THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their current six-game homestand, winning a three-game series against the Mets over the weekend...

CASTRO MUSCLES UP LATE, TWINS EVEN SERIES: The Twins beat the Rays last night at Target Field by a score of 3-2, evening the three-game series at 1-1...

WELCOME BACK, POLO: The Twins have reinstated infielder Jorge Polanco from the Bereavement List... Polanco, who was placed on the Bereavement List on Sunday...

POLANCO UNLOCKED: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 16 of his last 17 games, hitting .311 (19-for-61) with three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 12 walks...

CENTRAL FOCUS: After victories from both the Twins and Cleveland last night, Minnesota's magic number now sits at 10... Minnesota enters today at 76-69 with a 7.5 game lead on Cleveland...

NOTE: Cleveland has gone 3-7 in their last 10 games and 23-33 since the All-Star break, while Minnesota has gone 7-4 in their last 11 and 31-23 since the break.

TAMPA TALK: The Twins are playing the Rays for the sixth and final time in 2023... the Twins are 1-4 against the Rays this season...

These two will meet next year for seven games, three at Target Field from June 18-20 and four at Tropicana Field from September 2-5.

The Twins are 8-4 in their last 12 games against the Rays at Target Field.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 24th series victory this season... they are 23-18-5 in series play in 2023, going 13-7-3 at home and 10-11-2 on the road.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his last start on September 8 vs. New York-NL, a Twins' 5-2 victory at Target Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts...marked the most strikeouts he has recorded since September 2, 2022 at Boston as a member of the Texas Rangers...yielded both runs on a two-run automatic double by Francisco Lindor in the fourth inning...relieved in the sixth inning by Emilio Pagan as the bullpen combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings...the Twins scored three runs in the seventh inning off Sean Reid-Foley to secure the victory.

- ⚔ Has issued nine walks through his first six games of the season, tied with Pablo López for the third-highest streak by a Twins' pitcher in such a span.
- ⚔ Has not been handed a decision in three consecutive starts, tied for the second-longest streak of his career (last, August 26-September 7, 2014 with Houston).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took a no-decision on September 2 at Texas, a Twins' 10-inning 9-7 victory at Globe Life Field...pitched 3.1 innings and allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR) with one walk and two strikeouts...yielded a leadoff double to Marcus Semien and a two-run home run to Adolis Garcia in the first inning...surrendered another two-run home run to Sam Huff in the second inning...allowed two base runners and recorded one out in the fourth inning before being lifted from the game...Dylan Floro entered and allowed an RBI single to Leody Taveras (run charged to Keuchel)...the Twins bullpen combined to pitch 3.0 scoreless innings before Emilio Pagan entered in the eighth and yielded a game-tying sacrifice fly to Robbie Grossman...Jhoan Duran surrendered an RBI single in the 10th before earning his 24th save as the Twins clinched the series victory.

AGAINST TAMPA BAY: Facing Tampa Bay for the 11th time in his career and for the first time since August 21, 2021...is 2-6, 4.72 ERA (61.0 IP, 32 ER) with 20 walks and 43 strikeouts in his 10 previous starts against the Rays...took the loss in his last start against the Rays, an 8-4 White Sox' defeat at Tropicana Field; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed six runs on nine hits with two walks and three strikeouts.

⚔ Facing an American League East opponent for the first time this season...in 46 career appearances (45 starts) vs. the AL East, he is 18-16, 4.37 ERA (271.2 IP, 132 ER) with 86 walks and 213 strikeouts.

TARGET RUN: Making his fifth home appearance (4th start) of 2023...is 1-0, 1.27 ERA (21.1 IP, 3 ER) with six walks and 12 strikeouts in his previous four appearances...went 1-4, 6.45 ERA (37.2 IP, 27 ER) with 19 walks and 27 strikeouts in eight home starts in 2022...in 139 career home appearances (130 starts), he is 54-37, 3.32 ERA (840.0 IP, 310 ER) with 246 walks and 654 strikeouts...is 48-55, 4.72 ERA (774.1 IP, 406 ER) with 252 walks and 578 strikeouts in 135 road appearances (132 starts).

⚔ Last faced the Rays at home on June 15, 2021 as a member of the Chicago White Sox...earned the win after pitching 7.0 shutout innings and allowing four hits, with one walk and five strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT: Right-handed hitters are 21-for-74 (.284) with seven doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and six walks off Keuchel this year...lefties are 7-for-27 (.259) with one double, two RBI and three walks...allowed all three hits to righties in his last start on September 8 vs. New York-NL...owns better splits against left-handed hitters than righties in his career, holding lefties to a .239 (.313-for-1309) batting average and a .638 OPS...righties are batting .267 (1309-for-4909) with a .740 OPS off Keuchel.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a four-pitch mix in his first six appearances of 2023, leaning mostly on his sinker...has used his cutter 25.7 percent of the time after utilizing the pitch only 15.3 percent of the time in 2022...recorded three of his six strikeouts on his slider during his last start on September 8 vs. New York-NL...has a 52.6% whiff percentage on his slider this year, the highest in his career (previously 44.4% in 2017).

GROUND GAME: Keuchel owns a career groundball percentage of 58.3, the highest in baseball since 2012 (min. 1,000.0 IP)...has a groundball-to-flyball ratio of 2.87, the highest in baseball in that span under those same parameters...has induced 198 double play groundballs in his career, the second most since 2012, trailing only former Twin and current Baltimore Oriole Kyle Gibson (202).

