**THE TWINS:** Completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 4-3, going 3-1 vs. Texas and 1-2 vs. Cleveland...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game road trip with three against the Rangers over the weekend, followed by three against the Guardians from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 40-29 at home and 29-36 on the road, but have gone just 2-6 in their last eight away from Target Field.

☞ Twins are seeking their 70th win of the season tonight...last season, they won their 70th game on September 13, finishing the season with 78 wins.

**TWINS ONE STRIKE AWAY FROM A W:** The Twins lost to the Guardians on Wednesday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-2 in 10 innings, making them 11-7 in extras this season...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...Jhoan Duran allowed the game-tying run in the top of the ninth inning on a wild pitch, making the Twins 56-1 this season when leading after the eighth inning...Kody Funderburk allowed the go-ahead three-run homer to Kole Calhoun in the top of the 10th...the offense recorded just four hits, two apiece from Jorge Polanco and Donovan Solano...Minnesota went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position, making them 1-for-18 in such instances in the final two games of the series.

**SEPTEMBER EXPANSION:** The Twins have selected the contract of outfielder Andrew Stevenson from Triple-A St. Paul and recalled left-handed pitcher Brent Headrick from the Saints. ☞ Stevenson, 29, has played in 106 games for the Saints this season, hitting .317 (132-for-416) with 23 doubles, seven triples, 16 home runs, 57 RBI, 91 runs scored, 42 walks, 44 stolen bases (49 attempts), a .395 on-base percentage, a .522 slugging percentage and a .916 OPS...the Lafayette, Louisiana native has played in parts of five seasons with the Nationals from 2017-21, hitting .248 (98-for-395) with 18 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 49 RBI, 51 runs scored and a .322 on-base percentage in 248 games.

☞ Headrick, 25, previously appeared in 10 games over three stints with the Twins this season, going 2-0, 6.20 ERA (20.1 IP, 14 ER), nine walks, 26 strikeouts, a 1.38 WHIP and a .247 opponent batting average...in 17 games (12 starts) with St. Paul in 2023, the lefty has gone 4-2, 5.04 ERA (69.2 IP, 39 ER), 24 walks, 77 strikeouts, a 1.36 WHIP, a .263 opponent batting average and a 9.9 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio.

☞ To make room for Stevenson on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred infielder Jose Miranda to the 60-day Injured List...Miranda has been on the 10-day Injured List since July 15 with right shoulder impingement.

**NOTEWORTHY:** Donovan Solano hit .368 (28-for-76) in 22 games last month, third-best in the AL and sixth best in baseball...Royce Lewis had a slugging percentage of .600 last month, 11th best in the AL...Max Kepler had a .616 slugging percentage last month, 10th best in the AL...Kepler's 1.008 OPS in August was the 10th best in the AL.

**RANGER THINGS:** The Twins and Rangers are playing each other tonight for the fifth of seven meetings in 2023...these two met at Target Field last week from Thursday-Sunday (August 24-27) as the Twins won three of four, dropping just game three...they averaged 7.0 runs-per-game during the series.

☞ Since the start of 2021, 15 of 18 games between these two have been decided by three runs-or-fewer, while nine games have been decided by one run.

☞ Carlos Correa has 21 career home runs vs. the Rangers (102 games), his most against any opponent...21 homers are the fifth most among actives, trailing Mike Trout (44), George Springer (28), Jose Altuve (27) and Nelson Cruz (23).

☞ Since the start of 2019, the Twins have scored 5.5 runs-per-game in 24 games against the Rangers...marks the second-most against any AL club in that span, trailing Seattle (5.8).

☞ Notable individuals vs. Texas during the last four-game series: Max Kepler went 6-for-13 (.462) with two doubles, one home run and two walks...Jorge Polanco went 6-for-16 (.375) with a home run and three walks.

**LIVING OUR BEST (GLOBE) LIFE:** The Twins are 4-2 all-time at Globe Life Field, dropping a three-game series 2-1 last season from July 8-10 (winning only the finale) and sweeping the Rangers in three games here from June 18-20, 2021...since the start of 2016, the Twins have a record of 14-6 at Globe Life Field and Globe Life Park combined.

**NO SCHER THING:** The Twins are facing Max Scherzer for the 18th time in his career tonight...Scherzer has gone 9-2, 4.32 ERA (106.1 IP, 51 ER) with 10 quality starts in his previous 17 starts, 16 of which came when Max was a Detroit Tiger...Max's last loss to Minnesota came on September 23, 2012 at Comerica Park as he has gone 6-0 in eight starts since.

**HOW DO YOU SAY 'RED HOT' IN GERMAN:** In his last 38 games, since July 17, Max Kepler is hitting .321 (43-for-134) with 14 doubles, nine home runs, 20 RBI, 25 runs scored, 13 walks, a .383 on-base percentage, a .627 slugging percentage and a 1.009 OPS...additionally, he has seven doubles in his last 11 games.

☞ Since July 17, Kepler has raised his OPS 106 points, from .701 to .807...his .807 OPS is the second-highest of his career (.855 in 2019).

**UNLOCKING POLANCO:** Jorge Polanco has multiple hits in four of his last five games, hitting two doubles and two home runs with seven RBI in that span...he has reached safely in 21 of his last 22 games...additionally, in his last 17 games, since August 11, he is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with four home runs, 16 RBI, 11 walks, a .432 on-base percentage, a .567 slugging percentage and a .999 OPS.

