The Twins are a season-high eight games over .500 for the second time this season...a win today would make them nine games over for the first time since July 6, 2022 (47-38).

TWINS AND SOX ON REPEAT: The Twins beat the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field by a score of 10-2 for the second consecutive night...Bailey Ober made his return from Triple-A St. Paul and made the start, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 14 hits as six Twins had multiple hits (Kirilloff - 3, Kepler - 2, Correa - 2, Castro - 2, Wallner - 2 and Jeffers - 2)...Royce Lewis went 1-for-2 with three walks and hit his fifth career grand slam/fourth of the season.

LEWIS: \*TURNS ON PS5, SELECTS BEGINNER MODE\*: Royce Lewis' second-inning grand slam last night was the fourth in his last 18 games and one of 16 career home runs.

♣ 18 games is the shortest span of games for a player to hit four-plus grand slams, the next four being Don Mattingly (39 games - 1987), Travis Harner (44 games - 2006), Jim Northrup (45 games - 1968) and Ralph Kiner (48 games - 1945-50).

♣ Lewis' five career grand slams are now tied for eighth most in club history (since 1961) and the most in a single season, breaking a tie with Bob Allison (1961), Rod Carew (1976), Kent Hrbek (1985), Kirby Puckett (1992) and Torii Hunter (2007).

♣ Five career grand slams in 66 career games is the fewest in MLB history...the only other player in AL/NL to hit five slams before their 150th career game was Rudy York (139).

♣ Four grand slams in a single season ties CWS's Alexei Ramirez (2008) for most by a rookie in AL/NL history...the AL/NL record for most grand slams in a single season is six by NYY's Don Mattingly in 1987 and CLE's Travis Hafner in 2006.

CENTRAL FOCUS: Last night's victory in Chicago lowered the Twins' magic number to seven...
Minnesota enters today at 78-70 with a 8.0 game lead on the Guardians, who sit at 70-78...

DEEP DISH: Twins and White Sox are playing the 12th of 13 meetings this season. Minnesota has gone 8-3 against the Sox this season, going 5-1 at Target Field and 3-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...the I wins have outscored the Sox this season 60-34.

♣ Minnesota has won six straight over Chicago, their longest streak since taking seven straight from August 10, 2021-July 5, 2022.

♣ Since 2015, the I wins have gone 86-68 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Since 2019, no opponent has homered at Guaranteed Rate Field more than the Twins, with 78 (next is kansas City with 46).

♣ Christian Vázquez is hitting 328 (40-for-122) with seven doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, 10 walks, a .379 on-base percentage and a .789 OPS in 39 career games vs. the Sox...Vázquez is hitting .355 (22-for-62) with an .863 OPS in 20 career games at Guaranteed Rate...in his last 14 games here, he has reached base 23 times in 47 plate appearances (.489 OBP).

♣ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .342 (26-for-76) with six doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI and a .914 OPS in 20 career games vs. the Sox...he has driven in 15 runs in his last 12 games against Chicago...he is slashing .385/.385/.590 in 10 career games at GRF.

♣ Jorge Polanco is hitting .310 (31-for-100) with three doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a .952 OPS in his last 25 games on the South Side...he has driven in 15 runs in his last 10 games here...Polo's 14 career homers and 44 career RBI at Guaranteed Rate are his most in any opposing ballpark.

SECOND HALF SLUG: Since the All-Star break the Twins have gone 33-24 tied with Houston (33-

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: The Twins are seeking their 24th series victory this season...they are 23-19-5 in series play in 2023, going 13-8-3 at home and 10-11-2 on the road.

The Twins have gone 6-3-1 in series play since August 11.

The Twins have won three of their last four road series' and four of their last six away from Target Field.

Minnesota is looking for its second-straight series win over the White Sox and their first at Guaranteed Rate Field since taking two of three from July 4-6, 2022.

**FRENCH GOD OF WALKS:** Edouard Julien has posted a walk percentage of 15.1% (53 BB/352 PA), eighth best in baseball (minimum of 350 plate appearances)...he has drawn a walk in eight-straight games, tied with Rich Rollins (1962) for second-longest streak by a Twins rookie (since 1961), trailing Josmil Pinto (10 - 2014)...the club record for any player is 12, done by Brian Dozier, from July 29-August 11, 2014.

SEPTEMBERS TO REMEMBER: In 12 games since September 1, Carlos Correa has hit .313 (15-for-48) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks, a .365 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and an .865 OPS...last September/October, he hit .355 (44-for-124) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 19 RBI, a .412 on-base percentage, a .589 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS in 31 games.

LAST TIME OUT: Struck out a career-high 14 batters but did not factor into the decision on September 10 vs. New York-NL, a 2-0 Twins' loss at Target Field...pitched 8.0 scoreless innings, allowed just two hits and did not issue a walk...recorded his 200th strikeout of 2023 in the first inning (F. Lindor), becoming the eighth Venezuelan-born pitcher in American League/National League history (1901-) to achieve the feat...allowed a leadoff single to Brandon Nimmo in the first and a one-out single to Francisco Alvarez in the third; retired 17 of the final 19 batters he faced after the Alvarez single... Mets scored twice off Griffin Jax in the top of the ninth to take the series finale.

4 His 14 strikeouts were the most by a Twins pitcher since Francisco Liriano struck out 15 on July 13, 2012 vs. Oakland.

5 Became third pitcher in Twins history (1961-) to strike out at least 14 batters without issuing a walk, joining Bert Blyleven (14 K on September 24, 1986 vs. Kansas City) and Johan Santana (14 K on September 19, 2004 vs. Baltimore; franchise-high 17 K on August 19, 2007 vs. Texas).

6 Became the first pitcher to strike out 11-or-more left-handed hitters in a single game since KC's Brady Singer struck out 11 lefties on July 23, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay.

6 Threw 106 pitches, tied with his start on July 15 at Oakland for the most he has thrown this season and the fourth most of his career (career-high 110 pitches on June 4, 2022 vs. San Francisco).
