	a three-game series against the Mets over the weekend, followed by a loss to the Rays last

The Twins have gone 16-9 in 25 home games since the All-Star break for a .640 winning percentage, second best in the AL in that span, trailing just Baltimore (.680 — 17-8).

TAMPA BAY CONTINUES DOMINANCE OVER MINNESOTA: The Twins lost to the Rays last night at Target Field by a score of 7-4...Sonny Gray was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (1 earned) on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched, throwing 89 pitches...the offense recorded six hits, two from Max Kepler, who singled and homered...for Kepler it was his 22nd of the season, breaking a tie with Joey Gallo (21) for team lead...Royce Lewis also homered, hitting a three-run shot in the sixth inning, his 12th of the season.

RIGHT HERE, RIGHT NOW: Despite the Twins loss last night, their magic number moved down to 11 after a Guardians loss to San Francisco...they enter today at 75-69 with a 7.5 game lead on Cleveland, who sit at 68-77...below is a brief look at Minnesota and Cleveland:

NOTE: Cleveland has gone 2-7 in their last nine games and 23-32 since the All-Star break, while Minnesota has gone 6-4 in their last 10 and 30-23 since the break.

20-DAY FORECAST: Of the 18 remaining games, the Twins have an opponent winning percentage of .429, the second-lowest strength of schedule in baseball (San Diego - .425)...Tampa Bay (89-56) and Cincinnati (74-71) are the only remaining teams on the schedule with a winning record...Twins also will play Chicago-AL (55-88), Los Angeles-AL (68-77), Oakland (45-99) and Colorado (51-92).

RAY MATTER: The Twins are playing the Rays for the fifth of six times in 2023...the Twins were swept in three games at Tropicana Field from June 6-8 and lost the series opener last night.

♣ The Twins are looking to snap a five-game losing streak to the Rays and win over Tampa Bay for the first time since June 11, 2022...it marks their longest losing streak to the Rays since dropping 11-straight from April 21, 2012-September 14, 2013.

♣ The Twins are 7-4 in their last 11 games against the Rays at Target Field.

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .287 (35-for-122) with eight doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI and an .836 OPS in 32 career regular season games against the Rays...he has hit safely in eight of his last 10 against Tampa, batting .400 (16-for-40) with eight RBI and a 1.104 OPS in that span.

♣ Since the start of 2019, Max Kepler is hitting .295 (13-for-44) with five doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, 10 walks, a .426 on-base percentage, a .614 slugging percentage and a 1.040 OPS in 14 games against the Rays.

JOE COOL: Joe Ryan was selected by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft and spent parts of four seasons in Tampa Bay's minor league system...the Twins acquired Ryan along with right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman a little over a week before the trade deadline in 2021 (July 22), in exchange for Nelson Cruz and right-handed pitcher Calvin Faucher...at the time of the trade, Ryan was in Tokyo, Japan, participating in the delayed 2020 Olympics as a member of the silver medal winning United States Baseball Team.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: The Twins have gone 21-12 at home since June 21, tied with Baltimore (21-13 — .618) and Texas (18-13 — .581) for the most wins in the AL since that date...their .636 home winning percentage in that span leads the AL.

◆ They are 42-31 at home this season, the sixth-most wins during the Target Field era (since 2010)...they have eight home games remaining...their too five win totals at Target Field are 53-28 in 2010, 49-32 in 2018, and 46-35 in 2022, '19 and '15.

STRIKING SUCCESS: Twins pitchers enter today with 1,351 strikeouts on the season, third most in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901)... they are on pace to strike out 1,519 hitters this season...the starters have struck out an MLB-best 858 batters and are on pace to strike out 965 hitters this season...below are the pitching staff rankings (left) and starting staff rankings (right) in Twins history:

KEPLER KEEPS ON KRUSHING: Since the All-Star break, Max Kepler is hitting .300 (54-for-180) with 15 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 18 walks, a .365 on-base percentage, a .561 slugging percentage and a .926 OPS in 51 games (Twins 29-22 in those games).

◆Among all AL qualified players since the break, he ranks 13th in OPS, 14th in slugging percentage, 15th in batting average and 16th in total bases (101).

ROYCE ROLLS: Royce Lewis has reached base safely in 10-straight games, one short of his career-high of 11, done from June 15-27...during the current streak, he is hitting .333 (13-for-39) with 15 RBI, a .395 on-base percentage, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.011 OPS.

♣ Since August 23, his 27 RBI are the most in baseball...additionally, his eight home runs since that date are tied for fourth-most in baseball with Ronald Acuña Jr., trailing Trea Turner (11), Kyle Schwarber (10) and Julio Rodríguez (9).

