THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3, going 2-1 vs. New York-NL and 1-2 vs. Tampa Bay...tonight, Minnesota will begin its penultimate roadtrip of the season with the first of four against the White Sox through the weekend...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Cincinnati to play the Reds three times from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins have gone 43-32 at home and 33-38 on the road.
Of the 16 remaining games, the Twins have an opponent winning percentage of .407, the second-lowest strength of schedule in baseball (San Diego - .405)...Cincinnati (76-71) is the only remaining team on the schedule with a winning record. Twins also will play Chicago-AL (56-90), Los Angeles-AL (68-79), Oakland (46-100) and Colorado (53-92).

TWINS CAN'T SECURE SERIES WIN OVER TAMPA: The Twins lost to the Rays yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-4, dropping the three-game series two games to one...Dallas Keuchel was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Griffin Jax (6-10) was dealt the loss, allowing a solo home run to Randy Arozarena in the top of the ninth inning...the offense recorded five hits and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position...Max Kepler drove in two runs with a triple, while Matt Wallner (12) and Kyle Farmer (10) both added solo home runs.

TWINS-SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 10th of 13 meetings this season... Minnesota has gone 6-3 against the Sox this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 1-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the Twins have outscored the Sox this season 40-30...three of the nine games have been played in extra innings.

Minnesota has won four straight over Chicago, their longest streak since taking seven straight from August 10, 2021-July 5, 2022.

Since 2015, the Twins have gone 84-68 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

Five of the nine games between these two teams this season have been decided by one run and seven have been decided by two runs-or-fewer.

Christian Vázquez is hitting .336 (40-for-119) with seven doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, nine walks, a .383 on-base percentage and an .803 OPS in 38 career games vs. the Sox.

Notable hitters vs. Sox pitching this season: Ryan Jeffers is 7-for-17 (.412) with one triple, one home run and two walks...Willi Castro is 4-for-10 (.400) with two doubles and a walk...Alex Kirilloff is 4-for-12 (.333) with one home run, five RBI and two walks.

BUT THERE'S NO GUARANTEE ON THE BOX: The Twins have gone 1-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...their last series here came May 2-4, playing two extra-inning games.

Since 2019, no opponent has homered at Guaranteed Rate Field more than the Twins, with 74 (next is Kansas City with 46).

Jorge Polanco is hitting .316 (30-for-95) with three doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI and a .979 OPS in his last 24 games on the South Side...he has driven in 14 runs in his last nine games here...Polo's 14 career homers and 43 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

Christian Vázquez is hitting .373 (22-for-59) with an .896 OPS in 19 career games at Guaranteed Rate...in his last 13 games here, he has reached base 22 times in 43 plate appearances (.512 OBP)...two of his six four-hit games (career high) have come in this ballpark.

CENTRAL FOCUS: Despite the loss yesterday, the Twins lowered their magic number to nine after a Cleveland defeat in San Francisco...Minnesota enters today at 76-70 with a 7.5 game lead on the Guardians, who sit at 69-78...below is a brief look at Minnesota and Cleveland:

NOTE: Cleveland has gone 3-8 in their last 11 games and 23-34 since the All-Star break, while Minnesota has gone 7-5 in their last 12 and 31-24 since the break.

STRIKE ZONE DEFENSE: Twins pitchers enter today with 1,370 strikeouts on the season, third most in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901)...they are on pace to strike out 1,520 hitters this season...the starters have struck out an MLB-best 868 batters and are on pace to strike out 963 hitters this season...below are the pitching staff rankings (left) and starting staff rankings (right) in Twins history:

KEPLER ON DRUMS: Since the All-Star break, Max Kepler is hitting .299 (56-for-187) with 15 doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 29 RBI, 19 walks, a .365 on-base percentage, a .561 slugging percentage and a .927 OPS in 53 games (Twins 30-23 in those games).

Among all AL qualified players since the break, he ranks 12th in OPS, 13th in slugging percentage, 15th in isolated power (.262) and 17th in batting average.

POLANCO ON BASS: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 17 of his last 18 games, hitting .313 (20-for-64) with four doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI, 13 walks, a .423 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a .986 OPS in that span...additionally, he has driven in 12 runs in his last 14 games, since August 26.

ROYCE ON LEAD GUITAR: After starting the season hitting .182 (6-for-33) with a .576 OPS in his first eight games, Royce Lewis has hit .325 (53-for-163) with a .931 OPS in his last 44 games.

Since August 23, his 27 RBI are tied with Trea Turner for the most in baseball...additionally, his eight home runs since that date are tied for fifth-most in baseball with Matt Olson, trailing Trea Turner (12), Kyle Schwarber (10), Ronald Acuña Jr. (9) and Julio Rodríguez (9).

Among all MLB rookies with a minimum of 200 plate appearances, Lewis ranks first in batting average (.301), OPS (.874), OPS+ (138.4) and at-bats-per-RBI (4.45), and second in wOBA (.376) and slugging percentage (.520).

- ☞ Facing Chicago-AL for the second time this season and seventh time in his career...took the loss on April 10 vs. the White Sox in a 4-3 Twins' defeat at Target Field (6.0 IP, 8 H, 4 R/ER, 1 HR, 0 BB, 3 K).
- ☞ Is in his fourth season with the Twins after being acquired in 2020, along with Jair Camargo, from Los Angeles-NL in exchange for Brusdar Graterol and Luke Raley.