ST. PAUL SENSATION: In six starts with the Saints this season, Keuchel went 1-0, 1.13 ERA (32.0 IP, 4 ER) with 12 walks and 28 strikeouts...recorded three consecutive quality starts in his last three outings with the Saints, including earning the win on July 28 vs. Toledo in his most recent start (6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 8 K)...was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July, becoming the first St. Paul pitcher to win the award; posted a 0.96 ERA with 24 strikeouts in 28.0 innings pitched.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2023: 4-7, 4.65 ERA // CAREER: 63-48, 3.96 ERA)

Right-hander Kenta Maeda is set to start in the four-game series opener against the Chicago White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field tomorrow...earned his fourth win of the season in his last start on September 9 vs. New York-NL, an 8-4 Twins' victory; allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR) in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and two strikeouts...has allowed a home run in 10-straight starts; the longest such streak by a Twins pitcher this season and the second-longest streak in baseball, trailing Oakland's Kyle Muller (11)...facing the White Sox for the seventh time in his career...is 2-2, 5.58 ERA (30.2 IP, 19 ER) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts in six previous starts...last faced the White Sox on April 10 when he took the 4-3 Twins' loss after pitching 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on eight hits (1 HR) with three strikeouts at Target Field.

- Pitched 6.1 perfect innings in his start on August 21, 2023 vs. Pittsburgh...marked the longest perfect game bid of his career.
- Signed as a minor league free agent by Minnesota on June 22, 2023...made six starts for Triple-A St. Paul, posting a 1-0 record with a 1.13 ERA (32.0 IP, 4 ER), 12 walks and 28 strikeouts...named International League Pitcher of the Month for July, going 1-0, 0.96 ERA (28.0 IP, 3 ER) with 12 walks, 24 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP.
- In 2022, pitched in 14 major league games for three different clubs, starting eight games for Chicago-AL, four for Arizona and two for Texas...went 2-9, 9.20 ERA (60.2 IP, 62 ER) with 31 walks and 45 strikeouts...was one of nine players to pitch in the majors for three different teams in 2022.
- Won his fifth career AL Rawlings Gold Glove Award® with Chicago-AL in 2021...led all MLB pitchers with 41 assists and a 2.67 range factor per 9.0 IP, and limited opponents to just two stolen bases in six attempts.
- Ranked third in MLB in 2020 with a 1.99 ERA (63.1 IP, 14 ER) in his first season with Chicago-AL...allowed three runs-or-less in all 11 of his starts, including one run four times and no runs twice...started Game 2 of the AL Wild Card Series at Oakland.
- In 2019, went 8-8 with a 3.75 ERA (112.2 IP, 47 ER) and 91 strikeouts over 19 starts in his only season with Atlanta...limited left-handers to a .189 (14-for-74) average...started Games 1 and 4 of the NLDS vs. St. Louis, posting a pair of no-decisions.
- Tied for the AL lead in starts (career-high 34) and won his fourth Rawlings Gold Glove Award® in 2018 with Houston...surpassed 1,000.0 IP in his career on April 16 at Seattle in a complete-game loss (8.0 IP).
- In 2017, won the World Series with Houston and went 14-5 with a 2.90 ERA (145.2 IP, 47 ER) in 23 starts...was named his second career AL All-Star Team...posted single-season career highs in groundball rate (67.3 percent) and GB/FB ratio (4.41), leading the majors in both categories (min. 140.0 IP)...made five starts in the postseason, going 2-2 with a 3.58 ERA (27.2 IP, 11 ER) and 32 strikeouts for the World Champion Astros.
- In 2016, won his third-straight AL Rawlings Gold Glove Award® after tying for the AL lead in defensive runs saved among pitchers (7)...made 26 starts before his season was cut short in late August due to left shoulder inflammation.
- Won the AL Cy Young Award in 2015 and finished fifth in the AL Most Valuable Player voting after going 20-8 with a 2.48 ERA (232.0 IP, 64 ER) and 216 strikeouts over 33 starts with Houston...also won the Rawlings Gold Glove Award®, MLBPA Players Choice Award for AL Most Outstanding Pitcher, Fielding Bible Award (given to the best fielding pitcher in the majors) and three AL Pitcher of the Month Awards (April, May, August)...went 2-0 with a 2.57 ERA (14.0 IP, 4 ER) over three games (two starts) in the Postseason.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster in 2014...became the first Astros pitcher to win a Rawlings Gold Glove Award®...ranked among the AL leaders in complete games (1st, 5), groundball percentage (1st, 64.4), opponent GDP (1st, 36) and ERA (7th, 2.93).
- Pitched in 31 games in 2013 for Houston, making 22 starts...posted a 6-8 record and a 4.90 ERA (132.1 IP, 72 ER) as a starter.
- In 2012, made 16 starts with Houston across three stints in what was his first career major league action, going 3-8 with a 5.27 ERA (85.1 IP, 50 ER)...made his major league debut on June 17 at Texas, where he allowed just one run on four hits in 5.0 innings of work.
- Went a combined 10-8 with a 4.12 ERA (163.2 IP, 65 ER) and 91 strikeouts in 27 starts between Double-A Corpus Christi (20 G) and Triple-A Oklahoma City (7 G) in 2011.
- In 2010, posted a 7-14 record with a 3.77 ERA (174.1 IP, 73 ER) and 133 strikeouts in 28 games (27 starts) between Double-A Corpus Christi (9 G) and High-A Lancaster (19 G).
- Made his professional debut with Rookie Iri-City on July 8, 2009...went 2-3 with a 2.70 ERA (56.2 IP, 17 ER) and 44 strikeouts in 11 games (10 starts) for the ValleyCats.