♣ Among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 200 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.312), wOBA (.387), OPS (.902), OPS+ (145.5), slugging percentage (.540) and at-bats-per-RBI (4.30).

BARRELS OF FUN: Since August 1, Donovan Solano is hitting .353 (36-for-102) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 15 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage and an .851 OPS in 29 games...in that span he has multiple hits 11 times...since August 1, his .353 batting average is tied for fourth best in baseball (minimum of 90 plate appearances) with Freddie Freeman, trailing Mookie Betts (.413), Julio Rodriguez (.387) and Davis Schneider (.364).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS/BASEBALL HISTORY: In 1986, the Twins replaced manager Ray Miller with Tom Kelly...the Twins won the first game managed by Kelly over the Texas Rangers 4-2 in the Metrodome...TK went on to become the winningest manger in Twins history, going 1140-1244, winning two World Championships ('87 & '91) and had his number 10 retired by the Twins in 2012...additionally, in 1993, Paul Molitor drove in his 100th run of the year in the Blue Jays 4-1 win over California...he became the oldest player in major league history to record his first 100-RBI season.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss on September 6 at Cleveland, a 2-1 Twins' defeat...allowed two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts on 89 pitches...yielded an RBI single to Will Brennan in the bottom of the second inning...recorded two outs in the third before a 66-minute rain delay interrupted the game...came back after the delay and allowed one run (Brennan RBI double in the fourth) in 1.1 innings pitched before being relieved by Louie Varland in the fifth... Twins were limited to two hits and failed to sweep the three-game series.

❖ Allowed multiple stolen bases for the second time this year (also, 2 SB on July 3 vs. Kansas City) and third time in career...his single-game career high is three stolen bases allowed in the second game of a doubleheader on September 7, 2022 at New York-AL.

❖ Did not allow a home run for the first time in his last 10 starts, snapping the longest streak of his career of allowing at least one homer (19 HR in 9-game stretch).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his 10th win of the season in the Twins' 5-1 victory on September 1 at Texas... pitched 6.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts on a season-low 74 pitches...held the Rangers to one hit through 3.0 innings before yielding a solo homer to Corey Seager to lead off the fourth...retired eight of the final 10 batters he faced and was relieved by Griffin Jax to begin the bottom of the seventh...Minnesota won the three-game series opener.

4 Became first Twins pitcher to win 10 games in back-to-back seasons since José Berríos and Kyle Gibson both did it from 2018-19.

RAYS DEBUT: Facing Tampa Bay for the first time in his career...was drafted by the Rays in the seventh round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of California State University, Stanislaus...pitched for five different Tampa Bay affiliates across three seasons from 2018-21 (no MiLB season in 2020), going 15-8, 2.78 ERA (217.0 IP, 67 ER) in 48 games (40 starts)...was traded to Minnesota alongside right-handed pitcher Drew Strotman on July 22, 2021, in exchange for designated hitter Nelson Cruz.

Tampa Bay will be the 22nd team he has faced in his career...is 5-9, 5.80 ERA (104.0 IP, 67 ER) with 40 walks and 96 strikeouts in 21 previous starts when facing a new opponent.

AL EAST BEAST: In 11 career starts against the American League East, Ryan is 5-3, 3.55 ERA (66.0 IP, 26 ER) with 11 walks and 71 strikeouts...seven of his 11 starts against the AL East have been quality, and the Twins own an 8-3 record when he pitches against the division...two of his five career starts with 10-or-more strikeouts have come against AL East teams (April 13, 2023 at New York-AL -10 K; July 9, 2023 vs. Baltimore -- 10 K)...threw his first career complete-game shutout on June 22 vs. Boston (9.0 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K).

© Owns a .217 (54-for-249) career opponent batting average vs. the AL East, the lowest by a Twins pitcher against the division since it was formed in 1969 (min. 10 GS).

TARGET PRACTICE: Making his 13th home start of the season…is 6-4, 3.77 ERA (71.2 IP, 30 ER) with 13 walks and 94 strikeouts in 12 previous starts at home…has recorded five quality starts at Target Field, with the Twins going 4-1 in those starts (only loss was on June 4 vs. Cleveland - 2-1)…is 4-5, 4.67 ERA (69.1 IP, 36 ER) with eight quality starts, 15 walks and 75 strikeouts in 13 road starts this year.
◆ In 30 career home starts, he is 13-9, 3.61 ERA (169.1 IP, 68 ER) with 46 walks and 199 strikeouts... among pitchers with at least 10 career starts at Target Field, Ryan's 10.58 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ratio ranks fourth all-time, behind BOS's Chris Sale (11.65), teammate Pablo López (11.25) and CLE's Lucas Giolito (10.59).
