The Iwins are a season-high eight games over .500 for the first time since July 24, 20 (52-44)....a win today would make them nine games over for the first time since July 2022 (47-38). **ARMED FORCES APPRECIATION DAY:** Today, the Twins will honor veterans and active service-members from all six branches of the military on the 20th annual Armed Forces Appreciation Day presented by Thomson Reuters.

SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Twins beat the Mets yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 8-4, securing the series win, their 23rd of the season (23-18-5)...Kenta Maeda (4-7) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded 13 hits and went 4-for-9 with runners in scoring position...Kyle Farmer and Willi Castro each had three hits as Farmer drove in two runs...one of Castro's three hits was a home run, his sixth of the season...Max Kepler sealed the win with a bases loaded triple in the seventh inning.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have place infielder Jorge Polanco on the Bereavement List...Polanco has played in 68 games for the Twins this season, hitting .260 (66-for-254) with 15 doubles, 12 home runs, 41 RBI, 31 runs scored, 31 walks, a .341 on-base percentage, a .461 slugging percentage and an .802 OPS...to replace Polanco on the 28-man roster, the Iwins have recalled outfielder Gilberto Celestino from Triple-A St. Paul...Celestino has played in 48 games for the Saints this season, hitting .235 (40-for-170) with 10 doubles, two triples, four home runs, 31 RBI, 28 runs scored, 35 walks and a .373 on-base percentage.

MEET THE METS: The Twins and Mets are playing each other for the 25th time in their history this afternoon. Minnesota is 10-14 all-time vs. the Mets, going 3-3 at Shea Stadium, 3-0 at the Metrodome, 2-6 at Citi Field, 2-5 at Target Field... Twins are just 3-10 vs. the Mets dating back to June of 2010... the last and only time the Twins won three-straight over the Mets was the 2004 sweep (see below)...these two will meet in 2024 for three games at Citi Field from July 29-31.

STEP RIGHT UP AND SWEEP THE METS: The Twins are seeking their seventh sweep of the season today, their previous six sweeps were March 30-April 2 at Kansas City (3 games), June 13-14 vs. Milwaukee (2 games), July 3-5 vs. Kansas City (3 games), July 14-16 at Oakland (3 games), July 21-23 vs. Chicago-AL (3 games) and August 4-6 vs. Arizona (3 games)...last season, they swept opponents eight times, all in three games.

The Iwins only sweep of the Mets came in three games at the Metrodome from June 8-10, 2004...the winning pitchers in that series were Juan Rincon, Johan Santana and Grant Balfour.

The Twins are 6-7 when entering the series finale with the opportunity to sweep.

THE NL GUYS: The Twins have gone 21-18 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-2 at Miami, 1-2 vs. Washington, 2-1 vs. San Diego, 2-1 vs. Chicago-NL, 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL, 1-2 vs. San Francisco, 2-0 vs. Milwaukee, 0-3 at Atlanta, 2-1 at St. Louis, 3-0 vs. Arizona, 2-1 at Philadelphia, 2-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 0-2 at Milwaukee and 2-0 vs. New York-NL...the Twins have gone, 10-4 in their last 14 in IL Play and 14-8 in their last 22.

♣ After this series, Minnesota's remaining 2023 IL schedule includes trips to Cincinnati (September 18-20) and Colorado (September 29-October 1).

♣ Max Kepler has 21 career Interleague home runs, tied with Justin Morneau for fourth most in club history, trailing Iorii Hunter (33), Eddie Rosario (23) and Joe Mauer (22).

STRIKE ZONE DEFENSE: Twins pitchers enter today with 1,327 strikeouts on the season, fourth most in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901)...they are on pace to strike out 1,513 hitters this season...the starters have struck out an MLB-best 839 batters and are on pace to strike out 957 hitters this season...below are the pitching staff rankings (left) and starting staff rankings (right) in Twins history:

LIFE OF PABLO: Pablo López enters today fourth in baseball in strikeouts with 199 (career high), trailing Spencer Strider (250), Kevin Gausman (217) and Blake Snell (209)...he is on pace to strike out 227 batters...the last Iwin with 200+ strikeouts was José Berrios with 202 in 2018.

KEP ON KEPPIN' ON: In his last 46 games, since July 17, Max Kepler is hitting .304 (49-for-161) with 15 doubles, nine home runs, 26 RBI, 28 runs scored, 16 walks, a .369 on-base percentage, a .578 slugging percentage and a .946 OPS...since that date, the Twins are 26-20 in Kepler's 46 games played and 20-12 when he gets at least one hit.