☞ He has a .990 OPS as a left-handed batter since August 11.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1972, Rod Carew stole home with two outs in the 10th inning to give the Twins a 5-4 victory over Cleveland...Carew would steal home 17 times in his career, seven times stealing alone...in 2017, former closer Joe Nathan signed a one-day contract to officially retire as a Minnesota Twin...he is the club's all-time leader in saves (260), ranks 10th on baseball's all-time list with 377 career saves and was inducted into the club's Hall of Fame in 2019...Nathan saved one game in his rookie season as a 24-year-old with San Francisco in 1999 but didn't save his second game until he was 29 in 2004 with the Twins...he ranks fourth all-time in saves among pitchers from age 29-and-older, trailing Mariano Rivera (568), Trevor Hoffman (503) and Dennis Eckersley (387).

- ☞ Making his second start since returning from his rehab assignment and being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on August 26.
- ☞ Facing Texas for the second-straight start and third time in his career; took a no-decision vs. the Rangers in his last start on August 26, a 6-2 Twins' loss (5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 7 K).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision in his return from the 15-day Injured List on August 26 vs. Texas in a 6-2 Twins' defeat...allowed one run on five hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...his lone blemish was a solo homer by former Twin Mitch Garver in the top of the second inning...stranded two runners in scoring position in the second inning, inducing an inning-ending groundout from Leody Taveras...exited after 5.0 innings and a season-low-tying 80 pitches (also, 80 pitches on April 2 at Kansas City) with the score tied 1-1; Griffin Jax allowed four runs in the top of the ninth and Minnesota fell in the third game of the four-game series.

☞ Has allowed at least one home run in eight-straight starts (18 HR total), the longest streak of his career and tied with Bailey Ober and Kenta Maeda (both active streaks) for the longest by a Twin this year...is the sixth pitcher in American League/National League history (since 1901) to allow 18-or-more homers in an eight-game span; first since BAL's Bruce Zimmermann in 2022.

**DO YOU REMEMBER?:** Making his 11th career start in September tonight, his most in any month in his career...is 5-2, 3.09 ERA (55.1 IP, 19 ER) with 17 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .161 (31-for-193) opponent batting average in 10 previous September starts...his .161 opponent batting average in September is his best in any month of his career and is the lowest in baseball since 2021 (min. 10 September GS)...made his major league debut two years ago tonight on September 1, 2021 vs. Chicago-NL (5.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 5 K); also set his single-game career high strikeout total on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL (11 K in 5.0 IP).

**TEXAS TUSSLE:** Facing the Rangers for the second-straight start and third time in his career...will be the second time in his career that he has faced the same opponent in back-to-back starts (also, September 8-14, 2021 against Cleveland)...took a no-decision vs. Texas in his last start on August 26 at Target Field, a 6-2 Twins' loss (see "LAST TIME OUT" note above)...also took the loss despite recording a quality start vs. the Rangers on August 21, 2022, a 7-0 Twins' defeat at Target Field (6.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 6 K).

☞ Making his seventh start of the season against an American League West opponent (HOU - 2, TEX - 1, LAA - 1, OAK - 1, SEA - 1)...is 1-2, 5.70 ERA (30.0 IP, 19 ER) with 12 walks and 46 strikeouts...his 5.77 ERA (53.0 IP, 34 ER) in 11 career starts vs. the AL West is his highest ERA against any AL division in his career.

**ROCKY ROAD:** After winning his first three road starts of the year, Ryan has gone 0-4, 6.25 ERA (40.1 IP, 28 ER) with 11 walks, 46 strikeouts and a .302 (49-for-162) opponent batting average in his last eight road outings...is 3-4 with a 5.01 ERA (59.1 IP, 33 ER), 14 walks and 65 strikeouts in 11 overall road starts in 2023...has recorded seven quality starts on the road this season, with the Twins going 4-3 in those games (1-3 in his other road starts)...has posted better numbers at home this year, going 6-4, 3.77 ERA (71.2 IP, 30 ER) with 13 walks and 94 strikeouts in 12 starts at Target Field in 2023.

☞ Making his first career start at Globe Life Field; will be the 19th different ballpark he has pitched at in his career...is 5-8, 6.00 ERA (90.0 IP, 60 ER) with 23 walks and 97 strikeouts in 18 prior starts when pitching at a new ballpark.

☞ Is 11-8, 4.32 ERA (135.1 IP, 65 ER) with 33 walks and 141 strikeouts in 25 career road starts...in 30 career home starts, he is 13-9, 3.61 ERA (169.1 IP, 68 ER) with 46 walks and 199 strikeouts.

**LEFT OUT:** Left-handed hitters are batting just .211 (49-for-232) with a .618 OPS and 61 strikeouts against Ryan this year...his .618 opponent OPS against left-handed hitters is the 11th lowest in the American League this season (min. 20 GS)...right-handed hitters are batting .270 (74-for-274) with an .818 OPS and 98 strikeouts against Ryan in 2023...his .285 overall opponent on-base percentage in 2023 ranks 11th in the AL (min. 20 GS).

☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .201 (110-for-546) with a .625 OPS against him...his .625 career opponent OPS vs. lefties is the 10th lowest in the AL since his debut (min. 250 at-bats)...righties are hitting .240 (144-for-601) with a .735 OPS off Ryan in his career.
