The TWING: have gone 2-1 thiough three games on their current six-game nomestand, winning
a three-game series against the Mets over the weekend, taking games one and two tonight,
Minnesota will welcome the Rays for a three-game series through Wednesday afternoonthe
Twins have gone 42-30 at home and 33-38 on the road.
₱ The Twins have gone 16-8 in 24 home games since the All-Star break for a .667 winning
percentage, tied with Baltimore and Milwaukee for second best in baseball, trailing Los
Angeles-AL (.692).

TWINS CAN'T SECURE SUNDAY SWEEP: The Twins were shut out by the Mets yesterday at Target Field by a score of 2-0...it marked the 10th shutout of the Twins this season and second time at home...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 8.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, no walks and 14 strikeouts...Griffin Jax (6-9) was dealt the loss, allowing two runs in the top of the ninth inning...Pablo's 14 strikeouts set a new career-high and he became the third pitcher in Twins history (since 1961) to strike out at least 14 batters and issue zero walks in a start (also, Bert Blyleven – September 24, 1986, 14 K; and Johan Santana – September 19, 2004, 14 K and August 19, 2007, 17 K)... also marked the most strikeouts by a Twins pitcher in a single game since Francisco Liriano struck out 15 on July 13, 2012 vs. Oakland...Minnesota recorded four hits, walked six times and went 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

RIGHT HERE, RIGHT NOW: The Twins' magic number is now 12...they enter today at 75-68 with a 7.5 game lead on Cleveland, who sit at 68-76...below is a brief look at Minnesota and Cleveland:

NOTE: Cleveland has gone 2-6 in their last eight games and 23-31 since the All-Star break, while Minnesota has 6-3 in their last nine and 30-22 since the break.

21-DAY FORECAST: Of the 19 remaining games, the Twins have an opponent winning percentage of .437, tied with Houston for second-lowest strength of schedule in baseball (San Diego - .436)...Tampa Bay (88-56) and Cincinnati (74-71) are the only remaining teams on the schedule with a winning record...Twins also will play Chicago-AL (55-88), Los Angeles-AL (67-77), Oakland (44-99) and Colorado (51-91).

RAY MATTER: The Twins are playing the Rays for the fourth of six times in 2023...these two met at Tropicana Field from June 6-8 as the Twins were swept in three games — the first of five sweeps the Twins have suffered this season.

♣ In that three-game series, the Rays outscored the Twins 13-3...Twins batters went 13-for-93 (.140) and had just five extra-base hits (3 doubles, 2 home runs), while drawing six walks compared to 28 strikeouts.

♣ The Twins are looking to snap a four-game losing streak to the Rays and win over Tampa Bay for the first time since June 11, 2022.

♣ The Twins are 7-3 in their last 10 games against the Rays at Target Field.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .297 (35-for-118) with eight doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI and an .863 OPS in 31 career regular season games against the Rays...he has hit safely in eight of his last nine against Tampa, batting .444 (16-for-36) with a 1.224 OPS in that span.

STRIKE ZONE DEFENSE: Twins pitchers enter today with 1,343 strikeouts on the season, third most in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901)... they are on pace to strike out 1,521 hitters this season...the starters have struck out an MLB-best 853 batters and are on pace to strike out 966 hitters this season...below are the pitching staff rankings (left) and starting staff rankings (right) in Twins history:

KEP ON KEPPIN' ON: In his last 47 games, since July 17, Max Kepler is hitting .297 (49-for-165) with 15 doubles, nine home runs, 26 RBI, 28 runs scored, 16 walks, a .361 on-base percentage, a .564 slugging percentage and a .924 OPS...his slugging percentage and OPS since that date both rank 11th in the AL.

SEPTEMBERS TO REMEMBER: In nine games since September 1, Carlos Correa has hit .343 (12-for-35) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, three walks, a .410 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .982 OPS...last September/October, he hit .355 (44-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, a .412 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS in 31 games.

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis has reached base safely in nine-straight games, two short of his career-high of 11, done from June 15-27...during the current streak, he is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with 12 RBI, a .410 on-base percentage, a .571 slugging percentage and a .982 OPS.
◆ Since August 23, his 24 RBI are tied with Cody Bellinger for the most in baseball since that date...additionally, his seven home runs since that date are tied for fourth-most in baseball.

