has 12 RBI, which is tied for fourth most in the AL since that date...his .698 slugging percentage in that span ranks fifth.

RATED ROOKIE: Edouard Julien has reached base safely in seven of his last 10 plate appearances (4 hits, 3 walks)...among all major league rookies with a minimum of 200 plate appearances, Julien ranks first in OPS (.897) and on-base percentage (.387), third in batting average (.297) and fourth in slugging percentage (.510).

- ☞ Facing the Tigers for the second time this season and the sixth time in his career...is 1-1, 5.40 ERA (25.0 IP, 15 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in his five previous starts.
- ☞ Began the season with Triple-A St. Paul and was recalled when Kenta Maeda landed on the 15-day Injured List on April 29...since being inserted into the rotation, the Twins have gone 11-7 in his 18 starts.
- ☞ Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 4 vs. Arizona, a 3-2 Twins' victory...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on six hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...tossed a career-high 104 pitches, passing his previous high of 102 done on May 16 at Los Angeles-NL...allowed a solo home run to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. in the second inning...yielded an RBI single to Jose Herrera in the fourth inning...pitched a 1-2-3 fifth inning to end his outing...relieved by Dylan Floro in the sixth as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings...the Twins tied the game in the bottom of the sixth inning with a solo home run by Max Kepler and took the lead in the seventh on a solo shot by Michael A. Taylor.

- ☞ Has not issued a walk in a career-high four-consecutive starts... owns the second-longest active streak among starting pitchers, trailing San Francisco's Ross Stripling and Scott Alexander (5)...became the 10th individual Twins starter to issue zero walks through at least four consecutive starts.
- ☞ Has yielded six home runs in his last four starts, tying his career high over a four-game span (also, June 22-July 10, 2021 and June 30-July 20, 2021).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his fifth loss of the season and snapped his seven-consecutive quality start streak on July 29 at Kansas City, a 10-7 Twins' defeat...pitched a season-low 4.0 innings and allowed a career-high six runs on a career-high 11 hits (2 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts; snapped a 10-game streak of allowing three-or-fewer earned runs...marked his shortest outing since May 27, 2022 vs. Kansas City (3.0 IP)...allowed solo homers to Bobby Witt Jr. in the first inning and Michael Massey in the second inning; marked the fifth time this year he has permitted two homers in a start (May 11 vs. San Diego, June 14 vs. Milwaukee, June 20 vs. Boston and July 23 vs. Chicago-AL)...also yielded a sacrifice fly to Maikel Garcia and an RBI single to Witt Jr. in the second inning...permitted a two-run single to Kyle Isbel in the third...relieved by Jordan Balazovic in the fifth inning who allowed one run over 2.0 IP (RBI single by Salvador Perez)...Jovani Moran entered in the seventh inning and allowed an RBI triple to Drew Waters...replaced by Josh Winder who yielded an RBI single to Garcia (charged to Moran) and an RBI triple to Witt Jr...Winder then pitched a scoreless eighth inning.

AGAINST DETROIT: Facing the Tigers for the second time this season and the sixth in his career tonight...last faced Detroit on June 25 at Comerica Park, a 6-3 Twins' victory; did not factor into the decision after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing three runs on five hits with one walk and a season-high-tying eight strikeouts...permitted all runs in the third inning on a two-run double to Zach McKinstry and an RBI single to Kerry Carpenter...is 1-1, 5.40 ERA (25.0 IP, 15 ER) with five walks and 24 strikeouts in his five previous career starts against the Tigers; the Twins are 4-1 in those starts...is 1-1, 3.12 ERA (34.2 IP, 12 ER) with four walks and 34 strikeouts in six starts against the AL Central this season.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Ober is making his eighth road start of 2023 tonight...Twins have won five of his seven road starts this year, with Ober going 4-2, 3.48 ERA (41.1 IP, 16 ER) with five walks, 45 strikeouts and five quality starts...tied with Kansas City's Zack Greinke for the least walks issued by an American League starter on the road this season (min. 7 GS)...is 2-3, 3.03 ERA (62.1 IP, 21 ER) with 13 walks and 53 strikeouts in 11 home starts this season.

- ☞ Has seen slightly more success at Target Field than on the road in his career...is 6-4, 3.48 ERA (134.1 IP, 52 ER) with 30 walks and 130 strikeouts in 26 career home starts...in 23 road starts, he is 5-7, 3.67 ERA (117.2 IP, 48 ER) with 18 walks and 115 strikeouts.
- ☞ Making his fourth career start at Comerica Park tonight...is 1-1, 5.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 10 ER) with one walk and 17 strikeouts in his three previous starts...owns the lowest walks-per-9.0-innings ratio (0.5) at Comerica since 2021 (min. 3 GS).

LEFT AND RIGHT: Left-handed hitters are batting .240 (48-for-200) with 44 strikeouts and 13 walks against Ober after 18 starts this season...right-handed hitters are hitting .230 (43-for-187) with 54 strikeouts and five walks...lefties went 5-for-13 with one RBI and one strikeout against him in his last start on August 4 vs. Arizona while the only righty to record a hit off Ober was Lourdes Gurriel Jr. with a solo home run...in his career, left-handed hitters are batting .261/318/403 with 102 strikeouts against Ober...righties are hitting .226/250/438 with 143 strikeouts off him.

- ☞ Owns the 19th-lowest opponent batting average against left-handed hitters among American League pitchers with at least 18 starts this season...also has the ninth-lowest OPS (.635) and 10th-lowest slugging percentage (.340) against lefties this year.

ARSENAL: Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his 18 starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...mostly uses his slider against righties while relying on his changeup and curveball against lefties...threw 60 fastballs in his last start on August 4 vs. Arizona; tied for the most he has thrown in a game in his career (also, July 5, 2021 vs. Chicago-AL)...recorded two of his three strikeouts off his slider...allowed a home run on a changeup for the first time this season...here's a look at his repertoire:

☞ Currently has a run value of 7 on his changeup, tied for the seventh highest in all of baseball (min. 100 plate appearances)...his .231 opponent batting average against his changeup is the eighth lowest in the American League (min. 100 plate appearances).

☞ His .225 opponent batting average across all of his secondary pitches (changeup, slider and curveball) is the 11th lowest in the American League and ranks 26th in baseball (min. 200 plate appearances).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2023: 3-6, 4.22 ERA // CAREER: 62-47, 3.90 ERA)

Kenta Maeda is scheduled to start in the four-game series finale against Detroit tomorrow afternoon at Comerica Park...earned his third win of the season in his last start on August 5 vs. Arizona, a 12-1 Twins' victory; pitched 6.0 innings and allowed one run on just two hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts...facing the Tigers for the 10th time in his career and the second time this season...last faced Detroit on June 23 at Comerica Park in his first start since being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List...earned his first win of the season after pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, issuing two walks and striking eight batters...is 3-2 with a 3.33 ERA (51.1 IP, 19 ER), nine walks and 66 strikeouts in his nine previous starts vs. the Tigers...is 2-2, 2.74 ERA (23.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks and 27 strikeouts in four starts against the American League Central this season...is also 3-2, 2.47 ERA (43.2 IP, 12 ER) with 13 walks and 58 strikeouts in his last eight starts since June 23.

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, setting 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