◆ Since July 17, Kepler has raised his OPS 93 points, from .701 to .794...his .794 OPS is the second-highest of his career (.855 in 2019).

C4 IGNITING: In eight games since September 1, Carlos Correa has hit .355 (11-for-31) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, three walks, a .429 on-base percentage, a .581 slugging percentage and a 1.009 OPS...last September/October, he hit .355 (44-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, a .412 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS in 31 games.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson and High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez have been named Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Month.

Twins Minor League Weeklys: Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson, 22, made the start on Thursday at Louisville, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts. In his last 10 games (8 starts) for the Saints, SWR has gone 5-1, 2.82 ERA (51.0 IP, 16 ER) with 24 walks, 46 strikeouts and a 1.84 opponent batting average.

Rodriguez, 20, played in four games for the Kernels, hitting .333 (3-for-9) with one triple, three RBI, six walks, a .600 on-base percentage, a .556 slugging percentage and a 1.156 OPS...the Santiago, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Iwins as an international free agent in July of 2019.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 10th victory of 2023 to match his single-season career-high win total (2022) on September 4 at Cleveland in the Twins' 20-6 win at Progressive Field...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed one run on eight hits, with three walks and a season-low three strikeouts...allowed his only run on an RBI triple by José Ramírez in the bottom of the third...escaped a two-on, no-out jam in the sixth inning without allowing a run, retiring Steven Kwan with the bases loaded and two outs to finish his outing...was relieved by Brent Headrick to start the seventh with Minnesota leading 18-1; Twins set season high with 20 runs in the victory, their most since June 13, 2017 vs. Seattle (20-7).

Received a single-game career-high 18 runs of support, the third-most runs of support by any pitcher in 2023 (LAA's Griffin Canning - 24 on June 24 at Colorado; PHI's Zack Wheeler - 19 on July 1 vs. Washington) and the most by a Twin since Francisco Liriano received 19 runs of support on July 26, 2010 at Kansas City.

Has recorded a quality start in 10 of his last 13 outings (2.79 ERA) and has posted 18 quality starts this season, the most on the Twins' staff and tied with TOR's Chris Bassitt, TOR's Kevin Gausman and HOU's Framber Valdez for the second most in the American League this season (NYY's Gerrit Cole leads with 21)...his 18 quality starts are the most by a Twin since José Berríos had 21 in 2019.

TWO STARTS AGO: Recorded a quality start but took the loss on August 29 vs. Cleveland, a 4-2 Twins' defeat at Target Field...allowed three runs (2 earned) on eight hits (1 HR) in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...allowed one run in the second, third and fourth innings, including yielding a solo home run to Bo Naylor in the second...departed after 6.0 innings with Minnesota trailing 3-1; Twins went 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position and dropped the middle game of the three-game series.

STRIKEOUT SAVANT: Ranks second in the American League with 199 strikeouts this year (TOR's Kevin Gausman - 217)...owns a 10.49 strikeouts-per-9.0-innings ratio in 2023, the second highest in Twins history (1961-) among qualified pitchers (Kenta Maeda, 2020 - 10.80)..is one strikeout away from 200 this season; would become eighth Venezuelan-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-) to strike out 200 batters in a season, joining former Twin Johan Santana (2004-08), Carlos Zambrano (2005-06), Félix Hernández (2009-14), Aníbal Sánchez (2011, 2013), Carlos Carrasco (2015, 2017-18), Germán Márquez (2018) and Eduardo Rodriguez (2019)...last Twins pitcher with at least 200 strikeouts in a season was José Berríos in 2018 (202 K).

FAMILIAR FOE: Facing the Mets for the 12th time in his career...is 4-5, 6.32 ERA (57.0 IP, 40 ER) with 16 walks and 50 strikeouts in 11 prior starts vs. New York-NL; 11 starts are his third most against any team in his career (ATL - 14, WAS - 13)...his 6.32 ERA vs. the Mets is his highest vs. any team in his career (min. 3 GS)...faced New York-NL five times last year, going 2-3, 9.53 ERA (22.2 IP, 24 ER) with five walks and 18 strikeouts...earned the win in his last start vs. the Mets on September 27, 2022 at Citi Field, pitching 6.0 innings and allowing three runs on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts.