9/11 - NEVER FORGET: Throughout today's game, the Twins and Rays will join Major League
Baseball and the other 28 clubs in honoring the 22nd anniversary of the tragic events of
September 11, 2001...all on-field caps will have a memorial September 11 silhouette ribbon
patch on the right side...six wreaths will be placed behind the pitcher's mound before the
game, then moved to the flag poles near Gate 34 for the game; each will represent a different
group and commemorate lives lost: One will honor the United States Armed Forces, one will
remember Law Enforcement, one will pay tribute to Firefighters, one will recognize Emergency
Medical Services, one will commemorate American Citizens and one will honor International
F-16s from the Minnesota National Guard's 148th Fighter Wing, based out of Duluth.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision despite recording his 15th quality start of the year in his last start on September 5 at Cleveland...pitched 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on six hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts in an 8-3 Twins' victory...pitched 1-2-3 fist and second innings before surrendering a two-run home run to Bo Naylor in the third...yielded a go-ahead sacrifice fly to Myles Straw in the fifth inning...relieved in the seventh inning by Griffin Jax as the bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings...the Twins took the lead in the eighth inning after a sacrifice fly by Jorge Polanco, Carlos Correa scored and on a wild pitch and Donovan Solano hit a bases-clearing triple.

The Has pitched at least 6.0 innings in nine-straight starts, dating back to July 22...is 3-2, 2.65 ERA (57.2 IP, 17 ER) with two walks and 54 strikeouts in those games...tied for his longest since a nine-start streak from June 25-August 15, 2017 with Oakland and New York-AL (career high is 13 in 2015 with Oakland).

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision in his start on August 30 vs. Cleveland...pitched a INU STARTS AGU: Did not factor into the decision in his start on August 30 vs. Cleveland...pitched a season-high-tying 7.0 shutout innings and allowed just three hits, with zero walks and five strikeouts in a 10-inning 5-2 Twins' defeat...allowed a leadoff double to Steven Kwan, then retired 20 of the next 23 batters he faced...relieved Griffin Jax in the eighth inning and allowed one double...Caleb Thielbar replaced Jax and yielded an RBI single to Kwan...Jhoan Duran entered in the ninth inning and allowed Andrés Giménez to score on a wild pitch to tie the game...Kody Funderburk surrendered a go-ahead three-run home run to Kole Calhoun in the 10th inning.

4 Marked the first time he has pitched 7.0-or-more innings in back-to-back starts since July 3-12, 2019 as a member of the Cincinnati Reds (8.0 IP – July 3 vs. Milwaukee, 7.0 IP – July 12 at Colorado).

HINDERING HOMERS: Has allowed just seven home runs through his 28 starts this season...owns the fewest homers in baseball among pitchers with at least 15 starts...is one of two pitchers in Twins' history (since 1961) to allow six-or-fewer home runs in his first 27 starts of the year, joining Francisco Liriano (4 HR through first 28 GS in 2010)...his **0.34 home runs-per-9.0 inning ratio is the lowest by a qualified pitcher in Twins' history (1961-).**

AGAINST TAMPA: Gray is facing the Rays for the 15th time in his career and for the first time since September 24, 2018...is 4-5, 4.29 (79.2 IP, 38 ER) with 25 walks and 69 strikeouts in his previous 14 appearances (including 12 starts)...earned the 4-1 Yankees' win in his last appearance against Tampa at Tropicana Field after pitching 2.0 relief innings and allowing one run on two hits, with one walk and two strikeouts...entered in the third inning...allowed his lone run on a ground ball double

play by Brandon Lowe.

◆ Took 4-0 Yankees' loss in his last start against Tampa on June 23, 2018 at Tropicana Field...
pitched 6.2 innings and allowed four runs on six hits (1 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts.

WINDS IN THE EAST: Making his seventh start against an American League East team this season... is 1-1, 2.91 ERA (34.0 IP, 11 ER) with 14 walks and 37 strikeouts in his four previous starts...earned the win on April 24 vs. New York-AL...is 1-2, 2.96 ERA (51.2 IP, 17 ER) with 24 walks and 55 strikeouts in 10 starts against the AL East since joining the Twins.

◆ Owns the seventh-lowest ERA against the American League East this season (min. 5 GS)...also owns the 10th-lowest ERA against the AL East since 2022 (min. 10 GS).

THE ARSENAL: Gray has used a six-pitch mix this season, per Baseball Savant...currently uses his four-seam fastball the most at 26.2 percent...used his fastball only against lefties in his last start on September 5 at Cleveland (33 pitches)...recorded three of his four strikeouts using his sweeper in his last start primarily uses his curveball (299 pitches) and changeup (160 pitches) against lefties and his cutter (250 pitches), sinker (347 pitches) and sweeper (340 pitches) against righties... here's a look at his repertoire:
