THE TWINS: After completed their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3 (2-1 vs. New York-NL and 1-2 vs. Tampa Bay), the Twins began their penultimate roadtrip of the season with a win over the White Sox last night in Chicago...

TWINS PILE ON LATE IN CHICAGO: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 10-2...Kenta Maeda (5-7) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings pitched (tied season high)...

CENTRAL FOCUS: Last night's victory in Chicago lowered the Twins' magic number to eight (Cleveland did not play)...Minnesota enters today at 77-70 with a 8.0 game lead on the Guardians, who sit at 69-78...

OBERTIME: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Bailey Ober from Triple-A St. Paul... Ober, who was optioned from Minnesota to St. Paul on August 28, made one start during his most recent stint with the Saints...

SECOND HALF SWINGS: Since the All-Star break, the Twins have gone 32-24, the fifth-most wins in the AL, trailing Baltimore (37-20), Seattle (36-21), Houston (33-23) and Tampa Bay (33-22)...

STRIKE ZONE DEFENSE: Kenta Maeda struck out eight batters last night, giving the Twins starters 876 strikeouts, setting a new club record...the Twins staff enters today with 1,380 strikeouts on the season...

ADDITIONALLY: Twins starters lead baseball in strikeouts, while the entire staff ranks second in baseball, trailing Atlanta (1,387).

ROOKIES THAT RAKE: Royce Lewis is hitting .323 (54-for-167) with 11 home runs, 39 RBI and a .943 OPS in his last 45 games...he leads MLB in RBI (29) since August 23 and tied for third in homers (9) since that date.

Edouard Julien has posted an .868 OPS in his last 54 games, since July 8...he has drawn a walk in seven-straight games, tied with Tim Teufel (1984) and Kent Hrbek (1982) for third-longest streak by a Twins rookie (since 1961)...

TWINS-SOX: Twins and White Sox are playing the 11th of 13 meetings this season...Minnesota has gone 7-3 against the Sox this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 2-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...

Minnesota has won five straight over Chicago, their longest streak since taking seven straight from August 10, 2021-July 5, 2022.

Since 2015, the Twins have gone 85-68 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span. Since 2019, no opponent has homered at Guaranteed Rate Field more than the Twins, with 77 (next is Kansas City with 46).

Christian Vázquez is hitting .328 (40-for-122) with seven doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .379 on-base percentage and a .789 OPS in 39 career games vs. the Sox...Vázquez is hitting .355 (22-for-62) with an .863 OPS in 20 career games at Guaranteed Rate...

Alex Kirilloff is hitting .324 (23-for-71) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI and an .895 OPS in 19 career games vs. the Sox...he has driven in 15 runs in his last 11 games against Chicago...he is slashing .353/.353/.588 in nine career games at GRF.

Jorge Polanco is hitting .310 (31-for-100) with three doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a .952 OPS in his last 25 games on the South Side...he has driven in 15 runs in his last 10 games here...Polo's 14 career homers and 44 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2002, the Twins clinched the AL Central Division title with a 5-0 win over Cleveland at then-Jacobs Field, marking the Twins' first playoff appearance since 1991...they also won the division in the next two seasons...in 2017, the Twins celebrated Big Sexy Night as Bartolo "Big Sexy" Colon made the start...Colon allowed four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings as the Twins lost to the Blue Jays by a score of 4-3.

CLEMENTE DAY: The Twins join MLB and all 30 teams in recognizing and honoring the life and legacy of Roberto Clemente today...Minnesota's nominee for the 2023 Roberto Clemente Award is Carlos Correa...Twins are 8-12 all-time on Roberto Clemente Day (since 2002).

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision in his last major league start on August 27 vs. Texas, a 13-inning, 7-6 Twins' victory at Target Field...pitched 4.0 innings and allowed five runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts...worked a 1-2-3 first inning...allowed solo home run to J.P. Martínez in the second inning...yielded his first career grand slam to Jonah Heim in the fourth inning...relieved by Dallas Keuchel, who pitched 5.0 scoreless innings...the Twins tied the game in the ninth inning on an RBI single by Donovan Solano off Aroldis Chapman...Emilio Pagan entered in the 12th inning and yielded a sacrifice fly to Corey Seager...the Twins walked off the game in the 13th inning after a bases-loaded walk issued to Michael A. Taylor by Jonathan Hernández.