LAST TIME OUT: Snapped a five-start streak without a victory, earning the win on September 9 vs. New York-NL in the Twins' 8-4 victory at Target Field...pitched 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts...allowed a leadoff home run to Brandon Nimmo in the top of the first, the second leadoff homer he has allowed this year (also, April 20 at Boston - Alex Verdugo) and fifth of his career...fired 4.1 scoreless innings after yielding two runs in the first inning...was relieved by Kody Funderburk in the top of the sixth following a one-out walk to Daniel Vogelbach; Twins scored five runs off New York-NL's bullpen as Minnesota claimed the series victory.

☞ Earned the win despite striking out just two batters, doing so for the first time in his career as a starter...his two strikeouts tied for his second-lowest single-game total of the year (also, April 26 vs. New York-AL), trailing only his zero-strikeout start on April 20 at Boston.

☞ Has yielded at least one home run in 10-consecutive starts, the longest streak of his career and the longest such streak by a Twins starter since Griffin Jax in 2021 (also 10-game streak).

TWO STARTS AGO: Took his fourth-consecutive no-decision on September 3 at Texas in a 6-5 Twins' loss at Globe Life Field...allowed three runs on nine hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and three strikeouts...yielded a three-run home run to former Twin Mitch Garver in the first inning, then tossed 4.0 scoreless innings to complete his start...failed to record a 1-2-3 inning but stranded seven runners on base, including two in the first, second and third innings...was relieved by Cole Sands to start the bottom of the sixth with the score tied 3-3; Twins bullpen allowed three earned runs in 3.0-plus innings pitched, and the Rangers won on a walk-off solo homer by Adolis Garcia.

SOX STATS: Facing Chicago-AL for the second time this year and seventh time in his career...is 2-2, 5.58 ERA (30.2 IP, 19 ER) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts in six previous starts vs. the White Sox...lost to Chicago-AL on April 10 at Target Field in a 4-3 Twins' defeat; pitched 6.0 innings and allowed four runs on eight hits (1 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...retired 10 of the first 12 batters he faced before allowing four runs in the fourth inning on four singles and a three-run homer by Hanser Alberto.

☞ Seeking his first win against the White Sox since July 26, 2020, when he earned the victory in a 14-2 Twins' win at Guaranteed Rate Field (5.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 6 K); marked his first start as a Twin in Minnesota's third game of the shortened 2020 season...is 0-2, 6.97 ERA (20.2 IP, 16 ER) in four starts vs. Chicago-AL since then, with the Twins going 0-4 in those games.

AGAINST THE CENTRAL: Maeda is 2-3, 4.14 ERA (37.0 IP, 17 ER) with eight walks and 40 strikeouts in seven starts vs. American League Central opponents this season...since becoming a Twin in 2020, he is 9-6 against the AL Central with a 3.69 ERA (131.2 IP, 54 ER), 29 walks, 151 strikeouts and a .218 (106-for-486) opponent batting average in 24 starts...his 10.32 strikeouts-per-9.0 inning ratio vs. the AL Central since 2020 is seventh best in baseball in that span (min. 15 GS).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Making his 11th road start of the season tonight...is 1-5 with a 3.42 ERA (47.1 IP, 18 ER), 16 walks and 56 strikeouts in 10 road starts this year...his 10.65 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings ratio on the road ranks seventh in the American League in 2023 (min. 45.0 IP)...Twins have lost his last four road starts despite Maeda posting a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER)...is 3-2, 6.05 ERA (41.2 IP, 28 ER) with eight walks and 40 strikeouts in eight starts at Target Field this season.

☞ Pitching at Guaranteed Rate Field for the first time since June 29, 2021; took the loss in a 7-6 Twins' defeat (4.2 IP, 8 H, 7 R/ER, career-high-tying 5 BB, 4 K)...is 2-1, 5.47 ERA (24.2 IP, 15 ER) with nine walks and 24 strikeouts in five career starts at Chicago-AL.

☞ In 100 career road appearances (84 starts), he is 27-27, 4.57 ERA (435.0 IP, 221 ER) with 140 walks and 475 strikeouts...is 36-21, 3.31 ERA (416.0 IP, 153 ER) with 104 walks and 455 strikeouts in 87 career home appearances (69 starts).

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix this year, mostly using his slider, split finger and 4-seam fastball, throwing the trio 90.0 percent of the time...favors his split finger (281/452 - 62.2%) against lefties and mostly uses his slider (276/455 - 60.7%) and sinker (90/91 - 98.9%) against righties...recorded both his strikeouts in his last start on September 9 vs. New York-NL with his split finger...here's a breakdown of his repertoire:

☞ Has averaged 91.3 mph on his four-seam fastball in his last seven starts, a 0.7-mpg increase from his four-seam fastball average in his first 11 starts this season (90.6).

SPLIT, THE DIFFERENCE: Has accumulated a run value of five on his split finger this year, the sixth-highest run value on a splitter in the American League and 10th highest in baseball this season...opposing hitters have an expected slugging percentage of .318 and an xwOBA of .265 off Maeda's splitter this year...also owns a 33.9 percent whiff rate on his splitter in 2023, his highest whiff rate on the pitch since 2020 (45.6%).

☞ His 36 strikeouts with his split finger are the seventh most in the AL this year.

JAPANESE RANKS: Maeda tied Hisashi Iwakuma for the fifth-most victories by a Japanese-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-) with a win in his last start on September 9 vs. New York-NL...only Hideo Nomo (123), Yu Darvish (103), Hiroki Kuroda (79) and Masahiro Tanaka (78) have earned more victories than Maeda in MLB among Japanese-born pitchers...here are his career numbers and how they rank among Japanese-born hurlers in MLB (min. 500.0 IP):

- Missed entire 2022 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow.
- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 *Baseball America* Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