- ☞ Has yielded 11 home runs in his last eight starts, setting a new career high over an eight-game span (previously, 10, June 22-August 6, 2021).
- ☞ Has pitched 5.0-or-fewer innings in six-consecutive starts; marks the second-longest streak of his career...is 0-2, 6.75 ERA (28.0 IP, 21 ER) with eight walks, 30 strikeouts and a .328 (39-for-119) opponent batting average in that span.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Did not factor into the decision on August 22 at Milwaukee, a 7-3 Twins' defeat at American Family Field...pitched 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on two hits (1 HR), with a career-high-tying three walks and three strikeouts; has issued career-high walks in back-to-back starts...allowed both runs on a two-run home run to Willy Adames in the first inning...retired 12 of the final 15 batters he faced after the home run; the only hit he allowed was a double to Christian Yelich in the third inning...relieved by Dylan Floro in the sixth inning who permitted five runs on six hits; permitted RBI singles to Mark Canha, Tyrone Taylor and Brice Turang, then Brian Anderson hit a two-run single after Turang stole second...Floro ended the inning after a flyball by Joey Wiemer and a strikeout to Yelich...Oliver Ortega entered the game in the seventh but exited with injury...Cole Sands entered and pitched 1.1 scoreless innings.

**ACROSS THE RIVER:** In his five starts with Triple-A St. Paul this season, Ober went 2-1, 2.38 ERA (22.2 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and 25 strikeouts...in his last start with the Saints on September 9, Ober did not factor into the decision in a 4-3 St. Paul defeat at Louisville; pitched 5.0 innings and allowed one run on three hits with three strikeouts...yielded a sacrifice fly to Matt Reynolds in the second inning.

**THERE'S A LIGHT ON IN CHICAGO:** Facing the White Sox for the second time this season and the 10th time in his career...is 2-1, 3.33 ERA (46.0 IP, 17 ER) with 10 walks and 50 strikeouts in his nine previous appearances...last faced Chicago-AL on July 23 at Target Field; did not factor into the decision despite recording a quality start, pitching 6.0 innings and allowed three runs (2 earned) on five hits (2 home runs), with no walks and six strikeouts...surrendered solo home runs to Eloy Jiménez in the second inning and Zach Remillard in the third inning...yielded an RBI single to Remillard in the fifth inning (run was unearned after Oscar Colás advanced to third base on a throwing error by Ryan Jeffers).

- ☞ His nine starts and 50 strikeouts against the White Sox are his most against any opponent in his career.
- ☞ Owns the lowest opponent batting average against the White Sox (.208) since 2021 (min. 6 GS).
- ☞ Made his major league debut against the White Sox at Target Field on May 18, 2021...did not factor into the decision in a 5-4 Twins' victory after pitching 4.0 innings and allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts.

**BACK TO THE ROAD:** Ober is making his 10th road start of 2023 tonight...Twins have won five of his nine road starts this year, with Ober going 4-3, 3.86 ERA (51.1 IP, 22 ER) with nine walks, 57 strikeouts and five quality starts...is 2-3, 3.53 ERA (71.1 IP, 28 ER) with 17 walks and 63 strikeouts in 13 home starts this season.

**LEFT AND RIGHT:** Left-handed hitters are batting .240 (58-for-242) with 16 walks and 54 strikeouts against Ober this season...right-handed hitters are hitting .249 (55-for-221) with 10 walks and 66 strikeouts...lefties went 3-for-13 with two home runs and five RBI in his last start on August 27 vs. Texas, while righties went 2-for-4...in his career, left-handed hitters are batting .259/.316/.409 with 112 strikeouts against Ober...righties are hitting .234/.263/.451 with 155 strikeouts.

- ☞ Owns the 15th-lowest opponent slugging percentage against lefties (.364) among American League pitchers (min. 22 GS).

**ARSENAL:** Ober has used a four-pitch mix in his 22 starts of the 2023 season, per Baseball Savant...mostly uses his slider against righties while relying on his changeup and curveball against lefties...recorded two of his four strikeouts on his fastball in his last start on August 27 vs. Texas...also allowed a home run on a fastball and a changeup...here's a look at his repertoire:

☞ Despite a .250 opponent batting average on his fastball, he has an xBA of .216, the seventh lowest in the majors (min. 200 PA)...the .034 point difference is the seventh largest in baseball.

☞ His .240 opponent batting average across all of his secondary pitches (changeup, slider and curveball) is the 14th lowest in the American League (min. 250 PA).

### CAREER NOTES

- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career-highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
